# Jersey Shore BlueClaws (32-26/57-64) vs Aberdeen IronBirds (29-29/53-70)

Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium - Aberdeen, Maryland (opened 2002) RHP Ryan Dromboski (1-1, 4.91) vs TBA Series: Game 6 of 6 (Aberdeen leads season series 15-13 of 29)

Last Game Recap... Dante Nori had four hits and four stolen bases but Aberdeen rallied to top the BlueClaws 8-5 on Saturday night at Ripken Stadium...Aberdeen scored three times in the sevneth inning, tying the game on a double by Elis Cuevas and

Postseason Tracker...The BlueClaws have been eliminated from postseason contention and are now 7.5 games back of Greensboro with 7 games left, though technically they were eliminated on Thursday, since at that point they needed Greensboro to lose out...This would have included being swept by Hudson Valley next week...Those six HV wins would have been enough to keep the Renegades shead of Jersey Shore.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws are 2-3 this week in Aberdeen, losing on Saturday after wins on Thursday and Friday ...They won three straight from Hudson Valley to end their series last week, after losing the first three...Jersey Shore has split each of their last two series (at Wilmington, vs Hudson Valley) and they are 9-10 since August 9th

and 10 steals in his first five games with Jersey Shore...Nori came within one hit and one steal of tying the BlueClaws single-game records in both categories (Bryan Rincon had a four-steal game earlier in August)...Nori has hit safely in all five games with Jersey Shore and has reached base via a hit or a walk at least twice in four of the five games...Nori was hitting .262 at the time of his promotion from Clearwater, with 16 doubles, 11 triples, four home runs, 43 RBIs, 37 stolen bases. He hit .304 in June and .324 in July...At the time of his promotion, Nori led the Florida State League in hits with 111, was second in triples, and third in walks

Number 17... Nori, the 27th pick in last year's draft, becomes the 17th Phillies first round pick to play for the BlueClaws, following both Aidan Miller (2023 draft) and Justin Crawford (2022 draft) who were with the BlueClaws last season...Andrew Painter (2001 draft) and Mick Abel (2022 draft) were both with the

Raylin Rollin...Raylin Heredia, who homered on Wednesday and Friday, has four home runs since August 22<sup>nd</sup>...These are his first four home runs since returning from the IL on July 4th...Hereidia hit two home runs in April before two months on the Injured List, and now has six on the season after he hit eight last year with Clearwate

Aroon Heating Up...Aroon Escobar's had three hits on Friday and is 18-61 since August 9th...He now has 10 multi-hit games with the BlueClaws and Friday was his first three-hit game...Escobar played five games in Wilmington two weeks ago and had four 2-hit games, going 9-20 in the series...On August 10th, he hit his first BlueClaws home run since joining on July 8<sup>th</sup>...Escobar is the #4 prospect in the Phillies system per MLB Pipeline...Escobar was hitting .285 with 11 home runs, 42 RBIs, and 10 stolen bases with the Threshers...At the time of his promotion, Escobar was 6th in the FSL in average, T1st (with teammate Eduardo Tait) in home runs, 5th in RBIs, 1st in hits (78), and 1st in runs (52). Hit .360 with five home runs and a 1.088 OPS in April, winning Phillies Minor League Player of the Month.

Watch 'em Run...The BlueClaws stole six bases on Saturday after they stole seven bases on Thursday (their second 7 SB game of the year, 4/5/25 at HV) ...They have 22 steals this week, 36 in their last 11, and 52 in their last 17 games (since August 12th)...They are now 91-103 since the All-Star Break...Bryan Rincon (placed on 60-day IL on August 7th) has 13 in that stretch to lead the team while Avery Owusu-Asiedu has 13...John Spikerman has 11, Dante Nori (who arrived on August 25th) has 10...Aroon Escobar and Devin Saltiban each have nine.

Hip Hip, Jose...Jose Colmenares is 7-34 since joining the BlueClaws, with two home runs...He homered last Sunday against Hudson Valley against his former team, and again on Friday in Aberdeen...Colmenares hit .222 with six homers with the Renegades before being released on August 6\*\*...He signed with the Phillies and joined the BlueClaws on August 15\*\*.

Sho Time...Kodey Shojinaga had two hits on Friday, his third two-hit game with Jersey Shore...He is 7-22 since August 13th...Shojinaga, a 6th round pick last year from Kansas, is a Honolulu native that joined the BlueClaws on August 5th from Clearwater where he was hitting .229 with one home run.

