**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds wrap up the 2024 season against the Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay Rays) on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Ian Bedell gets the start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Cole Wilcox for Durham.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Memphis Redbirds continued the final homestand of the season with an 8-0 win over the Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay Rays) on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Shortstop Arquimedes Gamboa smacked a grand slam in the fifth inning to solidify the victory. Gamboa went 2-for-4 with four RBIs to bring him to 20 on the season. Right fielder Matt Koperniak went 2-for-5 with a home run, his 20th of the season. The left-handed hitter is currently three points behind the league leader in batting average heading into the final day of the regular season. Designated hitter Nolan Gorman added a solo home run in the eighth inning. Starting pitcher Zack Thompson (4-6) ended his season on a high note. The left-handed pitcher tossed 6.0 shutout innings in the win. Thompson allowed three hits, walked two and struck out four. Connor Thomas (S, 3) pitched 3.0 innings with two strikeouts and one hit allowed for the save. The scoreless outing brings the left-handed pitcher's ERA to 2.89. With a win in the season finale tomorrow afternoon, Memphis will finish the season at .500, the first season at or above the mark since 2018.

**AGAINST DURHAM:** The Memphis Redbirds is currently leading 9-8 in the season series against the Durham Bulls. In 13 games played against the Rays Triple-A affiliate, outfielder Matt Koperniak is dominating Bulls pitching with a .410/.486/.689/1.175 slash line with three home runs and 17 RBIs. In three starts, Zack Thompson holds a 1.20 ERA through 15.0 innings pitched. The six-game series this week in Memphis is the first meeting between the two teams at AutoZone park this season.

**UNTIL NEXT YEAR:** The Memphis Redbirds wrap up the 2024 campaign this week against Durham. This season, Memphis went .500 in games played away from AutoZone Park this season (36-36). To finish the season at .500 or above for the first time since 2018, the Redbirds will need to win at least four games against the Bulls this week. With a win on Sunday afternoon, Memphis will reach the .500 mark.

**HAPPY 25th, AZP:** To commemorate the 25th anniversary season of Redbirds baseball at AutoZone Park, the Redbirds will host a plethora of promotions and theme nights to celebrate. Since the opening of the downtown ballpark in 2000, many credit the stadium with the revitalization of downtown Memphis. The support of the Redbirds at AutoZone Park caught the attention of Michael Heisley, who then brought the Grizzlies to the city. “(AutoZone Park) was a catalyst for a lot of the things that downtown is today,” Memphis Redbirds President and General Manager Craig Unger said. “So, I think even to this day today, you still see development going on around here. The Commonwealth building a few years ago, you know, Stewart and the group there that, that did that building talked about AutoZone Park. This entire block around Madison is still the catalyst for growth there. Sports is that catalyst.”

**BASEBALL AMERICA OUTLOOK:** The St. Louis Cardinals entered the 2024 season with the No. 20 Minor League system in all of baseball according to BaseballAmerica. St. Louis began the campaign with five players ranked in the Top-100 (No. 39 Masyn Winn, MLB, No. 75 Tekoah Roby, AA, No. 83 Victor Scott II, MLB, No. 84 Tink Hence, AA, No. 85 Thomas Saggese, AAA). BaseballAmerica’s preview on the Cardinals system states “Jordan Walker’s successful graduation to the majors has dropped the Cardinals’ farm system back, though exciting up-the-middle hitters like Masyn Winn and Victor Scott II are ready to follow Walker to St. Louis. Getting the most out of arms like Tekoah Roby and Tink Hence is going to be crucial. The Cardinals pulled off the neat trick of adding two Top 100 Prospects when they dealt Jordan Montgomery to the Rangers for Roby and Thomas Saggese in July.”

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his sixth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 43, is beginning his 12th season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

- As of 2023, Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero’s tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his second season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

**TODAY'S START:** Redbirds right-handed pitcher is scheduled to start the final game of the 2024 season against the Durham Bulls on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Today's start is Bedell's first since being activated off of the Injured List

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bedell spent a month and a half on the Injured List after a 3.0-inning outing on August 4 at Durham. In the start, the right-handed pitcher allowed two runs on four hits, walked two and struck out two.

**2023 RISE:** In his first full season after recovering from Tommy John Surgery, the right-handed pitcher dominated High-A with the Peoria Chiefs. Bedell posted a 2.44 ERA in 27 appearances and 19 starts. He tossed 96.0 innings, led the team in strikeouts with 106 and posted a WHIP of 1.15... He lead Cardinals minor leaguers in ERA, was 5th in WHIP, 6th in strikeouts and 10th in batting average against...

**AWARDS AND HONORS:** Rated as the No. 26 prospect in the Cardinals organization entering 2024 by Baseball America... ranked among Cardinals minor league leaders in ERA (1ST), WHIP (5TH), strikeouts (6TH), and batting average against (10th)...
