TODAY'S GAMES: Following a 9-5 victory on Tuesday night, the Space Cowboys continue their six-game series against the Salt Lake Bees. In their only series of 2022 against Salt Lake, the Space Cowboys went 4-2 at Constellation Field from 9/13-9/18.

ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT Rylan Bannon hit three-run homer in the 2nd and RHP Kyle McGowin allowed just one run through five frames, retiring 15 of the first 16 he faced.... A two-run homer and four straight walks forced in two runs in the top of the 6th, briefly giving Salt Lake the lead... Korey Lee doubled in the tying run in the 7th and a single by JJ Matijevic gave Sugar Land the lead for good. RHP Matt Ruppenthal & Joe Record each threw a scoreless inning of relief to clinch a 9-5 victory.

ROSTER MOVES: LHP Matt Gage optioned to Sugar Land... LHP Parker Mushinski completed his ML rehab and was recalled by Houston... INF David Hensley optioned to Sugar Land (5/19)... OF Alex McKenna placed on the Dev. List... RHP Devin Conn released.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 6 international signings and 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14) & RHP Forrest Whitley (#19)

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

LEAVE 'EM ON: Over their last 13 games, the Space Cowboys have held their opponents to a .142 batting average with runners in scoring position (19-for-134), stranding 116 base runners in that stretch. El Paso: 9-for-62 (.145) with RISP, 59 LOB Dodgers: 10-for-71 (.150) with RISP, 53 LOB

BEGINNING WITH A BANG!: Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch of Thursday night's game, his fifth overall homer of the season... It was the third lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot just 15 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have twice come on the first pitch with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .375/.481/.734/1.215 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs and 11 RBI

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION: On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

GOT 'EM!: Korey Lee has registered 12 caught stealing in 37 total attempts this year. His 12 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League. In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

GRAE ALL DAY: Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 34 of his first 43 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 28 of 43 contests, including 20 of the last 26... Kessinger recorded an 11-game hitting streak from 5/2 to 5/14, tied with Korey Lee for the longest hitting streak by a Space Cowboys player this year... On the league leader board, Kessinger is currently 10th in walks (28) and tied for 10th in runs scored (33).

DOING IT WITH DEFENSE: The Space Cowboys have committed just 28 errors this year, the fewest in the PCL... Their .983 fielding percentage is tied for the second best in Triple-A this season... Meanwhile, Salt Lake has committed 48 errors this season, the most in Triple-A

EXTRA GOOD IN EXTRA INNINGS: With a 4-3 win in extra innings on Saturday night, the Space Cowboys improved to 3-1 in extra-inning games this year. Sugar Land's come-from-behind victory on Saturday night was their 12th comeback win of the season.

ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record has made four straight appearances without allowing a hit and six straight outings without allowing a run... In the month of May, Record has made 10 appearances, giving up just 2 earned runs in 10.2 innings, converting 4 of 5 saves in that span.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

For Matijevic, it was his first five-hit game of his career, passing his previous high of 4 hits on 6/21/21 @ ELP and the most RBI in a game for Matijevic in his career, surpassing his 5 RBI on 7/2/19 with Corpus Christi @ Frisco.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- Horizon Gradient: Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient
 feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms.
 The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- Mission Patch: This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

READY TO RIDE: The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

AGAINST SL: Making his first career start against Salt Lake.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on Thursday night at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark... Walked a career-high five batters and allowed four runs on just two hits, a pair of two-RBI hits by Jonny Deluca of the Dodgers... Did not receive a decision as the Space Cowboys fell 6-4 to Oklahoma City.

STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Murray made his Space Cowboys debut on April 1 at El Paso, delivering 5.0 innings of one-run relief out of the bullpen, as Sugar Land topped El Paso 7-3.

IN SPRING: Made three appearances, one start, in Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with the Astros. In 8.0 innings, did not allow a run and gave up just two hits with two walks and five strikeouts.

IMMACULATE DEBUT: The righty made his Triple-A debut while still with the Tampa Bay Rays organization in 2022, pitching one outing for the Durham Bulls on July 15 against the Gwinett Stripers. In the second inning, Murray struck out the side and tossed an immaculate inning.

TO THE 'STROS: Acquired by Houston in a trade from the Tampa Bay Rays on August 1 as part of a three-team trade. Houston acquired Murray from Tampa and 1B Trey Mancini from Baltimore, while sending OF Jose Siri to Tampa Bay and RHP Chaynce McDermott to Baltimore.

WITH TAMPA: Was originally selected in the 23rd round of the 2019 draft by the Tampa Bay Rays.... Was named the High-A East Pitcher of the Month in June and the Double-A South Pitcher of the Month in August in 2021 while with Bowling Green and Montgomery respectively... Led Minor League Pitchers in 2021 in WHIP (0.71) and had the third best ERA (2.16) among starters with at least 90.0 IP... Was also third among Rays' Minor League pitchers in wins and tied for eighth in strikeouts (96).

QUALITAY: In 2021, did not allow more than three earned runs in any of his 20 starts. Also walked more than two batters once, when he walked three on July 21 vs. Pensacola.

COLLEGE: Pitched collegiately at Dixie State University, which has since changed their name to Utah Tech... While at Dixie State, he set the single-season school record for strikeouts (92) & strikeouts per nine (9.93) during his senior year in 2019.
