### KNIGHTS BLAST JUMBO SHRIMP, 16-1

The Charlotte Knights crushed the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 16-1 on Thursday at VyStar Ballpark. The Knights scored four in the first, one in the third and five in the fifth to go up 10-0. **Jared Serna** doubled in the lone Jumbo Shrimp run in the bottom of the fifth. Charlotte added six more runs in the sixth inning to make it 16-1. The loss was Jacksonville's biggest since a 17-1 defeat at Mississippi on June 24, 2018. It was the club's largest margin of defeat in a home game since April 21, 2014, when the Suns lost 17-1 to Pensacola.

### GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 396 strikeouts through 36 games, a rate of 11.0 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 40 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. In fact, the Tides' 356 strikeouts are as close to 12th-place Toledo as they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.1 average exit velocity against is the second-best figure in Triple-A.

### DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the second-fewest runs (156) in Triple-A while posting the level's best ERA (4.01). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (396), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A by turning 73.0 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only two clubs have recorded a rate of at least 71 percent this season.

### BERRY BLAST

**Jacob Berry** struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 117 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .303/.394/.444/.838, cutting his strikeout rate by more than half at 14.2 percent with just 66 over 465 plate appearances. Over his last 24 games this season, Berry is 27-for-82 (.329/.447/.476/.923) with six doubles, two home runs, 16 RBIs, 17 walks and 15 runs scored.

### STARTER FLUID

Jacksonville starting pitchers have excelled over the last 28 games, ceding only 53 runs, 48 earned, on 89 hits (5.7 H/9) in 140.0 innings for a 3.09 ERA. They have totaled 60 walks (3.9 BB/9) against 155 strikeouts (10.0 K/9). On the season, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters collectively lead Triple-A in strikeouts (187), batting average against (.184) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in innings pitched (166.2), third in ERA (3.46), fewest hits (110), fourth in GO/AO (1.19), tied for fourth in fewest runs allowed (69).

### ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs nine times in the 14 games since, awakening a previously-dormant offense. During this stretch, the club ranks fifth in Triple-A in runs (91, 6.5 per game). They also place in the top 13 in hits (6th, 136), average (8th, .271), and OBP (13th, .355). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the season's first 22 games; they are 46-for-157 (.293) in those situations over the last 14 contests.

### KEMPIRE STATE OF MIND

Jacksonville outfielder **Kemp Alderman** got off to a slow start to the season. Through his first 11 games, Alderman was just 5-for-35 (.143/.318/.200/.518) with only one triple, one RBI, eight walks, seven runs and 18 strikeouts over 44 plate appearances (40.9 percent strikeout rate). The Decatur, Miss., native has surged since then; Over his last 21 games, Alderman is a scorching 29-for-82 (.354/.404/.573/.977) at the plate with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBIs, five walks and 17 runs scored. He has fanned 27 times in 89 plate appearances, lowering his strikeout rate to 30.3 percent during this span.

### SHRIMP BITES

**Robby Snelling** is slated to make his major league debut for the Marlins on Friday against the Nationals. He will be the fifth Jumbo Shrimp alumnus in the last six days... **Bradley Blalock** struck out a career-high 12 batters at Durham in his last start.

### ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 to Milwaukee for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujanyer Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 15, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."

-Blalock struggled at Coors Field in Denver; he had a 2-4 record and 12.27 ERA in seven appearances, including six starts, at home (29.1 IP, 50 H, 40 R, 40 ER, 9 HR, 14 BB, 9 K, .388 BAA). He was slightly better in seven appearances, including six starts, on the road for Colorado, going 0-2 with a 6.44 ERA (29.1 IP, 35 H, 21 R, 21 ER, 8 HR, 9 BB, 18 K, .307 BAA).
