ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Mets No. 4 prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** launched two home runs, C **Jose Mena** and DH **Joe Suozzi** went back-to-back, and the Cyclones pitching staff tossed a shutout in Brooklyn 7-0 statement victory Sunday afternoon against Hudson Valley. RHP **Junior Santos**, who lasted just 2/3 of an inning on Tuesday, spun five scoreless with seven strikeouts. RHP **Daison Acosta**, RHP **Brendan Hardy**, and RHP **Dylan Hall** combined for four scoreless with eight strikeouts and two walks. With the victory, the Cyclones pushed their division lead to 1.5 games.

FIRST ISN'T THE WORST: The Cyclones lead the North Division by 1.5 games heading into Tuesday's new week in the league. Brooklyn has won 11 of 15 games and has a division-best +29 run differential, ranking third-highest in the league.

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** took Hudson Valley by storm last week. After a quiet 0-4 Tuesday, Ramirez finished the series 7-19 with a double, three home runs, and seven RBIs. On Sunday, Ramirez cracked two long balls, collecting his second multi-homer game this year and first with Brooklyn.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU FINISH: The Cyclones have a 3.27 ERA in July, good for the best ERA in High-A and the fourth-best in Minor League Baseball. However, the Cyclones have five blown saves, ranking as the most for a team in High-A with an ERA sub-3.50. In the month, Brooklyn starters have a 2.51 ERA (38 earned runs in 136 IP), while the bullpen has a 4.56 ERA (39 ER in 77 IP).

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has been on a tear since the start of the Greensboro series on July 12. Over his past 15 games, Consuegra is hitting .328 with a 1.029 OPS. In the span, the 21-year-old outfielder has been on base in 13 of the 15 games

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox affiliate comes to Maimonides Park for the first matchup in history. The Dash host White Sox No. 1 prospect SS Colson Montgomery, No. 8 INF Bryan Ramos, and No. 10 RHP Matthew Thompson. In total, the Dash is home to seven of Chicago's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Winston-Salem ranks seventh in OPS and ninth with a 4.79 ERA among the 12-team South Atlantic League.

and has four multi-hit efforts.

NIC KNOWS: Since June 21, 2019 draftee C/INF **Nic Gaddis** has been on base in 26 of his past 29 games, posting a .415 OBP and a .844 OPS. For his career, Gaddis has a .359 OBP and a .744 OPS.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 54 home runs in the past 62 games (0.9 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

MLB DRAFT: With Monday's deadline of signing 2022 MLB Draftees, the Mets announced the signing of 19 of their 22 picks, including their first four selections: C **Kevin Parada** (1st round - GA Tech), SS **Jett Williams** (1st round - Rockwall-Heath HS), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round - Tennessee), and OF **Nick Morabito** (2nd round comp - Gonzaga College HS).

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
