ROAD WALK-OFF?: After splitting yesterday's doubleheader, the FredNats are still tied for first place in the Carolina League North Division with 10 games left in the regular season. FBG and Carolina - who play next week in Fredericksburg - are both 29-24 in the second half, 1.5 games ahead of Fayetteville. Tonight, FBG aims to get even in this seven-game series with the Hillcats, and sends LHP Liam Sullivan to the mound to try and do so. Sullivan has made five starts with the FredNats since returning from Tommy John surgery, and his last one was his best yet. He threw five scoreless innings, allowing just one hit, walking one and striking out six in a victory over Fayetteville. Lynchburg counters with RHP Joey Oakie, who faces the FredNats for the first time.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg and Lynchburg split a doubleheader, with Lynchburg winning game one 3-1 while setting down the final 15 FredNat hitters in order, and Fredericksburg picking up a walk-off win in game two as the "home" team at Bank of the James Stadium. The second game was a make-up of a rainout in Fredericksburg, so the FredNats picked up their MiLB-leading 11th walk-off victory of the season on the road in Lynchburg. Nick Peoples got the winning RBI in the 9th inning of game two off a position player. The FredNat bullpen was lights out in game two, with Ryan Minckler, Angel Roman and Merrick Baldo allowing zero runs on one total hit.

BAZ ON THE RUN: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 90, nine ahead of Fayetteville, who is in second place. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by three with 58 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 39% of would-be base stealers. 12 of FBG's caught stealings have come against Lynchburg this season. In addition to the phenomenal defense Bazzell has played all season, he's now enjoying his best stretch of the year with the bat too, hitting .352 in August with a .770 OPS.

WOWED BY WILLITS: 17-year-old Eli Willits - the number one overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft - made his professional debut Thursday night, and has hits in all six professional games he's played so far. Overall, Wllits is 8-for-20 with three walks, three RBI and two stolen bases. Willits, Washington's No. 1 prospect and the 18th best in all of baseball, won't turn 18 until December. He became the youngest FredNat ever, the youngest player in the Carolina League this season, and is currently the second youngest active player in full-season Minor League Baseball. Andrew Salas of the Jupiter Hammerheads is four months younger than Willits. Willits comes from a baseball family, his father Reggie played six seasons in the Major Leagues and is currently the Associate Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma, where his older brother Jaxon is the starting shortshop.

INSTANT IMPACT: The members of Washington's draft class that are already with Fredericksburg have had exceptional starts to their professional careers. 2nd rounder Ethan Petry (South Carolina) has played 14 games with Fredericksburg, and is hitting .320 with a .903 OPS. He's drawn 10 walks in 14 games as well. 15th rounder Jacob Walsh (Oregon) hit his first professional home run Wednesday night, and 14th rounder Nick Hollifield (UAB) has been a clutch force with the bat for the FredNats. On the last home stand alone, Hollifield had five game-tying RBIs in the 6th inning or later, plus a walk-off single on Sunday against Salem. Hollifield is 8-for-17 with runners in scoring position to begin his FredNat career, driving in runs in five out of his last seven games.

START EARLY, HOLD ON LATE: The FredNats are 59-59 overall this season, but are 15 games over .500 (34-19) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 93-121 (-28). The FredNats have also been exceptional at holding on to late-game leads this year. The team is 42-1 when leading after seven innings, and 35-1 when leading after eight.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Sullivan was simply dominant in his last start against Fayetteville. The tall lefty completed five innings for the first time this season and got his first win of the year. He stymied the Woodpeckers, allowing just one hit while striking out six on 75 total pitches. On the two-week homestand, he had 12 K's in 9.0 IP.

OVER BEFORE IT STARTED: Sullivan got off to a promising start in 2024, making two strong starts in which he allowed a total of just two earned runs in 9.1 innings with a remarkable 17 strikeouts. Unfortunately, that's where his year came to an end. After his second start, the lefty was placed on the full-season injured list and underwent season-ending elbow surgery.

BEACH BALL: In the last step of his recovery process this year, Sullivan pitched in eight games at the FCL level before being activated from the injured list on 7/18. Across 20 innings, the third-year pro allowed only eight hits and three earned runs, as he struck out 28 hitters.

GO DAWGS: Sullivan was taken by the Nationals in the 13th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia, where he enjoyed a fantastic career with the Bulldogs. In three SEC seasons, the Sandy Springs native posted a 4.95 ERA across 151 innings with 178 strikeouts. During his final season in 2023, he threw Georgia's first SEC complete-game shutout since 2014, when he allowed just four hits in nine innings against 10th-ranked Kentucky.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
