WHITECAPS MAKE HISTORY IN 16-0 WIN: The West Michigan Whitecaps enjoyed their most lopsided shutout in franchise history as they clinched the best winning percentage amongst Detroit Tigers Minor League affiliates this season in a 16-0 shutout over the Lansing Lugnuts in front of a sellout crowd of 8,568 fans Sunday afternoon at LMCU Ballpark. Six different players added a home run in West Michigan's seventh straight win – tying the most in a single game in franchise history – as West Michigan captures its 84th overall win and will finish the 2025 season with the best winning percentage of any Detroit Tigers affiliate. Meanwhile, 'Caps pitchers held Lansing to 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position to earn West Michigan their fourth six-game series sweep of the year.

RUNNING AWAY WITH RUNS RECORD: With their 16-0 win on August 24 over Lansing at LMCU Ballpark, not only did the Whitecaps collect their most lopsided shutout in team history, breaking the previous mark of 14-0 in a win over the Burlington Bees on June 5, 2000, but also broke the franchise record for runs scored in a season, and are now up to 699 on the year. The previous high was 1997 when the team scored 698 times.

ALONE AT THE TOP: A number of current Whitecaps players have set franchise records this season. Infielder Izaac Pacheco is the franchise's all-time home run record holder (37) and RBI-Leader (159). Another player who sits in the Top-5 is IF/OF Austin Murr (130). Murr currently holds the franchise all-time mark for doubles (62) with Pacheco sitting just four behind at 58.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Infielders Izaac Pacheco (No. 19 - Baseball America) and pitcher Lucas Elissalt (No. 26, MLB Pipeline) we're both recently named top-30 prospects in the Detroit Tigers Minor League system. Pacheco, who was a top-15 prospect after being drafted by the Tigers in 2021, subsequently dropped out of the top-30 before rejoining the list of top prospects in 2025 - setting career highs in every offensive category while becoming the Whitecaps career RBI and home run leader in the process.

POSTSEASON PLANS: Due to the Whitecaps winning the First-Half Title in the Midwest League Eastern Division, the 'Caps will host a playoff game the second week of September, scheduled for Thursday the 11th at 6:35 pm against the second-half Midwest League Eastern Division champion. A GRAND SEASON: The Whitecaps have shattered their franchise record for grand slams with eight this season, breaking the previous record of five, the most recent of which came by Andrew Jenkins in the 1st inning of a 12-2 win over the Lake County Captains at LMCU Ballpark on July 11.

THE WALK-OFF WHITECAPS: After the Whitecaps 3-2 walk-off victory over the Lansing Lugnuts on Friday, August 22, 11 of the 'Caps 43 victories at home have been walk-offs - accounting for 26% of their wins inside of LMCU Ballpark this season.

DRUMSTICKS FOR EVERYONE: As part of a 16-0 win over the Lansing Lugnuts at LMCU Ballpark on August 24, the Whitecaps set a new franchise record by scoring double-digit runs in 20 games this season, surpassing the previous record of 17 set in 2022. This season, a postgame tradition was instituted by manager Tony Cappuccilli, rewarding the team with Drumsticks Ice Cream Cones after each double-digit performance. This amounts to over 750 Drumsticks consumed by players, coaches, and support staff. This is not counting if anyone has seconds.

A LOT TO A LITTLE: The West Michigan Whitecaps currently have the best run differential in all of MiLB at +275 - ahead of the second-place Single-A San Jose Giants at +258. The 'Caps are one of two teams in all of baseball with a run differential over +200.

TOP DOG IN THE MiLB: The Tigers have the No. 6 farm system in baseball according to MLB Pipeline, and currently boast four prospects in MLB Pipeline's updated top 100: IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 2), OF Max Clark (No. 9), IF Bryce Rainer (No. 25), C/IF Josue Briceño (No. 32).

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: LHP Lael Lockhart makes a Minor League rehab assignment with the West Michigan Whitecaps after a pair of appearances in Low-A Lakeland, and tossed 3.2 scoreless innings with five strikeouts against Lansing on August 20. The product of Arkansas, who was originally selected by the LA Dodgers in the ninth-round of the 2021 MLB Draft, was traded to the Tigers in May of 2023. Lockhart began the season with the AAA Toledo Mud Hens where he posted a 3-7 record with a 5.80 ERA before being placed on the injured list. Lockhart brings a three-pitch arsenal with a fastball, splitter, and slider - with the splitter being his best offering with an over 60% whiff rate. Lockhart played parts of two seasons in '21 and '22 with Great Lakes. We also expect to see RHP Dylan Smith make a rehab assignment today as well in relief.

FOR GREAT LAKES: RHP Brooks Auger makes his 16th start of the season after tossing four scoreless frames while allowing two hits and three walks and three strikeouts as part of a 2-1 win over Quad Cities on August 20. In his first professional season after being drafted in the 6th round of the 2024 MLB Draft from baseball powerhouse Mississippi State. Auger was in a fireman role last season with the Bulldogs, appearing in 20 games with just five starts, a 1-2 record and 3.35 ERA. In 45.2 IP, he gave up just 37 hits and .215 batting average against while walking 17 and striking out 50 hitters.

- In his senior campaign with Valparaiso, Fields was named All-MVC second-team - ranking second in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (14.08) and top-15 in the NCAA in overall strikeouts (110).

2024: Fields - who garnered the nickname "surgeon" last season - dazzled with his cut-fastball and rainbow curves, going 2-5 with a 3.22 ERA while compiling 104 strikeouts in 103.1 innings pitched and holding opposing hitters to just a .223 BAA.

2023: After pitching just three scoreless innings with the Rookie League Tigers to begin the season, Fields found his groove in low-A Lakeland - going 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA while tallying 51 strikeouts through 45.1 innings pitched and missing a ton of barrels - with opposing hitters batting just .194 on the season.

2022 (Senior): In his senior season at Valparaiso, Fields began to separate himself as one of the best strikeout pitchers in college baseball, punching out 110 batters through 73.2 innings pitched - earning All-MVC Second Team honors before signing with Detroit on July 26, 2022.

More: Helped Libertyville High School to two regional championships while becoming a two-time all-conference and all-area selection. Honor roll all four years of high school. His father Timm was a 1990 Valpo graduate who also played baseball for the Crusaders. His favorite movie is Straight Outta Compton and his favorite TV Show is The Office. Never earned the win in a conference game during his four years at Valpo.

Scouting Report: Fields brings an upper-80s/lower-90s fastball that has “cutter” movement to it, as well as a high-spin curveball. The cutter-curveball combination was something that was very difficult for batters at the low-A level to catch up on.
