Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the fourth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with nine at each location. Reading won the season-series over Somerset in 2023 10-8, which included a 2-4 record at home and 8-4 on the road. Matt Osterberg gets the start for Reading today, opposite Blane Abeyta for Somerset.

Four in a Row

Reading remained hot with a 5-0 win over Somerset on Thursday Night. Caleb Ricketts and Baron Radcliff had three hits each. Ricketts also had two doubles and Radcliff hit his first home run of the season to right field. Robinson Pina started and went six-shutout innings for his second win of the season. The Fightin Phils have now won four-straight games, something they did three times last season. With a win tonight, Reading will match its longest win streak of 2023 of five, which they did twice last year and most recently from Aug. 1-5, 2023 at Hartford.

Robinson Rolling

Robinson Pina stayed hot Thursday night with his second-straight win. He tossed a season-high six innings, which also marked the longest start by a Fightin Phils pitcher this season. Outside of a poor start on Apr. 13 vs Portland, Pina has thrown 16 IP, and allowed 12 hits, three ER and struck out 14 batters.

First Zero of the Season

Reading pitching combined for its first shutout of the 2024 season. It marked the R-Phils first shutout since Aug. 27, 2023 at Harrisburg. Tristan Garnett was a part of both of those shutouts as well. In total, the Fightin Phils had three shutouts last season, with the first not coming until May 28 vs Harrisburg.

Carson on a "Tear"lor

Carson Taylor's scorching-hot start to the season is continuing this week, as he is 4-11, with a triple, three RBI and two runs scored. His .364 average is the best in the Eastern League. His 17 RBI lead the league and also rank tied for second in all of Double-A. He is additionally hitting .667 (10-15) with RISP, which is the best in the Eastern League, best in Double-A and second in all of Minor League Baseball. With RISP, Taylor also has: 3 HR (5 XBH) and 16 RBI. On Wednesday, Taylor stole two bases, which was both a season and career-high for him.

Swiper Yes Swiping

On Wednesday, Reading stole a season-high five bases, and added two on Thursday. Reading's 26 stolen bases this season ranks tied with Somerset for second in the Eastern League. This comes after Reading finished 10th in the league last season in stolen bases. Over the last seven days, Reading leads the Eastern League with 15 stolen bases.

Caleb Catching Fire

Caleb Ricketts recent hot stretch continued with three hits, two runs and two doubles on Thursday night. His two doubles marked a season-high for him and the most by any R-Phil in a single game in 2024. Ricketts is on a four-game hit streak and is slashing .500/.529/.688, with a 1.217 OPS over that stretch. He also has three doubles, five runs scored, a RBI and stolen base over that span, dating back to Apr. 19.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 26, 1997: At Reading, the Phillies trail 10-0 and don't have a hit going into the bottom of the 5th inning, but rally to stun Norwich, 11-10. Matt Guiliano (who hadn't homered in his previous 250 Double-A at-bats) and Steve Carver each hit grand slams, with Carver's tying the game in the 9th. Marlon Anderson caps the five-run 9th with the game-winning RBI single.

Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters today with a 7-11 record, after going 3-3 vs Hartford last week. After this week, the Patriots host New Hampshire. Somerset finished 84-53 last season and ultimately lost to Binghamton in the Eastern League Semifinals. Nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects are on Somerset's roster, featuring: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (4), Brock Selvidge (10), Ben Rice (12), Agustin Ramirez (21), Zach Messinger (22), Trystan Vrieling (23), Jack Neely (25), Tyler Hardman (26) and Danny Watson (28).

Patriots Pitcher

Righty Blane Abeyta makes the start tonight for Somerset. It will be Abeyta's fourth start of the season, and he is 0-3 with a 9.64 ERA. He's allowed 25 hits and has eight strikeouts and four walks over 14 innings pitched. In his last start on Saturday against Hartford, he suffered his third-straight loss, going six innings and allowing five runs on 10 hits, with three strikeouts. Abeyta spent all of last season with Somerset, going 8-8, with a 5.67 ERA across 25 games (23 starts). He spent all of 2022 with High-A Hudson Valley and split his first pro season in 2021 between the FCL-Yankees and Single-A Tampa. The Yankees signed Abeyta as an unrafted free agent in 2020 out of the University of Nevada-Reno.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Earned Opening Night start Apr. 5 at Bowie. Was efficient over 3.2 innings against Baysox, allowing just one-earned run and two hits. Second start of season was another strong one Apr. 12 vs Portland. Allowed three runs, but just one was earned. Surpassed Opening Night strikeout total with five puchours in total. Was efficient on Apr. 12, throwing 66% of pitches for strikes, while scattering six hits. Followed up with second-straight five-inning start Apr. 18 at Binghamton. Matched seaso-high with six hits allowed, and surrendered season-high to date two-earned runs. Second-straight start allowing no walks, and threw strikes on 74% of pitches. Placed on Development List Apr. 19 and activated prior to start on Apr. 26.
