ALBUOUEROUE ISOTOPES (22-47) AT OKLAHOMA CITY BASEBALL CLUB (38-31)

LHP Kyle Freeland (0-0, 2.25) vs. RHP Ben Casparius (2-1, 3.41)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque and Oklahoma City meet_for the fourth and final series of the year between the clubs ... The Baseball Club has already clinched the season series with 14 wins, the most in a season by Oklahoma City against the Isotopes ... Rockies' lefty Kyle Freeland is set for his second rehab start while Ben Casparius is slated to start for Oklahoma City.

ATTENDANCE: Over 39 home openings, the Isotopes have tallied the second-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball and most in the Pacific Coast League (256,5334). Highest: Dayton, 265, 131.

SERIES: With the triumph Sunday, the Isotopes claimed their first series victory of the year, taking four of six games, and first since Sept. 12-17, 2023, at El Paso, 12 sets. Albuquerque has not won a series against another opponent since Aug. 22-26, 2023, at Oklahoma City, won five of six.

NOW THAT'S QUALITY: Tanner Gordon spun the sixth Isotopes quality start of the season Sunday, first since June 8 at Sacramento (Karl Kauffmann), improving the club to 3-3 in such contests. He tossed 6.0 frames of two-run ball, the 10th Isotopes start allowing two runs or fewer (min. 5.0 IP), four against ELP.

B2B: Hunter Stovall and Sam Hilliard hit back-to-back homers in the eighth inning Sunday, third time in 2024 the Isotopes have gone back-to-back (also: Hilliard, Hunter Goodman, April 23 vs. OKC and Michael Toglia, Aaron Schunk May 9 at ELP).

DINGERS: The Isotopes have hit multiple homers in two-straight contests for the fourth time in 2024, first since May 8-9 at ELP.

DUBS: Albuquerque has 11 wins against El Paso on the year and 11 against every other first half opponent.

OPENING FRAME: The Isotopes plated four runs in the opening frame Sunday, the second-most runs in the first inning this year (most: seven, April 20 at El Paso).

MARGINS: With the six-run victory Sunday, five of the Isotopes 22 wins on the year have come with a margin of six or more.

ON THE BUMP: Albuquerque pitching limited El Paso to three runs Sunday, the ninth time in 2024 the staff has held an opponent to three tallies or fewer.

ISOTOPES ALL-TIME RBI LEADERS: Jason Wood, 328 (2003-06, 2008); Jordan Patterson, 229 (2016-18); **Coco Montes**, 212 (2022-24); Mike Tauchman, 211 (2016-18); **Sam Hilliard**, 210 (2019, 2021-24) SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard tallied two hits, a homer, RBI and a walk Sunday, his 25th multi-hit contest of the year and third in his last five games. Has a six-game hitting streak, slashing .385/.448/.731 with a double, triple, two homers and five RBI Over previous 12 games, batted .100 (5x50).

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes leads the Isotopes with 27 multihit performances ... His five RBI Saturday tied a season-high for an Isotopes player, reached on three previous instances.

Julio Carreras has a five-game hit streak, slashing .500/.526/.667 with three doubles and one RBI ... Tied careerhigh with four hits Saturday (also: Aug. 4, 2023 at Reading). He is 11-for-25 with three multi-hit performances in his last seven games, improving his season average from .187 to .217.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk registered two RBI Sunday, his eighth multi-RBI game of 2024 and third in his last four games ... Has a hit in six of last seven games (.379, four doubles, a triple, two homers and nine RBI) ... His 23 doubles is T-2nd-most in all of MiLB.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron went 2-for-4 Sunday with two RBI, his sixth multi-hit game of the year and second-straight (first back-to-back multi-hit game of 2024). Tallied fifth multi-RBI game.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver went 2-for-4 Sunday with a triple and RBI, his 11th multi-hit contest of the year and second in three games. Has a four-game hit and RBI streak. During stretch is slashing .429/.400/.1.000 with a triple, two homers and six RBI. ... First four-game RBI streak since July 16-26, 2022

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall recorded two hits Sunday, including his fourth homer, for his seventh multi-hit contest of the year. Has two homers in his last four games and three in last nine. Has a four-game hitting streak, slashing .400/.444/.867 with two doubles, two homers and five RBI.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo has just one multi-hit game in his last 18 contests (June 1 vs. Oklahoma City).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 4th in average (.313) ... Aaron Schunk is 2nd in doubles (23) and T-4th in XBH (32) ...
Coco Montes is 2nd in average (.331) and hits (81), T-3rd in triples (5), 5th in OPS (.952) and OBP (.409), 6th in total bases (133), 7th in slugging (.543) T-8th in walks (35), T-9th in RBI (46) ... Sam Hilliard is T-2nd in runs (53), T-4th in XBH (32), 5th in total bases (135), T-6th in homers (13), 7th in walks (36), T-7th in triples (4), T-9th in hits (73) and 10th in slugging (.529) ... Julio Carreras is 5th in SB (19).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

- Seventh in club history with a 4.80 home ERA among Rockies with 50 or more starts in Denver.
- Leads the NL with 103 opponent grounded into double plays over the past six seasons (2018-23).
- Finished fourth in 2018 NL Cy Young Award voting, the second Rockies pitcher to ever finish among
- the top five in balloting, joining Ubaldo Jiménez (third, 2010).
- His 2018 ERA of 2.85 ERA (202.1 IP, 64 ER) was the lowest in a full season in franchise history and
- the fifth-lowest in the NL for the season.
- Pitched 8.1 no-hit innings on July 9, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, the longest no-hit bid for a Rockies pitcher
- at Coors Field in franchise history.

• Made second rehab start, first for Isootpes, June 13 vs. El Paso and did not factor into the decision ... Tossed 4.0 frames of one run ball, allowing three hits, a homer and one walk with four punchouts ... Induced four groundouts and one flyout over 13 batters faced with five swings and misses ... Faced minimum in first, second and fourth frames after doubeplay (first), outfield assist (second) and doubleplay (fourth) ... Allowed solo homer to Kevin Plawecki in third ... Retired four of next five batters (walk)
