**LAST APPEARANCE:** 6/1 @ ROC...made 11<sup>th</sup> start of the season, his second of the road trip and second against Rochester...allowed five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings...five runs ties season-high from 5/5...three runs scored in the first inning...allowed a pair of triples between the first and second innings...surrendered solo home run in the fourth inning to Jack Dunn...primarily threw fastball (42%/35 pitches)...took second loss of the season in 11-8 Saints loss.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 5/25 @ BUF...made 10<sup>th</sup> start of the season, throwing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just one hit and issuing one walk while striking out eight...retired the first 10 batters he faced, including seven in a row by strikeout, setting a new franchise record with seven straight strikeouts, surpassing Joe Ryan (8/20/21 vs Iowa) and Ronny Henriquez (5/28/22 v Indianapolis)...only baserunners allowed came when he gave up a one-out single in the fourth, followed by a walk...was his second time in three starts throwing 5.0+ shutout innings...his fourth start with eight-or-more strikeouts. start with eight-or-more strikeouts...received first win of the season in 7-0 Saints victory.

**MOWING THEM DOWN:** In his start on May 22, 2024 in Buffalo, Festa retired the first 10 batters that he faced. After getting a flyout to center field to start the game, he then struck out the following seven batters, setting a new franchise record. With two outs in the third, Steward Berroa slapped a ball to second base to snap the streak. His seven consecutive punchouts surpassed Joe Ryan (8/20/21 vs Iowa) and Ronny Henriquez (5/28/22 v Indianapolis).

A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES: In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

**ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!:** On July 24, 2022, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other.
