JUMBO SHRIMP STRUGGLE IN 11-3 LOSS

Garrett Hampson reached base four times but the Columbus Clippers buried the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 11-3 on Tuesday. Thanks to home runs from Jhonkensy Noel and Johnathan Rodriguez, the Clippers built a massive 8-0 lead in the first two innings. The Jumbo Shrimp finally got on the board when a run scored on a double play in the fifth. In the seventh, Bryan Lavastida added another roundtripper in a three-run frame to make it 11-1. Jacksonville plated a couple runs in the ninth inning to get the final margin to 11-3.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 62 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 95-for-254 at the plate, slashing .374/.442/.500/.942 with nine doubles, one triple. seven home runs 41 RBIs and 55 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in MiLB in average (.358) and 10th in OBP (.439). Among the 328 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the third-best swinging-strike rate (4.4%).

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 23 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 34-for-94 (.362/.439/.628/1.067) with eight doubles, one triple, five home runs and 21 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering `` multi-hit contests. His 23-game on-base streak is the longest by a Shrimp hitter since Justin Twine's 27-game run from July 19-August 19, 2018. Including Johnston's time with Pensacola in 2023, the Tacoma, Wash., native has driven in 104 runs, tied for the most of any MiLB player, in 106 games.

'PEN PALS

Over the last two weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 13 games since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 21 runs 17 earned on 37 hits (7 8 H/9) in 42 2 innings for a 3.59 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 56 batters (11.8 K/9) against 27 walks (5.7 BB/9).

HIGH FIVE!

Jacksonville posted just three runs offensively on Tuesday at Columbus, but the club has still tallied at least five runs in 13 of their last 19 games. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp lead the IL in hits (193) while ranking second in both batting average (.291) and on-base percentage (.391), tied for sixth in doubles (35), eighth in OPS (.831) and eighth in runs scored (113, 5.9 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp were hitting just .256/.341/.417/.758 with 525 runs scored in 101 games (5.2 per game) as a team prior to this run.

IFRARSSIC PARK

Jacksonville outfielder Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the season. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 22 games, however, the 26-year-old is 20-for-72 (.278/.418/.542/.960) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 18 walks (19.8 BB%). Encarnacion has trimmed his strikeout rate to 35.2 percent (32 in 91 PA) during this recent hot stretch.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In his 43 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 63-for-177, hitting .356/.401/.486/.887 with 13 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 18 RBIs and 31 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 13 multi-hit games in his last 31 games, batting 51-for-137 (.372/.416/.504/.920) with 10 doubles, one triple, two homers, 14 RBIs and 25 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 265 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (45.8 percent). His 29.3 percent line drive rate is 20th.



	ABOUT EDWARD	

-Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings.

-Once ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miami for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He was also a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of *The Athletic*, 34th by *MLB* Pipeline and No. 69 by both Baseball Prospectus and Baseball America.

-The Marlins have been fairly aggressive with Cabrera, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League rather than the Dominican Summer Legaue. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

2023 SEASON

-Posted a 2.91 ERA in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a 6.28 ERA.

-Cabrera was optioned to Jacksonville on August 1.

-Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings of one-hit ball with 10 strikeouts on August 12 against Norfolk.

2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a 1.49 ERA in seven road starts versus a 4.58 ERA in seven starts at home.

2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and ninth in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.

-On May 1, Cabrera tied Jupiter's franchise record with 13 strikeouts in a game while also netting a career high of his own. He wound up yielding just two hits over 6.2 scoreless innings against the Bradenton Marauders.

-Cabrera missed 22 games while on the injured list from August 3 through August 25. He was activated on August 26 prior to a start against Mobile.
