On August 13, 1996, Rick Helling threw a perfect game against the Sounds for the Oklahoma City 89ers. It was the fifth and final perfect game in American Association history and the first since 1979. Nashville lost the game 4-0 in Oklahoma City.

**200-Plus:** Rick Sweet won his 213th game as Nashville's manager on Friday, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

The Future is Now: Nashville has seven players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, including four of the top five and six of the top 10. Outfield Sal Frelick in the No. 2 prospect, outfielder Joey Wiemer is the No. 3 prospect, outfielder Garrett Mitchell is the No. 4 prospect, infielder Brice Turang is the No. 5 prospect, outfielder Esteury Ruiz is the No. 9 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 10 prospect and right-hander Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

**LAST OUTING:** Small last pitched in a start against Norfolk on August 7 in Virginia. The southpaw got a no decision in Nashville's 9-4 win. He went 5.0 innings and allowed three runs (all earned) on three hits and two walks. He struck out eight batters and threw 50 of his 85 pitches for strikes.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Small has faced Gwinnett five times in his career - three times in 2021 and twice in 2022. Earlier this year on April 16 in Gwinnett, the southpaw tossed six shutout innings and limited the Stripers to just one hit and three walks. He struck out seven and earned his first win of the season. On June 25, Small struck out a season-high 10 over 7.0 innings in another win. In 2021, Small went 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (12.2 IP/0 ER) against Gwinnett. In total, Small is 3-0 with a 0.35 ERA (25.2 IP/1 ER) in five starts against the Stripers in his career.
