**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to Chesapeake Baysox, 4-3. With the score tied, 3-3, in the top of the eighth, **Braxton Roxby** issued a pair of walks to start the inning. After a sacrifice bunt, Adam Retzbach plated the go-ahead run with a groundout. In the top of the ninth, Luis Valdez led off with a single and moved to second base on a steal. Tavian Josenberger lined out to right fielder **Victor Bericoto**, who made a diving catch. The next batter, Jeremiah Jackson, lined out to Bericoto in right, who threw out Valdez at the plate attempting to score from third. Richmond was retired in order in the bottom of the ninth by Chesapeake reliever Yaqui Rivera. Chesapeake opened the scoring in the top of the first inning with an RBI single by Silas Ardoin. In the bottom of the second, **Zach Morgan** tied the score, 1-1, with a two-out RBI double. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the fourth. **Jairo Pomares** led off with a double and scored on a fielding error in right following a single by Sabin Ceballos. The Baysox tied the score, 2-2, in the top of the fifth with a triple by Josenberger. Later in the inning, Jeremiah Jackson moved Chesapeake ahead, 3-2, with an RBI single. Bericoto evened the score, 3-3, with an RBI single in the bottom of the fifth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today celebrates the 40th anniversary of the first game at The Diamond on April 17, 1985.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 8,148 fans per home game, which leads all 120 MiLB clubs.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** went 2-4 in last week's road trip to Harrisburg, dropping four-of-five after winning the opener. Their 2-10 start is the worst in team history. In 2015, the team opened with a 3-2 record before losing their next 15 consecutive games to start the year 3-17. The 2015 team finished with a 72-68 record.

**THE BAYSOX** split last week's series against the SeaWolves at home after taking two-of-three at Altoona the previous weekend to begin the season. Bowie's roster includes five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 6), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 16), RHP Trace Bright (No. 17), RHP Alex Pham (No. 26) and RHP Zach Fruit (No. 30). Five players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Bradfield (No. 3), Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), Bright (No. 25) and Pham (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Manuel Mercedes** makes his third Double-A start. In his Double-A debut on April 5 against Akron at The Diamond, he allowed five runs over 1.2 innings, walking four. He followed with four innings last Saturday at Harrisburg and allowed two runs (one earned) with no walks and three strikeouts. The 22-year-old pitcher spent all of last season with High-A Eugene, going 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA. He was tied for second in the Northwest League in games started (25) and ranked fifth in innings pitched (116.0). Mercedes spent the prior two seasons with Low-A San Jose. In 2023, he went 3-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 25 outings (21 starts). He signed with the Giants in their 2019 international class. *For more on Mercedes, see page two.*

**FOR CHESAPEAKE:** Right-hander Trace Bright makes his third start of the season and the fourth outing against the Flying Squirrels in his career. In his three previous appearances against Richmond, Bright is 0-1 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER/13.2 IP). This year, he made his season debut on April 6 at Altoona and allowed two runs over three innings in a loss. He picked up a in his last start last Saturday against the SeaWolves, throwing 5.2 hitless innings with one unearned run allowed but walked four. In parts of three seasons with the Baysox dating back to 2023, Bright is 2-12 with a 3.79 ERA in 33 outings (32 starts). Bright was selected in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of Auburn.

**HOWELL AT THE MOON:** **Carter Howell** was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). Through his first 12 games of 2025, Howell has reached base 21 times.

**BERI BOMBS:** **Victor Bericoto** hit two homers on Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg, belting a three-run homer in the first and a solo home run in the seventh. It was the first two-homer game of his Double-A career and the second of his professional career. He also had a two-homer game in 2023 with High-A Eugene. The two homers on Sunday moved Bericoto into ninth place on the Flying Squirrels' career home run list with 24. His next homer will tie him with **Frankie Tostado** for eighth with 25. In his last four games dating back to Sunday, Bericoto has five extra-base hits with two homers and three doubles.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The Flying Squirrels have collected 91 hits through their first 12 games this season, which is the third-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .235 (91-for-388), which is tied for the third-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .175 (18-for-103) with runners in scoring position, which is last in the league.

**PINCH ME!:** In the second game of last Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** hit a single while pinch-hitting in the top of the seventh inning. It was the Flying Squirrels' first pinch hit since 2023. During the 2024 season, Richmond pinch-hitters went 0-for-36 on the year with three walks and 18 strikeouts. The 36 pinch-hit at-bats ranked third in the minors on the season, trailing only Buffalo (10-for-40) and Las Vegas (13-for-38). No MiLB team in the digitized-stats era, which dates back to 2005, has more pinch-hit at-bats without a hit than last year's Richmond team.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverson Arteaga**, **Sabin Ceballos**, **Manuel Mercedes**, **Rodolfo Nolasco**, **Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

**WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?:** There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duval**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023), **Grant McCray** (2024), **Sandro Fabian** (2021) and **Trevor McDonald** (2024). **Christian Koss** (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Victor Bericoto** is tied for fourth in homers (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (6), tied for fifth in hits (13), tied for fifth in total bases (23), tied for seventh in walks (9), eighth in OPS (.958) and tied for ninth in SLG (.535). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for ninth in homers (3), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (6), tied for fifth in total bases (23) and tied for ninth in SLG (.535). **John Michael Bertrand** is tied for eighth in innings pitched (13.1).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1957:** The Richmond Virginians beat the Rochester Red Wings, 4-3, in 10 innings at Parker Field. Tommy Carroll won the game with a home run in the bottom of the 10th inning. He had signed with the Yankees in 1955 for a robust \$40,000 bonus and debuted in the majors that year at age 18. Later that same year, he became the youngest player to appear in the World Series for the Yankees, weeks after his 19th birthday. **1971:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-1, to cap a three-game, season-opening sweep. Darrell Evans drove in all three Richmond runs, including a two-run, two-out homer in the seventh to break a 1-1 tie. Luis Tiant, who had signed a 30-day minor league contract days earlier, started in his Richmond debut and allowed one run over seven innings. **1989:** Kent Mercker picked up his first Triple-A win as the Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Huns, 5-1, at The Diamond. He allowed one run over 5.2 innings. David Justice hit a two-run homer in the third. Mark Lemke had two hits and drove in a run. **1993:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 6-5, at The Diamond. After trailing, 5-0, the R-Braves tied the score, 5-5, with homers by Javy Lopez, Jose Oliva and Tony Tarasco. Ryan Klesko knocked a pinch-hit, walk-off single in the ninth. Following the game, manager Grady Little told him he was heading to the majors the next day. **2018:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 1-0, for the second straight day, marking the only consecutive 1-0 wins in franchise history. Jordan Johnson struck out five over seven innings. Luigi Rodriguez hit a solo homer.
