<u>GAME RECAP:</u>
The Reading Fightin Phils walked it off 5-4 over the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It was their second walk-off of the series and eighth of the summer. The game was tied at two after nine innings, but the Fisher Cats plated two in the tenth for a lead. In the bottom half, Carlos De La Cruz tripled in two runs and scored on a wild pitch for the winning run of the game.

DE LA CRISHED:

Carlos De La Cruz is having a banner end to his 2022 campaign. In the last 10 games he is batting .217 with 13 hits, three doubles, one triple, and three homers. He has knocked in eighth runs and scored eight himself. His slugging percentage is up to .659 in that time frame with a 1.063 OPS.

TRIPLE PLAY HISTORY:

Phil Clarke doubled to start off the seventh inning on Friday. Will Robertson walked to put two on and no one out. Hugo Cardona grounded into a triple play. Third baseman McCarthy Tatum took a groundball to the bag at third, threw to Madison Stokes at second and on to Aldrem Corredor at first. The last triple play in Fightins history was on June 23, 2016 versus Akron in the ninth inning.

WALK-OFF HEAVEN:

The Fightins have recorded walk-off wins now in two games of the five played against the Fisher Cats. It was their eighth walk-off of the season and each one was completed by a different player. It was also their twelfth extra inning contest, and third of the series. They are 5-7 in extras this summer.

HIGH STRIKEOUTS:

In 2019, the Reading Fightin Phils rewrote the record books with 1,271 total strikeouts recorded to set the league record. 642 were by starters and 629 were by relievers. It has since been rebroken twice by Akron, including this season with over 1,300. This summer the Fightins have 1,224 total punchouts just 18 away from tying the all-time record. Starters have compiled 529 K's while relievers have recorded 726 strikeouts.

PROSPECT CENTRAL:

The Fightins roster boasts many top prospects in the Phillies farm system. Andrew Painter (#1), Mick Abel (#2), Johan Rojas (#5), Ethan Wilson (#8), Jhailyn Ortiz (#17) McKinley Moore (#24), and Andrew Baker (#30) rank high.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies topped the Nationals 8-5 last night behind Ranger Suarez's ninth win of the season. He threw six and two thirds allowing four runs on seven hits. Bryce Harper, Nick Maton, Brandon Marsh, and Kyle Schwarber all had homers in the win. Philadelphia wraps up their series against Washington with a day game at Citizens Bank Park. They are up 1-0 on Harper's double to score Hoskins. Aaron Nola is on the bump, but they are in a rain delay as I am currently typing this.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

September 11, 2001: Terrorist attacks in New York, Washington and Pennsylvania bring the sports world to a halt and postpone the start of the Eastern League championship series between Reading and New Britain. A few days later, the series would be cancelled and the Phillies and Rock Cats declared co-champions.
