LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped back-to-back contests for the first time this season, falling to Hudson Valley, 8-3, on Thursday night...Renegades LF **Jackson Castillo** recorded 6 RBI thanks to a pair of bases clearing doubles in consecutive innings...Still, RHP **Noah Hall** was solid in his second start of the season, tossing 4.2 innings of one hit ball, giving up only one unearned run...Brooklyn pitchers committed 10 walks on the night, eight of which were surrendered by the bullpen...The Cyclones were rendered hitless from the third inning all the way to the bottom of the ninth...Despite the loss, 1B **Estarling Mercado** pieced together his second three-hit outing of the season, finishing 3-for-4 with a run scored.

RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY: Friday's contest between Brooklyn and Hudson Valley was postponed due to rain and fog in the Coney Island area...The rain out was the Cyclones' first since August 9, 2024, vs. Hudson Valley...Saturday's twinbill is Brooklyn's first since August 11, 2024, vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones swept the double-dip, winning Game 1, 4-2, and Game 2, 3-1...In 2024, the Cyclones were 7-5 through 12 games that were part of doubleheaders and 5-1 in twinbill games at Maimonides Park.

THE LONG HALL: RHP **Noah Hall** is off to a wonderful start to 2025...Through two starts, the 2023 draftee is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA, 11 strikeouts and only four hits given up...The right hander tossed 4.2 innings of 1-run ball in a loss to Hudson Valley on Thursday...The righty punched out a career-high 8 batters, and gave up only 1 hit...All this came after Hall spun arguably his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...Hall surrendered only 3 hits, and gave up just 1 run...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SOARIN' SERRANO: OF **Eli Serrano III** has impressed to begin his High-A career...On top of making an outstanding catch colliding into the left-field wall on Thursday night that was featured on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10, the 2024 4th-round selection is 8-for-21 at the plate...3 of his 8 hits have gone for extra bases, including 2 home runs, one of which was a mammoth blast to right-center field, no small feat at Maimonides Park...The N.C. State product has also displayed a keen eye at the plate, drawing 7 walks through 6 games...Serrano III is tied for the league lead in home runs and tied for 2nd in walks entering play on Saturday.

ROTATION ROCKS!: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite after the first full turn through the rotation...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.10 ERA through the first 6 games of the season...The group has permitted just 6 ER over 25.2 innings...Under the leadership of first year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 33:9 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.10 ERA is good for 3rd in the South Atlantic League, while the 'Clones starters' WHIP of 1.05 checks in at 3rd in the circuit.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** is off to a scorching start in 2025...The Bronx native is 1 of 2 players on the Cyclones with multiple home runs...Suero is a blistering 8-for-21 at the dish, with 6 extra-base hits, 8 runs batted in, and boasts an impressive 1.266 OPS.

THOR'S HAMMER: LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024 in his season debut last Sunday...The Grand Canyon University product collected his first win of the year, behind 5.0 shutout innings against Wilmington...Thornton allowed only 2 base hits and 1 walk, while striking out a career-high 8 Blue Rock batters.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In Saturday's lopsided victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win... Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...3B **Richard Lucas** went 5-for-6 at the dish, while CF **Travis Tajjeron** was a perfect 4-for-4 with 5 RBI...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

REIM TIME!: It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer**...Through six games, the California native is an impressive 7-for-26 at the plate with 8 RBI, 5 runs scored, 2 doubles and a triple...The 2022 draftee is tied for 3rd in circuit in RBI (8) and tied for 5th in the league in doubles (2)...Reimer collected more RBI through his first 2 games played this season than he logged all of last year through 25 games scattered across three different levels.

BOARDWALK BENGEE: OF **Carson Benge** started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate...Benge is 3-for-12 with a double, 2 RBI and 5 walks through his first 4 games played...The 2024 1st-round draftee by the Mets made Wilmington pitchers work over the weekend, drawing 3 free passes, while going 2-for-6 at the plate in the couple of games of the season...The Oklahoma State product laced a double to left field last Friday for the first High-A hit of his career.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones welcome in the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first installment of the SAL Subway Series of 2025...The Yankees High-A affiliate went 2-1 against Jersey Shore to start the new year, including an 8-7 walk-off victory last Saturday...Hudson Valley boasts 8 top 30 Yankees prospects including INF **George Lombard Jr.** (2), RHP **Ben Hess** (4), RHP **Bryce Cunningham** (6), RHP **Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz** (8), RHP **Cade Smith** (16), RHP **Carlos Lagrange** (19), LHP **Kyle Carr** (20) and INF **Roc Riggio** (27)...Riggio and Smith are currently on the injured list.

