### PITCHING CARRIES RIDERS TO CLOSE WIN OVER HOOKS IN SERIES FINALE:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the Corpus Christi Hooks 2-1 from Whataburger Field on Sunday evening. Frisco (37-20) was led by their pitching on Sunday with starter **Emiliano Teodo** striking out seven across four innings while allowing just one run on five hits. **Steven Jennings** (4-0) then retired all nine he faced across his three innings of work before **Robby Ahlstrom** threw the last two frames to earn his fourth save. The Riders jumped on the board first in the fourth inning with a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single, scoring Liam Hicks. Corpus Christi (22-35) then immediately tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fourth. With the game tied at 1-1 in the seventh, **Abimelec Ortiz** delivered the go-ahead RBI single to put Frisco ahead. Both hits for the Riders all game were RBI singles. Drew Strotman (3-1) took the loss in relief for Corpus Christi. Frisco now leads the Texas League South by 4.0 games with 12 games remaining in the first half after a Midland win on Sunday.

### PLAYOFFS IN SIGHT:

Entering into Tuesday's game, the RoughRiders are tied for the best record in all of Double-A at 37-20 and they have a season-best 4.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. With a magic number of nine, the RoughRiders are looking to make the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and win the first half for the first time since 2014.

### FIRING BLANKS:

The Riders had their scoreless innings streak snapped at 22-consecutive scoreless innings after the second inning yesterday, including back-to-back shutouts for the first time this season. The franchise record is 30-consecutive scoreless innings, which Frisco accomplished last year from July 2nd through July 5th. In their last four games, the Riders have allowed just two earned runs over 35.0 IP (0.51 ERA). Frisco has the second-best ERA in the Texas League during the month of June, at 2.61 through the first eight games.

### HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 23 games, batting .364 (28-for-77)/.469/.506/.975 with five doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs, 12 walks, eight strikeouts and 14 runs. In his last 11 games, he is hitting .400 (16-for-40)/.500/.650/1.150. On Friday, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

### CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, **Frainer Chavez** just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 48th game of the season with the Riders on Sunday, he is on fire at the plate. Over his last nine games, he is hitting .441 (15-for-34)/.472/.529/1.001 with a double, a triple, a walk, five steals and nine runs scored. In his last 22 games, he is slashing .333 (25-for-75)/.390/.440/.830.

### MAY FLOWERS:

With the month of May coming to an end, the RoughRiders have tied their franchise record for most wins in May with 19 (third time in franchise history, tying 2003 and 2010). Their 19 wins were the most in the Texas League and tied for the most in Double-A. Frisco's 3.45 team May ERA was second in the Texas League and their bullpen has dominated to the tune of a 2.62 ERA. **Emiliano Teodo** went 3-0 with a 0.82 ERA over four starts in the month.

### ROAD TRIP OF YOUR DREAMS:

The RoughRiders just finished a two-week, 13-game road trip against the San Antonio Missions and the Corpus Christi Hooks. They went 10-3 on the trip, Frisco is now 24-6 combined against their two division opponents and 13-14 against everyone else in the Texas League this season. On the mound against Corpus Christi and San Antonio, the Riders have a 2.68 ERA (78ER/262.0 IP).

### RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 22 games, they are 14-8, but are hitting .242 (41-for-169) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .276 with RISP.

### MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. In his last 19 games, Rodriguez is hitting .348 (24-for-69) with eight multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 13 RBIs, five walks, nine runs scored and two steals. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .283 and OPS from .371 to .811 over the last 19 games.

### ABOUT JOSH

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Ala., and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate.

### 2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

### 2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

### 2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
