**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels came from behind to beat the Altoona Curve, 5-3. The Curve took a 2-0 lead with solo homers by Andres Alvarez and Tucupita Marcano in the first and second innings. **Robert Emery** tied the game with a two-run homer in the top of the fifth inning. **Shane Matheny** gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead with a triple in the sixth and later scored on a sac fly by **Frankie Tostado** to extend the lead to 4-2. Liover Peguero singled in a run in the sixth to pull the Curve back within a run. **Jacob Heyward** added an insurance run in the top of the eighth to open a 5-3 lead. **R.J. Dabovich** worked a scoreless ninth to pick up his third save. **Bryan Brickhouse** struck out six and allowed two runs, the two solo homers, in his five innings. **Chris Wright**, **Ryan Walker** and **Dabovich** each pitched a scoreless relief inning. The win combined with a loss by Akron at Binghamton moved the Flying Squirrels back into a tie for first place in the Southwest Division standings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, looking for a series split. The two teams met for a six-game series in Richmond from April 12-17, the first home series of the year for the Flying Squirrels. Richmond won four games in that set, taking the decisive finale with a walk-off grand slam in the 10th inning by **Will Wilson**. The Flying Squirrels and Curve will face off for another six-game series in Altoona from July 12-17.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won two-of-three since Thursday after dropping three straight from Sunday through Wednesday. Last week, they won four-of-six at Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost one and split one this year. They won the season-opening set at Bowie from April 8-10, won their first home series against Altoona from April 12-17, lost a series at Erie from April 20-24, won five-of-six against the Baysox at home from April 26-May 1, split a home series against the RubberDucks from May 3-8 and won last week's road series against the Senators. With a loss last night in extra inning by the RubberDucks, Richmond is tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron.

**THE CURVE** have won three-of-five in this week's series. On the year, the Curve have won one series, lost four series and split one series. Last week, they dropped four-of-six at home against the Patriots. Altoona's roster includes 12 of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Nick Gonzalez (1), Henry Davis (2), Quinn Priester (4 - on IL), Liover Peguero (6), Matt Frazier (10), Mike Burrows (11), Carmen Mlodzinski (14), Kyle Nicolas (18), Jared Triolo (19), Tucupita Marcano (24), Tahnaj Thomas (28) and Luis Ortiz (30). In the Eastern League, Liover Peguero is third in batting average (.321), tied for first in RBIs (25), seventh in SLG (.529), tied for first in hits (45), tied for first in doubles (12), tied for first in triples (4), tied for first in extra-base hits (19) and tied in total bases (74). Blake Sabol is eighth in batting average (.307), eighth in SLG (.525) and tied for eighth in OPS (.911). Mike Burrows is fifth in ERA (2.27), tied for first in games started (8), tied for seventh in strikeouts (46), fifth in BAA (.178), eighth in WHIP (0.95) and tied for first in winning percentage (1.000). Colin Selby is tied for third in saves (5).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Gray Fenter** makes his sixth start with the Flying Squirrels and his third against the Curve. He faced the Curve on April 13 in his first start of the year and allowed one run over three innings with a season-high eight strikeouts. He started the series opener on Tuesday at PNG Field and allowed a season-high four runs (three earned) in four innings in a loss. In five starts this season, Fenter has posted a 2.08 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) with 25 strikeouts. As a reliever, Fenter is 0-1 with a 6.14 ERA (5 ER/7.1 IP). Fenter spent last season with the Baysox, beginning the season as a reliever. He went 3-2 with an 8.03 ERA as a reliever in 11 outings before moving into the rotation in July and went 3-2 with a 3.12 ERA the rest of the year. Fenter was originally drafted by the Orioles in the seventh round in 2015 out of West Memphis High School in Arkansas. He was signed by the Giants as a minor league free agent last December. **For more on Fenter, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Kyle Nicolas makes his eighth start of the year and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He started the series opener on Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels and allowed one run in four innings with a season-high eight strikeouts. He pitched at The Diamond in the Flying Squirrels' home opener on April 12 and pitched 3.2 scoreless innings in his season debut. He worked the finale of that set on April 17 and worked four hitless, scoreless innings. Nicolas was selected with the 61st-overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Ball State by the Miami Marlins. He was traded to the Pirates on November 29, 2021 along with RHP Zach Thompson and OF Connor Scott for C Jacob Stallings. Nicolas is rated by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 18 prospect.

**LOPSIDED:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -15 runs, the only team in the division with a negative run differential. In their last nine losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 7.2 runs. Of those nine losses, three have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg last Sunday and a 12-2 loss at Altoona on Tuesday. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last nine losses. On the other hand, the Flying Squirrels' last 13 wins in the same time frame have come by an average of 2.6 runs, including five one-run games.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,057). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 46 home runs this season, which is tied for second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (49). **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with nine homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 167 home runs.

**MARTY PARTY:** Over his last seven games played since Wednesday, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .370 (10-for-27) with three homers, two doubles, a triple and nine RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup last Friday and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. Last Saturday, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning.

**SHANE TRAIN:** Last Thursday, **Shane Matheny** hit a pair of solo homers, his second two-homer game of the season and the third of his professional career. He hit two home runs against the Baysox at The Diamond on May 1. He also had a two-homer game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton, part of his career-best 10 homers that season. This year, Matheny has hit five home runs, already surpassing his season total of four from 2021 with the Flying Squirrels. This season, Matheny is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in OBP (.400), ninth in SLG (.505) and 10th in OPS (.905). He is also ranked ninth in the league in wOBA (.399) and wRC+ (151). Over his last 10 games since May 11, Matheny is batting .333 (12-for-36) with two homers, two doubles, a triple and six RBIs. He is second on the Flying Squirrels with 17 walks this year.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** is third in the Eastern League with nine home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, matching **Jarrett Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He snapped an eight-game stretch without a homer with his solo shot last Friday night at Harrisburg. For the season, Roby has hit five of his nine homers against the Curve.

**TOASTY:** **Frankie Tostado** is batting .347 (33-for-95) with four homers, five doubles and 16 RBIs over his last 24 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. Last Wednesday, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. He posted a seven-game hit streak from May 10-18, ending with an 0-for-4 game on Thursday night. Tostado is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.323) and third in hits (42).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.323), third in his (43) and tied for fourth in total bases (66). **Sean Roby** is tied for third in home runs (9). **Shane Matheny** is ninth in OBP (.400), ninth in SLG (.505) and 10th in OPS (.905). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for ninth in stolen bases (9). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (4). **Jake Dahlberg** is tied for first in starts (8), seventh in inning pitched (40.2) and tied for fifth in winning percentage (.667). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for first in starts (8) and tied for eighth in innings pitched (37.1). **Bryan Brickhouse** is tied for first in starts (8) and is 10th in innings pitched (36.1).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