2024 IN REVIEW: Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all-time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

FAMILIAR FACES: 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro**, who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer**, who suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last two years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: 7 members of the Mets' 2024 draft class begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP **Ryan Lambert** was the lone '24 draftee that returned to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st-round selection OF **Carson Benge**, 2nd-round pick LHP **Jonathan Santucci** and 4th-rounder OF **Eli Serrano III** all made their High-A debuts...RHP **Brendan Girton**, RHP **R.J. Gordon** and INF **Nick Roselli** round out the class.

LEVITTOWN LEGEND: INF **Nick Roselli** grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division High School product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by *Baseball America*...Roselli hit the ground running last year in the Florida State League, notching an .869 OPS across 18 games with Single-A St. Lucie.

KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!: With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernandez** (27)...Of those seven, four have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

LAST TIME OUT: Díaz made his High-A and Cyclones debut in relief last Saturday afternoon vs. Wilmington...Entered in support of RHPs **Brendan Gorton** (2.2 IP) and **Ben Simon** (1.1) to start the top of the 5th inning and Brooklyn leading 10-1...Tossed 4.0 innings of 4-hit shutout ball, earning the hold...Struck out 4 without issuing a walk...Tossed 57 pitches and 38 strikes (66.67%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Ross** to start the top of the 9th inning and the Cyclones in front, 15-1...Brooklyn went on to defeat the Blue Rocks, 15-1...The game featured a 22-minute weather delay before first pitch.

2024: Split the season between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie...Started the season on St. Lucie's 7-day injured list...Joined the FCL Mets on a minor league rehab assignment on 5/4...Tossed 2.0 innings of 2-hit shutout ball in his first rehab start vs. the FCL Cardinals on 5/4 (2.0 IP, 2 H, 2 K)...Was his first outing in 603 days...Allowed only 1 unearned run on 6 hits over 6.2 innings in the FCL...Did not issue a walk and struck out 9...Reinstated by St. Lucie on 5/21...Allowed 1 unearned run in his first start back with St. Lucie, taking a no-decision on 5/23 vs. Clearwater (2.2 IP, H, R, BB, 2 K)...Tossed 4.0 hitless innings and faced one over the minimum in a no-decision on 6/5 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss, but struck out a season-high 7 batters over 5.0 innings on 7/13 vs. Lakeland (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 7 K)...Earned the win after allowing 2 runs over 7.0 quality innings on 8/2 at Fort Myers (7.0 IP, 8 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 K)...In 17 appearances (14 starts) for the Mets, Díaz posted a 2-6 mark with a 4.92 ERA (37 ER in 74.1 IP), 75 hits, 28 walks, and 71 strikeouts.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently on any Top 30 lists, Díaz entered the 2024 campaign as the New York Mets' No. 31 prospect per *Baseball America*...The 21-year-old was considered New York's No. 14 farmhand prior to 2023 and No. 9 by the same publication before 2022...Díaz was deemed the Mets' No. 12 prospect entering 2023 by MLB Pipeline and No. 10 in 2022.

ON THE MEND: Díaz is in his second season back on the bump after missing the entire 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...Since returning from injury, the Dominican native has accrued a 2-6 record with a 4.25 ERA (37 ER in 78.1 IP), 79 hits allowed, 28 walks, and 75 strikeouts...Díaz holds a 21.7% strikeout rate and a 8.1% walk rate in that span.

UNTOUCHABLE: The right-hander burst on the scene as a prospect in his first professional season in 2021...Díaz made 15 starts with the Mets' two Dominican Summer League squads...Despite holding an 0-2 record, the then 17-year-old mustered a microscopic 0.54 ERA (3 ER in 50.1 IP), allowing only 29 hits and 9 walks, while striking out 63...During the 2021 season, Díaz was the only qualified pitcher in Minor League Baseball to register a sub-1.00 ERA...Since 2021, only 3 pitchers who have worked 50.0+ innings in a campaign have registered an ERA under 1.00, however, Díaz's 0.54 mark is still the lowest...RHP **Craig Yoho** (0.94) with High-A Wisconsin, Double-A Biloxi, and Triple-A Nashville and RHP **Nico Zeglin** (0.95) with Single-A Myrtle Beach and High-A South Bend both accomplished the feat in 2024.
