Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds go for their second series win of the season this afternoon at AutoZone Park. Another big homer from Alex Jackson helped Nashville take a 6-2 victory in yesterday's contest. Right-hander Robert Stock and Tommy Parsons are set for a rematch after they both opened the series on the mound.

Robert Stock: 33-year-old Robert Stock makes his second start of the season and series today. The right-hander took the loss in Tuesday's series opener, allowing four runs (all earned) in 2.1 innings. He went 9-10 with a 3.60 ERA (165.0 IP/66 ER) across 29 starts playing for the Doosan Bears of the Korean Baseball Organization last year. Stock has pitched in the Major Leagues with New York-NL, Chicago-NL, Boston and San Diego. He was signed by the Brewers on January 26 and invited to Major League spring training. He was originally drafted in the second round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft by the Cardinals out of the University of Southern California.

Tommy Parsons: 27-year-old Tommy Parsons gets the ball for Memphis for his second start this season. He went 4.0 innings in the series opener, allowing three runs on six hits in a no-decision. Parsons is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA (5.0 IP/3ER) across two prior appearances in 2023. Last season, he finished tied for the International League lead with 12 wins in 2022, sharing that title with Caleb Boushley. He also had the lowest BAA (.204) and ranked among league leaders in WHIP (4th, 1.17), innings (5th, 135.2) and ERA (9th, 4.31). Parsons signed as an undrafted free agent with St. Louis on June 12, 2018, out of Division III Adrian College in Adrian, Mich.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 2, Third: 2, Fourth: 1, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

A-Jax Mashing: Catcher and designated hitter Alex Jackson homered for the second time in the series with a three RBI four-bagger that gave the Sounds a five-run advantage in the third. In six games to start 2023, Jackson boasts a .667 slugging percentage and 1.042 OPS. Of his six hits, four have gone for extra bases, including his 471-foot solo blast off Tommy Parsons on Tuesday.

The Best Arounder: After keeping Memphis off the board twice in back-to-back days, the Sounds pitching staff held the Redbirds to a couple of runs in Saturday's win. As a team, Nashville boasts the best ERA at 2.18 (66.0 IP/16 ER) in Triple-A. The next closest team is Louisville with 2.86.

Stingy Sounds: Nashville pitching has held opponents to a .205 batting average (49-for-239) and .305 slugging percentage, leading the Triple-A level in both. The club also ranks third with a .319 opponent on-base percentage.

Perfect Ten...or more: The Sounds recorded a season-best 13 hits in yesterday's win with five batters contributing a multi-hit game. The Sounds are 4-1 when recording 10+ hits and have yet to allow 10 hits in a game this season.

Erceg...More Like Goose Egg: Reliever Lucas Erceg tossed two more hitless frames to finish off the Redbirds. Through three appearances this season, Erceg has yet to yield a run or hit (5.0 IP, 3 BB, 6 K, 0.60 WHIP).

Trading Zeros: The Sounds blanked Memphis 4-0 in the first game of Thursday night's doubleheader before being shut out themselves in the second game 2-0. The last time Nashville pitched a shutout in one end of a doubleheader and was shut out in the other was May 2, 2009. The Sounds fell 8-0 to the Omaha Royals in the first game of a twin bill at Herschel Greer Stadium, then returned the favor with a 4-0 win in game two.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 10 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 14 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 16 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 605-521 record during an eight-season span.