Spike It Up...John Spikerman had two hits on both Wednesday and Thursday and is 16-61 since starting his BlueClaws career 0-8...He has four multi-hit games since August 8<sup>th</sup>...Spikerman is 11-11 stealing bases with Jersey Shore and 33-34 as a pro (only caught on 8/20/24 vs Dunedin)...The Phillies 3<sup>rd</sup> round pick last year (University of Oklahoma), he joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he had three home runs in 28 games while hitting ..238...Spikerman added 12 stolen bases with the Threshers...He hit .367 last year with Oklahoma and helped the Sooners reach the College World Series in 2022 as a freshman...He is the highest-drafted player from last year's draft class to reach the BlueClaws...Spikerman is the #15 prospect in the system per

Pitching Wins... Since the All-Star Break ended on July 18th (a stretch in which the BlueClaws are 24-13), the BlueClaws have a team ERA of just 3.14 (111 ER in 318 innings) including a starting

Lights Out Saul...Saul Teran got the last five outs for his 10th BlueClaws save on Friday night and is the first BlueClaw with 10+ saves as a High-A affiliate and the first BlueClaw with 10+ saves since Addison Russ (13) and Zach Warren (15) did it in 2018...He has allowed four runs in 23 innings with 15 streep Shore, adding 20 strikeouts...He gave up two earned runs in 18 innings, adding 31 strikeouts and three walks with Clearwater before originally joining the BlueClaws on June 2<sup>nd</sup>...Teran, 23, signed with the Phillies in 2021.

Hit Hit, Hettiger...Kehden Hettiger is 18-76 in August with six doubles, a triple, and a home run...He hit a 2-run triple to give the BlueClaws the lead last Saturday against Hudson Valley...He had the game winning RBI double in the win on August 14th at Wilmington...He also has four two-RBI games this month plus his eighth home run of the season, hit August 2 Brooklyn...Hettiger, a 21 year old from Sierra Canyon (CA) High School, joined the BlueClaws on April 16<sup>th</sup> and homered in his first at bat...He was an 11<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2023.

Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws trailed 3-2 entering the 8th on August 28th at Aberdeen before rallying to win...They trailed 2-1 on August 23th en route to an 8-3 win...They trailed 2-0 in two of their five wins over Hub City three weeks back, and trailed by two in two of their five wins the week prior in Brooklyn...In their 24 wins since the break, they have trailed in nine of them (biggest deficit was 3-0 down in a 5-4 win over Wilmington on July 24th).

Extra, Extra...Extra innings? No problem! After their win on August 14th at Wilmington, the BlueClaws are 8-1 in extra innings this season...They were the last team in the minors without an extra innings loss (starting 7-0), until they fell 8-5 in 10 on August 9th against Hub City

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 30 times this season, the last time on July 23rd vs Wilmington (Asheville has allowed 39 such innings), in 28 different

games over which they are 2-26... Their second win was on 6/7 at Bowling Green (allowed four runs in the seventh and won in 10)... Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5<sup>th</sup> of the seven inning game)... 16 of the 30 innings have included multiple walks.

From the Draft...The BlueClaws quickly went from having one member of the 2024 draft class (7th round pick, OF Joel Dragoo) to having eight, adding four members of that class on August 5th — OF John Spikerman (3th round, Oklahoma), C Kodey Shojinaga (6th round, Ransas), RHP Titan Kennedy-Hayes (11th round, Austin Peay State), and LHP Kevin Warunek (18th round, Longwood), and two more on August 21th — LHP Erik Ritchie (12th round, Charlotte), and LHP Erik Ritchie (19th round, East Carolina)...OF Dante Nori (1th round, 27th overall)

Balk This Way...The BlueClaws balked (Erubiel Armenta) on July 26<sup>th</sup>, their then-MiLB-leading 37<sup>th</sup> of the year (Asheville now leads with 39 balks)...They are in balking distance of the 48 set by Lynchburg in 2023, the most in minors since at least 2005...Jersey Shore has balked in nine runs this year, tied with Asheville for the most in the minors... The BlueClaws had a club record five balks on 5/9 vs Aberdeen, and four each on 6/27 and 6/29 at Brooklyn...This year, only three teams have issued at least four balks in a game, the BlueClaws three times, and Aberdeen on 5/1 at Brooklyn (4)...The BlueClaws single-season record was 20 (last year).

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes three players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Gabriel Barbosa (Minor League Rule-5 Draft from the Yankees), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft (three of which have been released with Jersey Shore - OF Elio Prado, RHP Augusto Calderon, OF Eduardo Lopez)

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9<sup>th</sup> inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10<sup>th</sup>)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the inning.

The Deadline - Tait Traded...With Eduardo Tait's trade to Minnesota, this is the fifth straight season the BlueClaws have had a player traded as part of a deadline deal, 2025 - Eduardo Tait to Minnesota (Jhoan Duran)...2024 - George Klassen to the

Angels (Carlos Estevez) and William Bergolla to the White Sox (Tanner Banks)...2023 – Hao-Yu Lee to Detroit (Michael Lorenzen)...2022 – Ben Brown to the Cubs (David Robertson), Brown had been promoted to Reading one day before the trade but his last appearance was with the BlueClaws...2021 – Tyler Burch to Baltimore (Freddy Galvis) and Kevin Gowdy to Texas (Kyle Gibson).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have two walk-off wins this year - an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 - July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommv McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show...Otto

Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6<sup>th</sup>, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.

On the Staff... Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley... Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey... Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020... Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach... 2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.

Season Notes: Made BlueClaws debut on 8/9 vs HCS and gave up two runs in 3.2 innings...Joined the BlueClaws on 8/7 from Clearwater, where he was 7-5 with a 2.63 ERA in 17 games/9 starts...His longest outing was 5.1 innings (5/17 vs LAK, one run), and he threw five innings on two other occasions...Gave up 16 earned runs, eight in two games, and one or none in his other 15.
