Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP Logan Allen to the mound today, hoping to bounce back from last night's heartbreaker (1-0 after a loss this season). Omaha will counter with RHP Ronald Bolanos. The Clippers are 5-2 (.714) against right handers this year. Bolanos has never pitched against Columbus in his career (today is second career start in Triple-A).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus had not played Omaha in the regular season since 1991, when they were known as the Royals and played in the American Association. From 1988-91, the two leagues played crossover games with the Clippers winning 11 of 21 against Omaha, including six of nine in Columbus. The Clippers met the Storm Chasers in the 2011 Triple-A National Championship in Albuquerque (W, 8-3).

Checked All the Boxes

The Clippers scored in the 3rd last night and have now scored in every inning this season, but the bulk of the team's total runs have come in the 1st (6), 5th (8) and 7th (9, 77% of team runs in those three innings). On the flip side, the opponents have not crossed the plate in the 5th or 7th (got on the board for the first time in the 8th and 9th last night).

Bradley Zimmer was 1x17 going into last night's game and then reached base four times last night (2x3, BB, HBP). His multi-hit game was his first since 7/28/20 with Cleveland, against the White Sox (went 3x28 for the rest of the 2020 season). In the 2nd inning last night, Zimmer was plunked for the fourth time this season (all in the last four games) and he now leads the IL.

Double Time

Ernie Clement found the gap for a double last night, recording his fifth straight game with a double (has one double in six of seven games this year, leads the IL, owns 40% of the team total). Thanks to those doubles, Clement's only XBH, his .536SLG ranks 31st in the IL and he is one of only two players in the top 32 that has yet to hit a longball (Owen Miller ranks 18th with a .630SLG, 4XBH).

Hole in the Heart

The 3-4 spots in the Clipper order went a combined 0x24 through the first three games and 3x40 up until Tuesday night (Daniel Johnson and Bobby Bradley combined to go 3x8 on Tuesday). Last night, although Johnson went 0x4 (first hitless game of the year), Bradley was 2x4 with a HR and 3RBI (first multi-hit game of the year, second multi-RBI game in his last four).

Johnson on a Roll

After dipping below .300 with an 0x5 day on 8/8/19 vs. Pawtucket, Daniel Johnson hit safely in nine straight (.424, 14x33 from 8/9-8/18). On 8/22/19, Johnson tied his single game best with 5RBI and kicked off a streak of four straight games with an XBH (XBH in six of last nine as a Clipper). In his last 23G at Triple-A, he is hitting .337/.412/.570 with 3HR and 13RBI.

Struggles Continue

In 47 games since getting optioned on 7/16/19, **Bobby Bradley** has hit .203/.308/.430 with just 11HR and 27RBI while posting a strikeout in 37% of his PA (73 of 201). Only 11RBI since the option are on non-HR and he has accumulated 75LOB in 47 games. In 43 games immediately prior to getting recalled (5/3-6/21/19), Bradley hit .310/.373/.732 with 21HR and 44RBI (32% strikeout rate, 59K in 185PA).

Arias Too

Following a 2-run HR in his first at bat of the season, Gabriel Arias has gone 2x20 with 14 straight hitless at bats until last night. Arias is one of five regulars hitting .150 or below (Bradley Zimmer, Oscar Mercado, Bobby Bradley and Nolan Jones). Arias has drawn a walk in each of the last six though, stretching his on base streak to seven (.357OBP)

Shutting It Down

The Clipper bullpen had not allowed a run in the final third of a ballgame until letting one score in the 8th last night, followed by a pair in the 9th. Despite last night's mini-meltdown (4.0IP, 3ER), the bullpen still carries an IL-best 1.35ERA (28.1IP, 2ER, through first six games). The homer given up by Danny Young in the 9th snapped a streak of 132TBF without a homer allowed by the relief corps.

This Date in Clipper History 5/13/1984

Clipper first baseman **Dan Briggs** went 4x5 with a triple, two doubles, two runs and an RBI in Columbus' 6-5 comeback victory over Rochester. The Clippers scored a run in each of their final five at bats with Briggs driving in the game-tying run in the 8th. After the game, Briggs was quoted by the Columbus Dispatch as saying, "Two days from now, no one will remember what I did today."

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). Last year, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (926 to 895).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus (35 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB ranks 2nd in win percentage at .338 and wins, 192).

Walk-Off Magic

Columbus was 5-2 in walk-off games last season, winning four thanks to the courtesy runner in extra innings (Columbus pitching did not allow a run through first 9.0IP in extras last year). On 6/29/19 at Louisville, they suffered their first walk-off loss of the year, snapping an 81 game streak without (previous loss was 5/31/18 at Buffalo). Additionally, the Clippers ranked 1st in the IL with a 16-8 (.667) record in games decided in the last at bat.

Trending Downward

While ranking in the top three of the IL with a 4.71ERA (3rd), the 2019 Clippers registered their worst mark since the 1998 season (4.85ERA). In 2018, they ranked dead last in the IL with a 4.34ERA, marking the third straight (now fourth) season that the team ERA had gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 30 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After two straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup was atop the IL again in 2019 (1,392K, 60 more than 2nd place). They obliterated the franchise record (1,297, set in 2017; 2018's total of 1,290 was 2nd worst in franchise history), passing it on 8/22/19 (reduced strikeout rate to 8.3 per game after setting record, 10.1 prior). On the season a Clipper was punched out at least four times in a game on 15 occasions (**Eric Haase** led the team with three golden sombreros).

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Ernie Clement advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 5/8 at Louisville and the runner came around to score in the win. During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners did score, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes; won 17 in a row from 4/12-7/31/18).

International Accolades

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes, Eric Haase, Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 35-48 (.422), 5-2 with Columbus (.714).

Young Vet:

Allen is the youngest member of the Columbus rotation (will turn 24 in less than three weeks), but had as many Major League starts last month (5) as the rest of the staff had at Triple-A coming into the season (Kirk McCarty and Jean Carlos Mejia had never pitched above High-A, while Scott Moss, 4GS, and Eli Morgan, 1GS, rounded out the rotation).

After a promising start to the season (3ER in 10.0IP), Allen was chased before the end of the 3rd inning in each of his next three starts with Cleveland (13ER in 5.2IP). Through his first 57TBF, Allen was a member of the No Homers Club, giving up a longball to only Whit Merrifield on 4/5 (there's allowed to be one). Following that batter, Allen kept 47 straight in the park until allowing 6HR over 12TBF from 4/23-4/28.

Coming Around as a Clipper:

Starting with his regular season finale at Louisville on 8/29/19 and including both of his IL Playoff starts, Allen won three straight starts in a Clipper uniform, posting a 2.08ERA (17.1IP, 14H, 5R, 4ER, 7BB, 14K). However, he has allowed a solo homer in each of those 3GS. In Allen's first four starts after the trade from San Diego, he was 0-1 with a 9.92ERA (16.1IP, 26H, 19R, 18ER, 9BB, 12K), giving up 5HR.
