LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped Sunday's series finale to Wilmington, $5-1 .$. Brooklyn's only run came on a solo home run by 1B Mateo Gill in the bottom of the eighth...Gil and CF Omar De Los Santos each tallied a pair of knocks, accounting for four of Brooklyn's eight hits.... Sh Phillip Glasser accumulated a pair of doubles and an RBI for Wilmington, while C Maxwell Romero Jr. added a two-run double in the Sxixt...RHP Noian McLean took a no-decision for Brooklyn after hurling three just two hits and seven strikeouts in six scoreless innings.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St Lucie on Monday...INF Jefrey De Los Santos was also reinstated from the 7-day injured list, while RHP Jordan Geber was transferred to Double-A Binghamton and UT Jaylen Palmer was reinstated from their injured list...In four appearances (two starts) in the Florida State League, the 20 -year-old was $1-0$ with a 0.00 ERA (O ER in 18.2 IP)...The only run Tong has allowed is unearned, in addition to racking up 36 strikeouts to only five walks...Entering play on Tuesday, the Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (52.9\%) trailing only Ouinn Matthews (53.5\%)..Tong's $45.6 \%$ strikeout-to-walk rate is second-best in Mil B behind Wilkinson (479\%) Tong is one of three qualifiers who has not allowed an earned run and his 36 strikeouts are tied for sixth-most in the minors.

BRIGHT LIGHTS, BIG CITI: C José Hernández and OF Karell Paz were part o Brooklyn's cont portunity to hit against the New York Mets RHP Kodai Senga who was facing live hitters for the first time since being diagnosed with a torn posterior shoulder cap sule in February...Hernández described Senga as the "best pitcher he's ever faced" and his offerings as nasty ...King Henry, Sandy, and Pee-Wee were in attendance later in the day for the Mets matchup against the Chicago Cubs, as Cyclones' sea

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos enters Tuesday's contest $13-$ for-14 stealing bases to start the season...The 13 swipes are third in the South Jaylen Palmer for first on the Cyclones' all-time sto base list (50) Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for sixth across the Minors for swipes (120)... He broke INF Walter Rasquin's (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs Jordan Geber, Brett Banks, and Justin Lawson united on a one-hit shutout of Wilmington in Friday's 3-0 victory...The one-hitter marked the first time the Cyclones held an opponent to one or fewer hits since May 22,2 first one-hitter in a nine-inning game since a $6-1$ rout vs. Jersey Shore on July 16,2021 RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning that night...It was Brooklyn's second shutout of the series and third of the year after RHPs Nolan McLean, Dakota Hawkins, and Joey Lancellotti combined on Brooklyn's 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday...RHPs Brandon Sproat, Jordany Ventura, and Justin Lawson registered a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.
LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP Justin Lawson has started his 2024 with a bang...The reliever notched a three-inning save in last Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings)...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among has the lowest WHP (033) and opposing OPS (136) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (1).

GLORIOUS LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hit ters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The former Maryland Terrapin tied a cathree RBI...Entering play on Tuesday, Lorusso is tied for eighth in the SAL in slugging
