GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils were shutout 1-0 by the New Hampshire Fisher Cats despite outhitting their opponent. The pitching staff allowed just six hits and one run on the board, but couldn't drive in one of their own. Johan Camargo and Jhailyn Ortiz each had three hits apiece as the Fightins connected for nine hits. However, 10 R-Phils baserunners were stranded during the game. Colton Eastman turned in a quality start on the mound but picked up the loss in Friday's game. He went six innings and gave up one run on four hits while tying a season-best four strikeouts.

OUTSTANDING ORTIZ:

Jhailyn Ortiz found rhythm at the plate over the last week. The outfielder is on a five-game multi-hit streak going back to the series finale at Richmond where he had two doubles. He leads the team with 32 extra base hits, which ranks 10th in the Eastern League. Ortiz also ranks fifth in the Eastern League with 19 doubles. In Friday's loss, Ortiz had three hits and one walk, raising his batting average to .400 and on-base percentage to .489 for the month of July. Friday's three-hit effort was Ortiz's second of the month, the first coming on July 4 at Richmond. In the game against the Flying Squirrels, Ortiz connected for a double and a home run. He leads the team with 69 hits and ranks second with 42 runs and 13 home runs.

THE FUTURE:

Catcher Logan O'Hoppe and left-handed pitcher Erik Miller leave today for the 2022 Futures Game, which is being held at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 16 at 7 PM ET. O'Hoppe, the Phillies' No. 3 prospect, leads the Fightins with a .283 batting average, 46 runs scored, 40 RBI and 14 home runs. Not only is O'Hoppe the leader in the batting order, where he's batted cleanup a team-high 50 times, he's also the team's anchor behind the plate. O'Hoppe has made 49 starts at catcher and throws runners out at about a 21% clip. The Phillies drafted O'Hoppe in the 23rd round of the 2018 MLB Draft. Miller is the Phillies' No. 10 prospect and he was selected by the team in the fourth round of the 2019 draft. The lefty spent a month on the development list but not before a strong start to the season. Miller made 15 appearances, including seven starts, and posted a 1.45 ERA. Through 25.2 innings, he has 34 strikeouts and holds opposing batters to a .174 average.

RIJO RAKES:

Wendell Rijo stayed hot at the plate on Thursday. He had his second-straight multi-hit game on Thursday as he connected for two hits, a run scored and an RBI while adding a stolen base. On Wednesday, Rijo hit two three-run home runs against New Hampshire, his second two homer game in the last week. Last week at Richmond, Rijo hit two solo shots in a 5-3 win. The infielder is up to eight home runs in 2022. He's batting .275 with a .357 on-base percentage, 44 hits, 29 RBI and 28 runs this season with the Fightins. In the last 10 contests, Rijo leads the team with a .424 batting average, a .545 on-base percentage, 14 hits, 13 RBI and 10 walks. He's also shown off his speed on the base paths with three stolen bases. Rijo made starts at third and second base during the season, making crisp plays on both sides of the infield.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies claimed a 2-1 victory over the Marlins on the road to start their final series before the All-Star break. JT Realmuto connected for three hits and an RBI while Darick Hall also added a hit and an RBI. Despite falling behind 1-0 in the second inning, the Phillies scored both the tying and go-ahead run in the seventh. Kyle Gibson went six innings and gave up four hits and a run while striking out five to earn the victory. Seranthony Dominguez got his fourth save of the season by pitching a scoreless ninth inning.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

July 16, 1968: At Reading, Larry Bowa goes 5-for-7 with 3 RBIs on the day as Reading sweeps a double-header from Waterbury, 3-2 and 7-1. Bowa's RBI single ties Game 1 in the 6th and his bunt single in the 8th leads to the game-winner when the throw to 1st sails into the stands.

July 16, 2004: At Altoona, Ryan Howard passes Greg Luzinski and ties Hal Jones for the all-time Reading professional record for HR in a season with his 34th homer of the year. The Phils fall to Altoona, though, 7-3.
