YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels picked up their fifth straight win, topping the RubberDucks, 5-4, in 10 innings. **Shane Matheny** won the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th inning. Akron opened a 3-0 lead in the fourth inning. **Sean Roby** hit RBI singles in the fifth and seventh innings to close the score to 3-2. **Simon Whiteman** hit a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the eighth to tie the score at 3-3. In the top of the ninth, Bo Naylor worked a bases-loaded walk to put Akron ahead, 4-3. With two outs and an 0-2 count in the bottom of the ninth, **Frankie Tostado** hit a single to score **Mike Gigliotti** and tie the game, 4-4. **Chris Wright** held the RubberDucks off the scoreboard in the top of the 10th inning. Richmond starter **Kai-Wei Teng** set season highs with six innings pitched and nine strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first meeting between the two clubs this year and the RubberDucks' only trip to The Diamond in 2022. The Flying Squirrels visit Akron twice, a six-game series from May 31-June 5 and another six-game set from August 23-28.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five straight games and six of their last seven overall. Last week, they took five games in the six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond after dropping four of six on the road in Erie the previous week, their only series loss so far this year. They opened the season taking two in a three-game series at Bowie from April 8-10 before winning four games in a six-game set against Altoona in their first homestand from April 12-17.

THE RUBBERDUCKS had won four straight and six of eight prior to dropping the series opener on Tuesday night. They won four of six in last week's home series against the Curve. On the year, the RubberDucks have won their two home series and lost their two road series. Akron's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects, including No. 1 George Valera, No. 2 Daniel Espino, No. 4 Brayson Rocchio, No. 8 Logan Allen, No. 9 Jose Tena, No. 11 Tanner Burns, No. 16 Bo Naylor and No. 23 Xzavion Curry. Last season, the RubberDucks finished the season with a 73-46 record before sweeping the Baysox, 3-0, in the Double-A Northeast Championship Series.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his fifth start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday against the Baysox and allowed three runs over 4.2 innings with a season-high seven strikeouts and a season-high five walks. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. *For more on Brickhouse, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Xzavion Curry makes his fourth start and fifth overall appearance. He last pitched on Thursday against the Curve and surrendered four runs in three innings in a no-decision. He opened the season out of the bullpen on April 9 and struck out seven over 4.1 scoreless innings at Erie. After allowing six runs in 4.2 innings against Reading on April 15, he worked 4.2 innings with a season-high eight strikeouts on April 22 at Bowie. Curry was drafted in the seventh round by Cleveland in 2019 out of Georgia Tech. He missed the 2019 professional season with shoulder inflammation and the 2020 season was canceled, delaying his professional debut until 2021. Last year in his first professional season played, Curry climbed three levels, pitching for Low-A Lynchburg, High-A Lake County and Double-A Akron. He finished the year ranked third in the minors in K/9 IP (7.7), sixth in BB/9 IP (1.5) and sixth in ERA (2.30).

WINNING EARLY: The Flying Squirrels are sitting in first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, a game over second-place Harrisburg. Richmond's 14-8 record is tied for the best start in franchise history through 22 games, even with the team's start to the 2018 season. The team's best record through 23 games is 14-9, which occurred in 2010, 2018 and 2021.

COMEBACK KIDS: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in seven of their 14 wins. Richmond trailed before coming back to win in five straight victories from April 13-21. On April 13, the fell behind, 5-1, to the Curve before scoring nine runs in a 10-6 win. On April 14, Altoona pulled ahead 3-0 in the first before Richmond rallied and took the lead with a two-run homer by **Sean Roby** in the seventh. On April 16, the Curve pulled ahead, 4-0, before Richmond scored the next eight runs to win, 8-4. On April 17, Altoona led, 2-1, before the Flying Squirrels tied the game in the eighth and later won on a walk-off grand slam by **Will Wilson** in the bottom of the 10th. In the second game of a double-header on April 21 at Erie, the SeaWolves scored two in the first inning and the game was tied, 3-3, in the last frame before the Flying Squirrels plated five runs in the top of the seventh. On April 30, the Baysox took an early 1-0 lead before the Flying Squirrels scored the next three runs to win 3-1. On Tuesday, the RubberDucks opened a 3-0 lead in the fourth and pulled ahead in the top of the ninth, 4-3, before **Frankie Tostado** tied the game in the bottom of the ninth and **Shane Matheny** hit a walk-off single in the 10th.

PACKING THE HOUSE: On the year, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (77,200) and average attendance (5,938). Richmond is 10th of the 120 minor league teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

LOOKING FOR HITS: Over a five-game stretch from April 24-29, the Richmond offense combined to hit .171 (25-for-146), which ranked last in the Eastern League. During that span, the Flying Squirrels hit three homers. Over the last three games since Saturday, the Flying Squirrels lead the league with a .290 batting average (29-for-100) and are second with 17 runs scored.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 29 home runs this season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is leading the league lead with eight homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 182 home runs.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last five games since last Thursday, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a league-best 1.76 ERA (9ER/46.0 IP) with 50 strikeouts. The Richmond pitching staff has held the Baysox and RubberDucks to a .206 batting average the last five games. In that span, Bowie and Akron have hit 3-for-46 (.065) with runners in scoring position and left 45 runners on base.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** is leading the Eastern League with eight home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on Friday night, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He hit five home runs in the first home series of the season against Altoona from April 12-17 and he homered twice in last week's set against Bowie. He has hit more homers at home than the team's leaders in 2010 (3), 2012 (6), 2015 (6), 2017 (6) and 2019 (4).

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .444 (16-for-36) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs on his current nine-game hitting streak, which is currently the longest active streak in the league. Tostado has picked up multiple hits in five of his last six games since last Wednesday. Last year, Tostado finished the season ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 63 RBIs, which was fifth in the Giants system. Tostado hit 14 homers last year, which was tied for 10th-most in a season in Flying Squirrels history. This season, Tostado is ranked second in the Eastern League in batting average (.351) and third in hits (26).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the league in home runs (8), tied for fourth in RBIs (17), sixth in SLG (.614), ninth in OPS (.968), third in total bases (43) and tied for 10th in runs scored (14). **Frankie Tostado** is second in batting average (.351), third in hits (26) and eighth in total bases (38). **Will Wilson** is tied for ninth in walks (14) and tied for sixth in runs scored (16). **Jake Dahlberg** is sixth in ERA (1.71) and tied for second in innings pitched (26.1). **Ryan Walker** is leading the league in wins (5) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for third (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for fifth in strikeouts (30) and tied for fifth in innings pitched (24.0). **Chris Wright** is tied for fourth in saves (3).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
