## Sacramento River Cats (32-21) at Reno Aces (25-30)

LHP John Michael Bertrand (4-1, 5.28) vs. LHP Yu-Min Lin (2-4, 5.31)

**EXTRA ACES:** The Sacramento River Cats lost last night's game, 3-5, in extra innings, ending their seven-game road winning streak...was their first extra-innings loss of the season...the Cats have stolen a base in every game since May 10, ranking first in the PCL since that date, with 29 total stolen bases...the game took three hours and 28 minutes, their longest extra-innings game this season...The Cats turned a double play to end the 10th inning...marked their first double play in extras this season...they recorded one extra-inning double play in 2025 on July 6 at Reno in the 11th inning; Sac won that game 15-13...Spencer Bivens was the starter but did not factor into the decision of Sacramento's defeat...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and one strikeout in a Triple-A career-high 5.0 innings of work...Marques Johnson was dealt his first loss of the season...allowed three runs (2 earned) on two hits (1 HR), with no walks and two strikeouts in 1.1 innings...gave up the game-winning, walkoff home run to Jacob Amaya in the 11th inning.

▶ Jake Holton (1-for-4) knocked his first career Triple-A triple, and 12th of his professional career...he is batting .278 (5-for-18) with one double, one triple, one home run, eight RBI, a .627 slugging percentage and a .967 OPS in this series against Reno.

▶ Nate Furman went 3-for-6, his fourth three-hit and 11th multi-hit game of the season...is his first time with back-to-back three-plus-hit games since August 29-30 last season...extended his hitting streak to seven games...he is batting .361 (13-for-36) with seven runs, three doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, three stolen bases, a .410 on-base percentage and a .938 OPS in that span.

**AND THEY'RE LAUGHING DRAWING ACES:** The Sacramento River Cats won Thursday's game, 7-2, giving them a seven-game road winning streak for the first time since May 2013...they are now 13-3 in their last 16 games...marked their 14th multi-home run game, they are now 14-0 in such games...Sacramento leads the PCL in home runs in the month of May (34), and lead all of Triple-A in home runs since May 19 (19)...Carson Seymour was the starter and earned his third win of the season...allowed one run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Grant McCray went 1-for-5, extending his hitting streak to seven games, tied for sixth-longest active hitting streak in the PCL.

▶ Jake Holton (2-for-5) knocked his fifth home run of the season, a 426-foot, solo-shot to center field...marked his second-longest recorded home run (441 feet, August 4, 2021 with Lakeland), and fifth-longest by a River Cat this season...also knocked an RBI double in the fifth...was his second multi-extra-base-hit game (also, May 19, 2B and HR).

▶ Nate Furman (3-for-5) recorded his fifth home run of the season, a 400-foot, two-run blast to right field...also knocked a single to lead off the game, and a double in the third, making him just a triple shy of the cycle...was his first multi-extra-base-hit game of the year...marked his third three-hit game and 10th multi-hit game

▶ Hitting coach P.J. Pilittere was ejected in the third inning by first base umpire Ray Valero for arguing an out at first call...was Pilittere's first ejection with the River Cats and first since 2023 when he was ejected with the Rockies for arguing a strike call.

**WHO'S THE NEW GUY?:** Drew Cavanaugh (4-for-4) recorded his second multi-homer game of the season on Wednesday...the only River Cat to have multiple multi-homer games last season was Marco Luciano (3 two-HR games)...two of Luciano's multi-HR games were just six days apart; Cavanaugh's multi-HR games were seven days apart...his first longball in the fourth inning traveled 431 feet; the third-longest homer by a River Cat this season (Berico to, 459; Eldridge, 434)...his second traveled 430 feet.

▶ He has knocked nine extra-base-hits in his last six games since May 20, leading all of Triple-A in that span...he is batting .552 (16-for-29) with five doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, two walks, two stolen bases, a 1.138 slugging percentage and a 1.732 OPS in seven games since May 20.

**BUDDY SYSTEM:** Infielder Buddy Kennedy has been phenomenal in his debut with the River Cats this season...on Tuesday, he hit his team-leading eighth home run of the season...he is the only River Cat to have a consecutive games with a home run, and he's done it twice...the last time Kennedy homered in three-straight games was May 14-17, 2025 with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (4-straight).

▶ He leads the team (min. 15 games) in OBP (.420), SLG (.531), and OPS (.951), each of which also rank in the top 10 among qualified PCL players...ranks second on the team in batting average (.313) behind Turner Hill (.324)

▶ His 40 runs are T-6th in the PCL, his 56 hits are 8th, and his 95 total bases are ranked 10th.

▶ Buddy has 22 extra-base-hits this season, ranking T-8th in the league...18 of those XBH have occurred since April 19, and he is T-5th most in the PCL and T-10th most in Triple-A since that date...since then, he is batting .315 (39-for-124) with nine doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 24 RBI, 22 walks, a .597 slugging percentage and a 1.030 OPS.

▶ Seven of his eight home runs have happened since May 6, and he is first in the PCL and T-3rd in home runs in Triple-A since that date.

**KNOCK, KNOCKS:** The River Cats were the last team in Triple-A to record a home run, getting their first on April 1...the Cats ranked last in home runs in the PCL through April 28...however, in the month of May, they lead the league in homers at 34...they have recorded 19 longballs in their last 10 games since May 19, leading the PCL and second in Triple-A (behind St. Paul's 20) since that date...the River Cats are 3-17 in games where they do not record a home run.

▶ On the other side, the River Cats pitching staff has allowed just 15 home runs in the month of May, leading the PCL and T-2nd in Triple-A...they rank first in PCL and second overall in Triple-A in total home runs allowed on the season (35), behind only Nashville (33).

**DEAR JOHN:** Southpaw John Michael Bertrand is set to start tonight's game at Reno...last pitched on May 24 vs. Sugar Land where he was dealt his first loss of the season...allowed five runs (4 earned) on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and a Triple-A career-high-tying six strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

▶ Made his first career start against Reno on May 7 where he did not factor into the decision of Sacramento's 6-3 victory...allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR) with one walk and no strikeouts in 6.1 quality innings.

▶ Through 10 games (8 starts) this season, Bertrand has posted a 5.28 ERA (44.1 IP, 26 ER) with 19 walks, 30 strikeouts and a .302 opponent batting average.

▶ Spent a majority of the 2025 season with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels...in 25 starts with the Squirrels he posted a 2.87 ERA (131.2 IP, 42 ER) with 15 walks, 91 strikeouts and a .249 opponent batting average...was promoted to the River Cats on September 19...played two games with the Cats (1 start) where he had a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), one walk, 10 strikeouts and a .273 opponent batting average.

**BOYS IN THE BIGS:** Outfielder Victor Bericoto had his contract selected by San Francisco and made his major league debut on May 22...recorded his first major league hit on May 26...six total Cats batters and one pitcher are currently playing on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats so far this season:
