NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, an incredible 26 games over .500 at 49-23 (.681) and the best team in MiLB.

- 49 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, one ahead of the 48-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .690 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of Sugar Land (48-26 / .649).
- Omaha has held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 18 days, since June 5.

PLAYOFF BOUND

Up by 3.5 games over the 2nd-place Syracuse Mets with 1 game to play in the 1st half, Omaha's 9-4 win Tuesday clinched the 1st Half title in the International League.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has a 35-12 record over its last 47 games ... 31 of those 47 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 24 of the 35 wins in this stretch.

- Omaha is 17-7 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won 10 of their last 14 games decided by just a run.
- In total, 48 of Omaha's 72 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (67%), including 14 of 22 losses this season.
- As a team, Omaha's 23 saves are the 5th-most of any Minor League team ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank third in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 411 to 322 this season, a +89 run differential.

- A +89 run differential ranks not only as the best the International League, but also the highest mark at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +140 (443 to 303).

COMEBACK KIDS

Trailing 1-0 after the third inning Tuesday, the win marked Omaha's 27th come-from-behind win this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as five runs to win and 10 times, have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 10 of the 27 comeback wins, with four victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 7 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 23-7 record (.767 winning %), compared to 25-17 (.595 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 29-6 (.829 winning %), while the team is just 20-17 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.541 winning %).

RELIEF AID

For much of this season, Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.55 ERA, 1.32 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .205/.320/.340 ... the .206 opponents' average is the 2nd-best in all of the Minors.
- Including Friday's loss to Louisville, Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, including 5 of the last 9 games ... since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 1.53 ERA (6 ER in 35.1 IP), the 5th-best in the Minors in the stretch.
- Walter Pennington's 73 strikeouts in 29 games (2 starts) are the 6th-most in the International League, while 61 strikeouts in relief lead all MINOR LEAGUE RELIEVERS ... his 37.2% strikeout rate is 3rd in MiLB (min. 45.0 IP).
- Noah Murdock and Evan Sisk have each offered a pair of impressive scoreless streaks that are active entering today's game ... Sisk has gone his last 6 games without allowing a run, since June 9, 3.2 innings ... Murdock made his Triple-A debut last week in Toledo and since arriving to the Storm Chasers, has thrown 6.2 scoreless innings over 5 appearances.

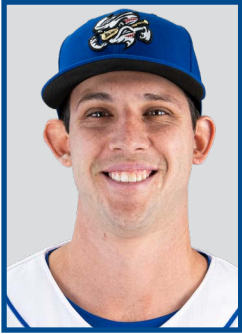

TODAY'S START

Lynch is making his 11th Omaha start, 14th overall start and 16th overall appearance this season ... Lynch is on his fourth stint in Triple-A with Omaha, previously with the Storm Chasers March 29-May 4 and May 10 to 29 and May 31 to June 1.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, MAY 18 vs. LOUISVILLE

Was his first start with Omaha, his third consecutive quality start with Omaha, dating back to his previous stint ... worked around three singles over his first two innings without allowing a run ... three singles in the 3rd inning plated a run ... worked around a hit batter in the 4th inning, threw a 1-2-3 5th inning ... allowed a solo homer to P.J. Higgins in the 6th inning but finished the inning for a QS.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 5 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings.
In his second stint with Omaha, threw back-to-back quality starts for the Chasers, May 19 @ St. Paul and May 25 vs. Columbus ... combined to allow 2 earned runs on 10 hits with 1 walk over 13.2 innings.
Opened his MLB season with 10.0 scoreless innings, between his first stint that start on May 5 and the start of his second stint on May 30 ... after 5.0 scoreless innings in his Royals season debut May 5, made his first true MLB relief appearance with 2.0 scoreless innings May 9 @ Los Angeles (AL).

CAREER NOTES

- Limited to just 9 starts for the Royals around a pair of stints on the Injured List ... missed the first 53 games of the season due to a rotator cuff strain suffered in Spring Training, then missed the last 66 games of the season with a left shoulder strain.
Made 5 rehab appearances (4 with Omaha) prior to his return to the Royals, during which he recorded a 3.98 ERA (9 ER in 20.1 IP) ... ended his first rehab assignment with 6.0 scoreless innings on 61 pitches May 23 at St. Paul (MIN), the highest strike % (77.05%) and fewest pitches/inning (10.17) of an Omaha starter in 2023, named the International League's Pitcher of the Week for his start.
Threw at least 5.0 innings in all 9 of his starts with the Royals between May and July ... threw a team-best 31.0 innings over 5 June starts, named Royals Pitcher of the Month.
Placed back on the Injured List July 19, made 1 rehab appearance on September 21 at Columbus (CLE) with Omaha ... made 1 start with the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in October (3.0 IP, 1 ER), then made 5 starts for Leones del Escogido of the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM) between November 5 and December 1, going 1-1 with a 2.66 ERA (6 ER in 20.1 IP) and 23 strikeouts.

- Made 27 starts for Kansas City to tie Kris Bubic for the team lead, despite two Injured List stints with a blister on his left index finger, June 23 to July 11 and July 17 to August 1, during which he combined to miss 26 games ... made 2 rehab starts with Omaha.
His 8.3 K/9 rate (122 K in 131.2 IP) ranked 10th among Major League left-handed starting pitchers (minimum 27 starts).

- Spent April at the Alternate Training Site in Springdale, AR and was slated to start the year in Omaha ... had his contract selected on May 3 without having pitched in a game above the High-A level and went on to make 15 starts with the Royals over two stints.
Allowed 15 runs in 8.0 innings over his first stint (3 starts) ... he was optioned to Omaha May 14 and made 12 appearances (11 starts) and returned to Kansas City on July 25 and went 4-1 over his next 7 starts with a 2.23 ERA (10 ER in 40.1 IP).

- Spent much of the season with Wilmington (A+) but had stints with Surprise (R) and Burlington (R) as well as rehab assignment, combined to go 6-2 over 20 starts, with a 2.99 ERA (32 ER in 96.1 IP) with 96 strikeouts ... named a Carolina League Midseason All-Star.

- Split his first professional season between Burlington (R) and Lexington (A) and combined to go 5-1 over 12 starts with a 1.58 ERA (9 ER in 51.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts to 8 walks (7.63 K/BB) ... his ERA and 1.4 BB/9 were both second-best among Royals farmhands (min. 50.0 IP).

- Pitched collegiately at the University of Virginia, where he went 12-12 over three years with a 4.56 ERA (104 ER in 205.1 IP) in 39 games (35 starts) ... as a Junior in 2018, went 4-4 with a 3.96 ERA (39 ER in 88.2 IP) with 105 strikeouts in 13 starts.

- 2015: Graduated from Douglas Freeman High School ... named a Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American following his senior year.
