**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Hartford Yard Goats. Altoona went 3-3 against the Yard Goats in 2024 at Dunkin' Park.

McCade Brown, who holds a 2.76 ERA for the season, takes the ball for Hartford tonight. Brown was Colorado's 3rd round pick in 2021 out of Indiana University. Brown pitched just 6.2 innings as an underclassman at IU and missed most of 2023 and '24 recovering from Tommy John. He hails from Normal, IL, and attended Normal West High School where he also played soccer for four years.

**SHRIMPIN':** The Curve earned their second 1-0 win on a walk-off walk on Wednesday, August 6 against Hartford. Nick Cimillo drew the bases loaded free pass in the bottom of the ninth to send Altoona to a second straight win over the Yard Goats. The only other time in franchise history that the Curve won a game 1-0 on a walk-off walk was August 1, 2023 when Connor Scott drew the game-winning walk.

**TRIPLE SIANI:** Outfielder Sammy Siani matched the franchise record with 2 triples on Tuesday, August 5 against the Hartford Yard Goats. It was the second time this season he's picked up 2 triples, first instances since Jared Oliva since July 17, 2019 against Trenton.

**SO YOU LIKE PLAYING ALTOONA?:** Eight players this season have earned an Eastern League weekly or monthly award immediately after playing the Curve. CJ Kayfus (Akron, 4/13), Brandon Beck (Somerset, 4/20), Blaze Jordan (Portland, May Player of the Month), David Sandlin (Portland, 6/1), Rafael Sanchez (New Hampshire, 6/8), Trey Gibson (Chesapeake, 7/27) and Max Ferguson (Portland, 8/3) have all taken home weekly awards after playing Altoona.

**Hunter Barco** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (April 27) and Pitcher of the Month in April to account for Altoona's only honors this season.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Altoona matched a season-high with 6 extra base hits in an 11-4 win over the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday, August 3. Nick Cimillo slugged his second career 2-homer game and Termarr Johnson smashed his 9th homer of the season in the victory.

Cimillo is the first Curve batter to reach double figures in home runs this season and one of 11 Pirates minor leaguers to hit at least 11 home runs. Esmerlyn Valdez (20 w/ GBO) and Javier Rivas (18 w/ GBO) have hit the most homers by a Pirates minor leaguer this season.

**EZZY:** Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez has put together back-to-back strong performances to start Altoona's series at Portland. After recording a multi-RBI game in the series opener, Valdez picked up 3 hits in Altoona's 6-2 win over the Sea Dogs on July 30th. In his last 9 games, he is 9-for-32 with 4 RBI and 3 walks (.733 OPS).

**MY VALENTIN:** Righty Valentin Linarez has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .188 BAA this season and a 1.15 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 3 runs in 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA) and a 0.82 WHIP with 22 strikeouts.

**JUSTIN'S MEIS:** Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, Justin Meis has gone 3-2 with a 1.78 ERA with two saves in 16 games for the Curve. In that time he's recorded a 0.87 WHIP and walked just 4 batters in 25.1 innings with 30 strikeouts. Meis' 56 K's this season are 3rd-most by an Eastern League reliever.

**WHERE ARE THE BATS:** Altoona holds a .202 team batting average in the Second Half (Since June 23) the lowest among 120 full-season clubs, the team also ranks 116th in OPS (.612).

Pitching has been the team's savior of late. Altoona pitchers rank 5th among 120 minor league clubs in WHIP (1.13).

**KELLY K'S:** Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 32 batters in 30.1 innings to start July, he holds a 0.98 WHIP which ranks T-6th among qualified minor league pitchers. Kelly's 105 strikeouts this season are 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 113), tied with teammate Wilber Dotel (101).

**CLOSE WINS:** 18 of Altoona's last 23 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 51 of the team's 103 games this year (49%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

**HARBIN'S K'S:** Righty Ryan Harbin has struck out 27 batters in 16.2 innings with Altoona. Harbin ranks 8th in the Pirates system in strikeouts (73) in 47.0 innings, every other pitcher in the top 14 in the system in strikeouts has thrown at least 60.0 IP. Harbin ranks 4th among MiLB relievers with 73 strikeouts.

**ITALIANISSIMO:** Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 20 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 27 in 78.1 IP. His 2.88 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY PRESENTED BY

2021 - Akron completes a miraculous rally with a 10-run 8th inning to overcome a 3-2 Altoona lead. Bo Naylor finished off the inning with a grand slam off Oddy Nunez. Prior to the 10-run inning, Altoona pitching had not allowed more than 5 to score in one inning.
