### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Kolby Allard** to the mound tonight, looking to run the winning streak to 7G for the first time since an 8G streak from 7/31-8/9/22. Omaha will counter with RHP **Ben Sears**. Columbus is 27-12 (.692, best in the IL) versus right handers this year. Sears has never pitched against Columbus in his career (tonight is 23rd career game in Triple-A).

### vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 45 of the last 71 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 71G, the Clippers are 8-43 (.157) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha, while going 18-2 (.900) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has played 6G against Omaha in his career, hitting .478 (11x23) with 1HR and 7RBI.

### Climbing

Entering tonight looking up at only four other teams, the Clippers hold their highest ranking in the standings (5th) since ending the day tied for 4th on 4/8 (6th to 13th in between). Unfortunately, Columbus is still 3.0 games out, having spent the last 35G between 3.0 (four times) and 6.0 (twice, last on 5/2). The Clippers are 11-3 (2nd in the IL) since getting swept in a DH at St. Paul on 5/15.

### Domination

In the 7G before last night, the Clippers trailed after only one of 61 innings played (walk-off loss at Toledo on 5/25), while leading after 48 (79%), including 42 of the last 44. That has resulted in 6G in which they never trailed, after totaling 6G through the first 49G of the year. Falling behind early last night, the Clippers came back to capture their 20th comeback win of the year (1st in the IL).

### Nayled It

**Bo Naylor** collected his first homer of the year with Columbus last night, giving him 29HR and 102RBI in his Clipper career (132G). The Clippers are 6-0 with Naylor in the lineup, averaging 7.3 runs per game (4.2 per in previous 10G). Batting leadoff tonight, Naylor is in the top spot for Columbus for the first time since 8/26/22 (11G as leadoff man in career; .163/.280/.256 with 1HR, lead off on 8/6/22).

### Familiar Foes

**Juan Brito** will bat second tonight for the 187th game since his debut (9/19/23; +97G and +452PA on 2nd place, Omaha's **Drew Waters**). Only one batter in the IL has more games and PA at a particular spot in that time, Omaha's **John Rave** at leadoff (tonight will be his 196th game; +40G and 185PA on 2nd). Brito is 9x21 (.429) with 5RBI in his last 5G (0x18 with 0RBI previous 5G).

### Misleading Streak

**Nolan Jones** has reached base in 21 straight games, posting a .370OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop nine points over the course of the streak, while his average has dipped five points (.266, 21x79). The streak is tied for 10th longest in the IL this season and ranks as the 5th longest active streak. Jones has not homered since the start of the month vs. Toledo (85AB; 5RBI in last 22G).

### Bombs Away

**Angel Genao** clubbed his first homer in Huntington Park last night (19AB, .421), after having hit 3HR in 73AB on the road (.507SLG). As a team, Columbus has more homers outside the city (36) than inside (32), but they are averaging 1.3 per game at home (1.09 on the road). Last night's multi-HR game was the 10th at home for Columbus (8-2), compared to 10G on the road (4-6).

### Gaining Steam

**George Valera** owns an 18G on base streak since 5/5 (.400OBP). Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but he has over reached half the time in the last 10G (.523OBP in 44PA; hitting .344, 11x32 with 12BB and 5K). Valera's K-rate is down considerably this season (16.5% from 26.5% in first four seasons with Columbus), with 4K in his last 39PA.

### Back on Track

In the last 19G, the Columbus bullpen has a 3.19ERA (79.OIP, 28ER), 3rd best in the IL (3ER or fewer in 18G until last night, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 14th at 5.16; starters have a 5.50ERA, 16th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 5HR to 166BF since.

### This Date in Clipper History

6/3/2005

Columbus scored eight times in the 5th inning at Buffalo, erasing a 5-1 deficit on the way to a 10-7 win. The comeback was powered by six home runs, including five in the 5th. **Wil Nieves** started the 5th with a solo shot, while **Andy Phillips** (3-run HR), **Mike Vento** (2nd HR of the day), **Mitch Jones** and **Ryan Hankins** went back to back to back to close out the 5th inning scoring.

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,431 to 1,378).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 80-78 (.506) in pitch reviews, with batters going 44-52 (.458) and pitchers/catchers going 36-26 (.581). They have run out of challenges in 32G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

### On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 860, would rank as 3rd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

### On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 82 through the first 57G (on pace for 214SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 19CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (50; nabbed 51 times in 2004).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,934RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

### In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.33 through the first 57G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 158HR (3rd lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 9th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 31G this season (20-11, .645), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

### Good Baseball

**Kody Huff** bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 418-431 (.492), 388-385 with Columbus (.502).

**In the Majors:**

Allard did not make Cleveland's opening day roster, but had his contract purchased on 3/30 to pitch out of the Guardian bullpen. He made four appearances for Cleveland over a couple weeks, giving up at least 1ER every time out, including multiples in each of his last 3G (6.0IP, 9ER). Following a 69-pitch outing at Atlanta on 4/12 (3.0IP, 5ER), Allard was DFA'd on 4/13 and outrighted to Columbus on 4/16.

**Bumpy Beginning:**

Following his assignment, Allard appeared once out of the Columbus bullpen (3ER in 1.0IP vs. Iowa on 4/19) before going on the shelf with a sore right hip (4/22-5/6). Upon activation, he allowed 2ER in each of his first 2G back (4.1IP), averaging 48 pitches per outing. Allard was moved into the rotation beginning on 5/20 vs. Louisville, working a scoreless start (4.0IP) on only 37 pitches (0BB; issued 7BB to 24BF in 3G of relief), followed by a scoreless, walkless outing on 5/27 at Toledo (5.0IP, 17BF).
