Tonight, Reading continues its six-game series at Portland. Phillies No. 3 Prospect Griff McGarry gets the start, opposite Grant Gambrell for Portland.

Looking Back

Reading won its second-straight game this week, 5-4 over Portland last night. Mick Abel was solid over five-plus innings, and the bullpen allowed one-earned run over four innings. Johan Rojas and Matthew Kroon both added two hits. Jhailyn Ortiz struck out five times, marking the first time an R-Phil has done that since Jason Donald on May 28, 2008 at Erie.

History for De La Cruz

Carlos De La Cruz now holds the longest on-base streak by an R-Phil, dating back to 2009. A single amd two walks increased his streak to 35 games. Tuesday, he passed Cameron Perkins mark of 33 set in 2014.

Can't Stop Johan

The day after Johan Rojas had four hits and three stolen bases, he added a pair of base knocks. It's the fifth-stragiht game with multiple hits. Rojas also had a home-run saving catch last night that was number-two on this morning's SportsCenter Top-10 Plays.

Amongst the League Leaders

Johan Rojas and Carlos De La Cruz are tied for first in the Eastern League in runs scored with 46. Nick Yorke of Portland is tied with them. Rojas is second in the league in hitting at .324 and Matthew Kroon is fourth at .320. Rojas is first in the league in hits with 85 and De La Cruz is tied for third with 76 hits. De La Cruz is also tied for third in the league with 14 home runs on the season.

Gettin' On Base

Oliver Dunn has quietly put together a 20-game on base streak, that dates back to May 26. Additionally, Johan Rojas has hits in ten straight; while Madison Stokes and Herbert Iser have been aboard in seven in a row. Matthew Kroon has reached in eight in a row.

Around the Organization

The Phillies were postponned last night and finish their series with the Braves this afternoon. Lehigh Valley was shutout 5-0 at Worcester last night as the IronPigs were held to just two hits. Jersey Shore topped Rome 6-2 to improve to 35-29 as Matt Osterberg went seven-strong innings. Clearwater lost 11-5 to Dunedin last night as Cade Fergus has two hits in the loss.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 22, 1999: At Norwich, Adam Eaton, making his Double-A debut, throws an 8-inning no-hitter and strikes out 12, but loses the game 1-0 as the Navigators' Jake Robbins tosses a 3-hit shutout for the home team. Jimmy Rollins collects 2 of the Phillies' hits, both doubles.

Shipping up to Portland

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Portland, with both at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs sit in second in the Northeast Division, 1.5 games back of Somerset. It will be a neck-and-neck battle with the Patriots this week for the first-half crown. Last week, Portland went 3-3 at Binghamton and next week, the Sea Dogs begin the second half at New Hampshire.

Dog on the Mound

Righty Grant Gambrell gets the start for Portland tonight. Gambrell is 3-3 with a 3.96 ERA over 12 starts between high-A Greenville and Portland. He made his double-A debut on May 18 and is 1-1 with a 3.06 ERA in six starts with the Sea Dogs. Last Friday, Gamrebll went 4.2 innings, and allowed three runs on four hits, with five strikeouts in a no decision at Binghamton. He was a third-round pick out of Oregon State by the Roayls in 2019. He was traded to Boston, along with Luis De La Rosa from Kansas Ciity on June 9, 2021. He did not play at all in 2022 due to an ankle injury he suffered late in 2021.

Phillies Number Three Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
