**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped Saturday's contest to Aberdeen, 14-6, forcing Sunday's rubber match...The IronBirds sent 10 batters to the plate and scored six runs in the fifth inning to create separation...The six runs allowed in the frame tied the most surrendered by the Cyclones in one inning in 2024...All nine Aberdeen hitters reached base safely at least once and eight of the nine tallied at least one hit...SS **Junior Tilien** picked up two hits and drove in four of Brooklyn's six runs with a three-run home run and a sacrifice fly...C **Austin Allen** reached base twice on a single and a walk during his Minor League rehab assignment.

**TURN UP THE TRUMPETS!:** On Thursday, RHP **Edwin Díaz** became the fifth player to join the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment in 2024, striking out a pair in a scoreless inning...C **Francisco Alvarez**, RHP **Drew Smith**, RHP **Tyler Megill**, and RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** have also appeared on Coney Island this season...He is expected to continue his rehab stint on Sunday...Díaz was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on May 29 with right shoulder impingement...In 20 relief appearances in 2024, the Puerto Rico native is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (12 ER in 20.0 IP), five saves, seven walks, and 30 strikeouts...Díaz is a two-time All-Star and has taken home both the American League and National League Reliever of the Year award...The Mets acquired the right-hander with 2B **Robinson Canó** and cash considerations from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for RHP **Gerson Bautista**, OF **Jay Bruce**, RHP **Justin Dunn**, OF **Jarred Kelenic**, and RHP **Anthony Swarzak** on December 3, 2018.

**EL TROLL RETURNS:** C **Francisco Alvarez** has rejoined Brooklyn to continue his Major League rehab assignment...The 22-year-old went 1-for-6 with a single and two walks, catching all 9.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on Tuesday, and serving as designated hitter on Wednesday...He joined Double-A Binghamton last week and appeared in three contests for the Rumble Ponies, going 2-for-8 at the plate with two runs scored, a home run, and three RBI...Alvarez has been on the New York Mets' 10-day injured list since April 20 with a left thumb sprain...As a member of the Cyclones in 2021, he set a then-franchise record with 22 home runs in 84 games...That mark is second-most in a single season in Brooklyn franchise history behind OF **Stanley Consuegra's** 23 in 2023...His 58 RBI in 2021 is the third-most in a single season behind Consuegra (63) in 2023 and INF **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021...Alvarez's .538 slugging percentage and .889 OPS rank fourth and sixth in Cyclones' single-season history.

**CROWN CONSUEGRA!:** In last Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (174), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...On Saturday, Consuegra's one-out double in the ninth inning broke his tie with Ramirez for the franchise record in doubles (39)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on an 11-game on-base streak and has a hit in 17 of his last 19 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .333/.440/.696 with a 1.136 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 65 points (.171 to .236) and his OPS by 247 points (.519 to .766) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in slugging (.696) and is tied for first in home runs (6)...Consuegra is also second or tied for second OPS (1.136), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (48).

**GET YOUR OFFENSE HERE!:** In back-to-back games on SNY, the Brooklyn Cyclones erupted for a season-high-tying 13 runs and 14 hits in Thursday's 13-3 win vs. Aberdeen and followed it up with 13 more runs and a season-best 18 hits in a 13-7 win on Friday...The 13 runs were the most for the Cyclones since a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...The 14 knocks were also the most for Brooklyn since a 14-hit outing in a 9-7 win at Jersey Shore on April 20...Friday's 18-hit effort was the best for Brooklyn since they accumulated 18 knocks in an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on July 21, 2023...The 18 hits were the most for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park in almost 13 years...Brooklyn racked up 20 hits, also against Aberdeen, in a 13-0 rout on July 21, 2011...Friday marked the first time the 'Clones accrued 13+ runs and 18+ hits in the same game since scoring a franchise-record 20 runs in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...It was the first time Brooklyn accomplished those numbers at Maimonides Park that 13-0 win vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011.

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancillotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...

**vs. ABERDEEN:** Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...Dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 133-117 (.532).

It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS:** The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its seventh shut-out victory in Tuesday's 3-0 no-hit win vs. Aberdeen...On Sunday, Brooklyn earned its sixth of the season in a 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones had a season-high 23.2 consecutive scoreless innings since two out in the fifth inning on Saturday snapped on 3B **Mac Horvath's** one-out RBI single in the third inning on Wednesday...The Cyclones have shut out opponents in back-to-back games twice in 2024...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws on Sunday marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 and May 3's 2-0 wins vs. Aberdeen...The seven shutouts are tied for the second-most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

**NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH:** Including Sunday, 10 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are in third place...They are one game back of Jersey Shore for second in the North Division...Brooklyn is 1.5 games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they did not play an in-division opponent until this week, as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws travel to North Carolina.

**MARVELOUS MORABITO:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.461)...He is also tied for 10th in stolen bases (26) and 12th in batting average (.339)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league lead in steals (15) and tied for third in runs scored (22).

**BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK:** INF **Wilfredo Lara**, INF **Junior Tilien**, and C **Chris Suero** have caught fire over the last few weeks...In his last 17 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .328/.429/.517 with an .946 OPS, adding a double, two triples, two home runs, and nine RBI...Tilien enters Sunday on a team-season-long 18-game on-base streak since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader at Bowling Green...The streak is the longest active in the South Atlantic League and Brooklyn's longest since INF **William Lugo** reached in 18-straight from August 23, 2023, until April 6, 2024...The 20-year-old has posted a .303/.400/.409 line with a .809 OPS, adding 10 runs scored, two doubles, a triple, a home run, nine RBI, and 11 walks...Since May 17, Suero has reached safely in 14 of 15 games...The 20-year-old is hitting .300/.453/.440 with a .893 OPS, 15 runs scored, a double, two home runs, 12 RBI, and 13 walks.

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for fifth in triples (3), ninth in OPS (.869), 10th in slugging (.494), and tied for 10th in total bases (84).

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 57 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.41 ERA (25 ER in 93.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 83.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**BIRDMAN BIRDMAN:** Prior to joining the rotation, Hawkins impressed in a relief role...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old was sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2) prior to his first start...He was also first in ground ball rate (62.1%) and swinging strike rate (19.7%), second in strikeout rate (33.0%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3%), seventh in walk rate (8.7%).

**2023:** Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

**WAZZOU WIZARD:** The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023...In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts...His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninth-most in a single-season at Washington State.
