James Marvel: Right-hander James Marvel will make his seventh start of the season today at Nashville. He was named Pittsburgh's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2019 after leading the farm system with 16 wins, 136 strikeouts and a 2.94 ERA between Indianapolis and Double-A Altoona.

Last Outing / Against the Sounds: Marvel earned his first win of the season on June 6 in the opening game of the series at Nashville. He gave up one run with five strikeouts in five and two-thirds innings. The Indians won the game, 6-1.
