Starting Matchup: Lansing right-hander **Jake Walkinshaw**, coming off nine strikeouts in four innings last Sunday vs. Great Lakes, matches up with TinCaps southpaw **Noel Vela**, who started the first game of the series and held the Lugnuts to one run on five hits and one walk through six innings in an easy 7-1 TinCaps victory.

Denzel Goes Hollywood: Lugnuts OF **Denzel Clarke**, the A's No. 13 prospect, walked and struck out in two plate appearances and made a highlight-reel catch while colliding with the right field wall in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium last night, helping the American League defeat the National League, 6-4. Fellow A's prospect **Shea Langeliers** homered and caught a runner stealing and was named the Futures Game MVP.

Clean Baseball: Yesterday's doubleheader was played entirely without errors, continuing a stretch of nearly mistake-free baseball. The Nuts have now committed only four errors in their last 16 games, with 13 fully errorless games. The opposition has only committed five errors in that span, with 12 errorless games.

He Was Due: OF **Gabriel Maciel's** home run yesterday was his first since July 14, 2021, a solo home run hit as a member of the Cedar Rapids Kernels at the South Bend Cubs.

Hot in July: Infielder **Euribiel Angeles** is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with three doubles, three walks and an .842 OPS in 12 games this month, striking out just once. **Jack Winkler** (.354/.446/.521, .967 OPS, five doubles, one HR and 11 RBIs in 13 games); **Joshwan Wright** (.333/.375/.489, .864 OPS, two doubles, one triple, one HR) and **Tyler Soderstrom** (.324/.395/.730, 1.125 OPS, four doubles, one triple, three homers, 12 RBIs in 11 games) have also been tremendous this month.

Sunday Struggles: The Lugnuts have been outscored 100-53 on Sundays this year, with a .201 team batting average (and .640 OPS) compared to a .301 batting average (and .901 OPS) allowed to the opposition. The Nuts are 5-9 overall in series finales.

Among the MWL Leaders: **Tyler Soderstrom** is 2nd in the Midwest League with 61 RBIs, 4th with 147 total bases, tied for 3rd with 37 extra-base hits and 5th with 16 home runs. Others among the best in the circuit include **Kumar Nambiar**, who is 1st with 31 relief appearances, while **Trayson Kubo** is tied for 4th with seven saves.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The late Victor Sanchez, a promising 18-year-old right-hander who died in a swimming accident (hit by a boat) on 3-28-15 back home in Venezuela, tossed a nine-inning no-hitter to lead Clinton to a 1-0 win over the Lugnuts at Ashford University Field. It was the third time the Lugnuts were no-hit this season. The game was finished in two hours and one minute. Nuts catcher Santiago Nussy committed three passed balls. The game's only run was scored, however, on a one-out walk from Taylor Cole to Janelly Zorrilla, a throwing error on a pickoff, a groundout, and a Cole wild pitch. Sanchez wrapped up the no-hitter by retiring Dwight Smith, Jr. on a popout to first. Attendance: 827.

Take Two: Joined Lugnuts in initial flight from Spring Training and was scheduled to be part of the starting rotation, but was placed on Injured List on Opening Day and flew back to Arizona (elbow)... made two Arizona Complex League starts in rehab, totaling 4 2/3 IP... flew to Double-A Midland on June 24 to be ready in case of emergency, but was not needed... returned to Lugnuts on June 28, tossing three scoreless innings at Lake County.

In the Classroom: Attained Bachelor's degree in Sport Management in three years at SNHU, posting a 3.88 GPA, then attained his MBA, focusing on project management, with a 4.0 GPA... interned in the SNHU athletic department, filming sporting events... twice was named Northeast 10 (NE10) Academic All-Conference and was named Academic All-District as a grad student.

On the Field: In high school, played shortstop when not pitching, batting second in the lineup... turned in an outstanding college career at SNHU, finishing 23-5, 16 saves – 11 in 2016, 2nd most in a season in school history – 1.93 career ERA, 76 G, 22 GS, 233 IP, 168 H, 62 BB, 234 K... finished 2nd in career wins, 2nd in ERA, 4th in strikeouts and 5th in innings pitched in SNHU record books... other NE10 rivals included Lake County's Zach Hart (Franklin Pierce University) and former Lugnut and current Stockton Port Edward Baram (Adelphi)... in 2019, named D-II East All-Region First Team, ABCA East All-Region Second Team, NCBWA East All-Region Second Team, and NE10 All-Conference First Team... SNHU was ranked No. 17 in the nation, but lost in the NCAA East-Super Regional to NYIT, finishing one victory shy of punching its ticket to the D-II College World Series in Cary, N.C.

The Penmen? Yes, SNHU's nickname is the Penmen, created by the editorial cartoonist of the Union Leader, Bob Murphy. Southern New Hampshire University was originally founded as New Hampshire College of Accounting and Commerce. The "pen" refers to the quill used by an accountant of colonial New Hampshire. The current logo, however, shows a Revolutionary War patriot holding an American flag bravely rushing forward.

Into the Workforce: Currently serves as Special Project Coordinator at Advanced Theory & Performance (ATP)... first came to ATP while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in 2017, leading to post-college work opportunity.

Going Pro: Signed with the Athletics for \$1,000... debuted in 2019 with A's Green in the Arizona League, making 18 relief appearances, holding lefties to .200 avg. while righties hit .302... moved up to Stockton in 2021, converting from relief pitcher to starter, and had similar success vs. lefties (.248) compared to righties (.320)... worked this past offseason to change the spin of his slider to get more horizontal and vertical movement, seeking increased swing and miss.
