#### JACKSONVILLE OUTLASTS GWINNETT IN 11 INNINGS

The Jacksonville bullpen yielded just one earned run in 7.0 innings on Saturday to outlast the Gwinnett Stripers 8-7 in 11 innings. Bryan Hoeing, Josh Simpson, Anthony Maldonado (1-0) and Zach Leban combined to yield only one hit in 5.0 shutout innings as Jacksonville (1-1) notched their first victory of the 2023 campaign. With the score deadlocked at seven, Peyton Burdick began the inning at second and moved up to third on a base hit by Jacob Amaya. Jake Mangum followed with a sac fly to give Jacksonville an 8-7 advantage. Leban finished off the Stripers in the bottom of the 11th for his first save.

#### ACT ONE: SCENES ONE & TWO

Jacksonville and Gwinnett have played two thrillers in Lawrenceville to begin the 2023 season. In Friday's series opener, Braden Shewmake launched a three-run walk-off home run for the Stripers to win 8-5. The Jumbo Shrimp responded Saturday with a last at-bat win of their own, this time taking the 11-inning affair 8-7. Over the course of the two games, half-innings have ended with five different lead changes and three ties.

#### JUST WIN, BABY

The Jumbo Shrimp have earned back-to-back winning marks for the first time since 2013-14. Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) mark in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) record in 2022, Jacksonville's 155 wins over the last two seasons are the club's most in consecutive campaigns since the 163 victories piled up by the 2009-10 squads. In particular the last two years, Jacksonville has excelled on the road, with winning records in each campaign. Prior to 2021, the club's last winning record away from home was in 2014, finishing with a 42-28 road record.

#### GONE FISHIN

Since 2021, their first season in their return to the Triple-A level, Jacksonville owns a 25-11 record against the Gwinnett Stripers. That .694 winning percentage is the second-highest against any opponent they've faced over this span. Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp clocked 24 home runs against the Stripers, third-most against all opponents. The pitching staff also owned Gwinnett, holding them to a .215 batting average against, the second-lowest among 2022 opponents, and a 2.99 staff ERA that was the best against 2022 adversary.

#### ROAD WARRIORS

Despite owning a home record of 38-37 (.507) in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp were world beaters on the road, posting a 42-32 (.568) record away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Of those 42 road wins, Jacksonville had 19 wins on the road against IL West opponents like Gwinnett. In 2022 contests away from 121 Financial Ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .263/.337/.453. Jacksonville's .263 batting average on the road ranked third in the IL and their .790 OPS placed second in the circuit. In comparison, the club ht .250/.330/.398 at home. Of the 744 runs the Jumbo Shrimp scored in 2022, 409 came on the road (55.0 percent).

#### GOING, GOING..GONE!

Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp clubbed 183 home runs, which ranked sixth in the International League while also placing as the most in a season for a Jacksonville club since a franchise record of 200 in 1996. In fact, Jacksonville has eclipsed 100 long balls in a season just twice in the previous seven campaigns. Jacksonville particularly got hot at the back end of last season, as they smashed 47 home runs in their last 43 games. The Jumbo Shrimp hit most of their long balls on the road last year, launching 107 of their 183 home runs (58.5%) away from 121 Financial Ballpark, which was the highest home run total on the road in the IL.

#### WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Jumbo Shrimp manager Daren Brown returns for his second year as Jacksonville's skipper. Brown holds a 1,341-1,326 (.503) record as a minor league manager. The Holdenville, Okla., native is in the midst of his third stint as a Triple-A skipper. The 55-year-old piloted Triple-A Tacoma in Seattle's organization from 2007-13 and again in 2019, tallying 494 victories, which marks the most wins of any manager in Rainiers franchise history. Brown led Tacoma to consecutive division titles in 2009 and 2010, and during that latter season, helped the Rainiers win the franchise's first outright Pacific Coast League Championship since 1969.

#### **SHRIMP BITES**

Thirteen players boast MLB experience and 17 have previously played with Jacksonville...Last night's 8-7 win took 3:21, the fourth-longest game since 2022.

#### **ABOUT DEVIN**

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eliqible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

#### 2023 SEASON

### 2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022,[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in Jacksonville.

#### 2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends
