TEEING OFF

- TODAY'S GAME: Three consecutive rainouts due to Tropical Storm Debby has led to 5 games in just over 48 hours, beginning with today's doubleheader at the Joe.
- NEW FACES: The GreenJackets made the call for nearly a dozen new players Sunday, 10 of whom entered the organization this summer. The new list features 5 pitchers, 2 catchers, 2 infielders, and 2 outfielders to diversify and uplift the current roster.
- JUST PLAY THE HITS: The Augusta offense has been held quiet during this post-All Star Break skid, scoring 3 runs or fewer in 11 of 14 games and currently on a 29-inning scoreless streak. The arrival of six new hitters from the draft gives hope the offense can turn things around.
- LEFT FOR DEAD: The GreenJacket offense has struggled intensely
 against left handed pitching all season long, hobbling to a .145 average
 against southpaws. The last 11 games started by a lefty have all been losses
 for Augusta, most recently Friday against Down East.
- SO LONG, PARTNER: Amongst the series of moves this week, a handful of GreenJackets earned their first promotions to high-A Rome. Jacob Godman, Joe Olsavsky, and Giomar Diaz all made their way up this weekend, following LJ McDonough and Adam Maier from earlier in the week.
- LOW POWER MODE: The GreenJackets have struggled with the long ball often this season, but have seen the power numbers rise at home of late. 20 of the team's 34 long balls (counting Noah Williams' grand slam from a currently suspended game) have come at SRP Park, including Joe Olsavsky two nights ago.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Tomorrow marks the lone solo game of the week, with JR Ritchie supposed to throw for the GreenJackets against fellow righty Trevor Harrison of the RiverDogs.
