TO THE ROAD: After narrowly dropping the series opener last night at Segra Stadium, the FredNats will look to even the series tonight behind a start from former first round pick Mason Denaburg. The Nationals' first selection in 2018, Denaburg has had an injury-filled career to this point, but this is the first time he's been healthy in back-to-back seasons. When healthy, he has been effective, and the Frednats will look to provide some more run support tonight. The FredNats were 34-33 on the road last year, and this is the second year in a row the team has traveled to Segra Stadium in Fayetteville. The Woodpeckers beat the FredNats in 4 out of 6 games in the lone matchup last year between the teams.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats were only able to muster four hits in the game, two of which came in the 9th inning. Riley Cornelio had a solid start in his pro debut, but was on the hook for the loss after giving up two ones (one earned) in five innings. Brady House hit his second home run in the first four games of the year in the 9th inning to get the game back to a one-run affair, and on the very next batter, Elijah Green hit a double that was misplayed by the Fayetteville center fielder. Green tried to make it all the way around the bases and score the tying run, but he was thrown out at home plate and the FredNats lost 3-2.

NEVER UNDER .500: In the two seasons Jake Lowery has managed the FredNats, the team has never been under .500. There were four instances in the first half last year where the squad slipped to .500, but they were 4-0 in those games and finished the regular season 75-55. The FredNats are 2-2 going into tonight's game, and will try to keep that streak going.

OFF TO A GREAT START: 2022 Nationals first round pick Elijah Green is off to a great start in his first campaign in Fredericksburg. The 19-year-old is 7-for-16 with two doubles, a walk-off single, three runs scored and two stolen bases in his first four games in FXBG.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The 2023 FredNats Opening Day roster is loaded with young talent as the Washington organization continues to rebuild. Fredericksburg features eight of the top-30 Nationals prospects (according to MLB Pipeline) on the Opening Day roster, including four of the top nine prospects. 2022 first round draft pick Elijah Green leads the way at No. 3, 2021 first-rounder Brady House is No. 5, Jarlin Susana is No. 6, and 2022 second rounder Jake Bennett slots in at No. 9. Other top-30 prospects on the Opening Day roster include Armando Cruz (No. 14), Daylen Lile (No. 16), Roismar Quintana (No. 17), and Brenner Cox (No. 23). All but one of those prospects was either drafted by the Nationals or signed internationally by Washington, with Susana being the lone exception as he came over from San Diego in the Juan Soto trade last August.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Mason Denaburg takes the ball tonight as he looks to build off of an encouraging return to the mound in 2022. A late-first round selection in 2018, Denaburg made 13 starts in '22 for the FredNats, working to an ERA just north of 4.00, while holding opponents to a .229 batting average against.

LONG ROAD BACK: Denaburg has certainly been tested in his young career. After scuffling in his first taste of pro ball in 2018, the injury bug struck. Denaburg underwent surgeries on both his elbow and his shoulder after the '18 campaign, holding him out for 1,027 days between his last start in 2018, and his Fredericksburg debut in 2022.

Mason did work under a pitch count last season, so extending himself and working deeper into games is a big key for his 2023 season.

SMILE: Denaburg had the word "Smile" embroidered over the thumb on his glove, to remind himself to stay relaxed and have fun on the mound.
