On September 17, 2013, the PCL Champion Omaha Storm Chasers defeated the IL Champion Durham Bulls 2-1, at Coca-Cola Park in Allentown, Pennsylvania. **Chris Dwyer** threw 7.0 scoreless innings, while **Irvyng Falu** went 3-for-5 with an RBI single in the 6th.

This was Omaha's 2nd of 3 Triple-A titles and the first of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.

NOTES AND NUGGETS	
ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT	
After leading for 42 of 50 innings last week in Toledo (84%), the Storm Chasers have trailed for 34 of 36 innings this week against Durham.	
In the first 3 games of this series, the Bulls scored in the first inning and led the rest of the game ... after a 0-0 tie through the first 2 innings last night, Durham scored in the 3rd inning and led the rest of the night.	
Prior to this week, Omaha trailed for just 30 innings in the past 2 series (13 games) ... that represents just 29% of the team's 105 innings, dating back to June 4.	
Omaha has been outscored by Durham this week 34-10, a -24 run differential ... so far this season, the Chasers' biggest negative run differential in a series is -14, when Norfolk outscored Omaha 44-30 April 15 to 20 ... the Chasers' had a +26 run differential last week in Toledo, outscoring the Mud Hens 37-11.	

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO	
While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.	
Omaha has successfully stolen 106 bases this year, and only been caught 17 times ... 106 steals rank 4th in the International League and 5th in Triple-A.	
106-for-123 in steal attempts is a 86.2% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 90.0%, 54-for-60).	

I CAN'T TOUCH THIS	
The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 695 strikeouts this season ... that is the MOST of any Triple-A club and ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball (1st: Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, 738).	
Over 621.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.06 K/9, which ranks 2nd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.	
With 695 strikeouts through 72 games, an average of 9.65 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,438 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.	

SACRIFICIAL LOVE	
The Omaha Storm Chasers rank near the top of the Triple-A level in both sacrifice bunts (14) and sacrifice flies (31).	
The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts in 2024, with 38 last year ... 14 this year are the 2nd-most in the league, 4th at the Triple-A level, and tied 15th in the Minors.	
31 sacrifice flies are tied for the most in Triple-A and tied for the 3rd-most in the Minors ... Tyler Gentry is tied for the league lead with 6 sac flies.	

WHAT A RELIEF	
Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best at the Triple-A level this month and recently compiled a stretch of 17.0 scoreless innings, compiling parts of 6 games.	
Over 17 games in the month of June, Omaha's bullpen has a 4.00 ERA (31 ER in 69.2 IP) that ranks 7th at the Triple-A level this month ... the relievers have a 1.39 WHIP and .237 opponents' average in June, both 10th at the Triple-A level.	
3 members of Omaha's bullpen have not yet allowed a run in June ... RHP Ryan Hendrix (7.0 IP), RHP Andrew Hoffmann (3.0 IP) and LHP Evan Sisk (3.0 IP) ... additionally, RHP Jacob Wallace has retired his last 19 batters since June 7 (6.1 IP).	
Chasers relievers combined for 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings, from the 8th inning last Tuesday through the 6th inning this Tuesday ... previously, the bullpen's longest scoreless streak this season was 13.2 innings, May 7 to 10.	
Last week in Toledo, Omaha's bullpen led all 120 full season Minor League teams with a 0.51 WHIP, .099 opponents' average and 7.75 K/BB ... the relief corps' 1.25 ERA ranked 4th in the Minors last week ... the bullpen allowed just 3 earned runs in 21.2 innings of work, with 7 hits and 4 walks to 31 strikeouts.	

PITCH, PLEASE	
Sunday in Toledo was Omaha's 5th pitching shutout of the season, continuing a strong stretch on the mound, with 3 shutouts in a 4-game stretch in Toledo.	
Omaha's .151 opponents' average (26-for-172) and 0.84 WHIP (16 BB + 26 H in 50.0 IP) were the best among full season Minor League teams last week ... those two marks and the staff's 1.98 ERA (11 ER in 50.0 IP) are Omaha's BEST in any series since joining the International League in 2021.	
Storm Chasers pitchers did not allow a run over a season-high stretch of 23.0 innings, from the 2nd inning Wednesday through the 1st inning Saturday ... that nearly matched last year's longest scoreless streak of 24.0 innings without allowing a run, from August 2 to 4 @ Rochester.	
Overall, a 0.93 WHIP and .168 opponents' average from Omaha's pitchers against Toledo were the best of any Triple-A pitching staff last week ... the group's 2.41 ERA was 2nd at the Triple-A level ... previously, the best ERA Omaha had in a 6-game series this year was 3.66, May 6-11 @ Louisville.

TODAY'S START

Wright is making his **4th start with Omaha** this season, his **8th overall start this season ... is with Omaha on a Major League rehab assignment** ... opened the year on Kansas City's 15-day Injured List, sent to Double-A Northwest Arkansas to begin his rehab on May 2, had his rehab transferred to Omaha on June 3.

Underwent shoulder surgery in October 2023 to repair right shoulder damage.

Playing his 9th professional season this year ... Royals are Wright's 2nd MLB organization, was drafted 5th overall by the Braves in 2017 and pitched with Atlanta until he was traded to Kansas City in November 2023.

Made his 7th rehab start, his 3rd with Omaha ... after not making it out of the 3rd inning in the series opener, pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his 2nd start of the week ... pitched a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st, retired 6 of his first 7 ... worked around a walk in the 2nd, a pair of singles in the 3rd inning ... pitched a 1-2-3 inning in the 4th to end his day, retired his last 5 hitters of the game ... did not come out for the 5th inning, threw a season-high 65 pitches.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

Opened the year on the Royals' 15-Day Injured List with a "right shoulder injury" ... initially assigned to Northwest Arkansas on May 2 to begin his rehab assignment, was recalled from his rehab assignment after 2 starts with shoulder fatigue ... returned to the Nationals 2 ½ weeks later and made 2 more starts for NWA.

Threw 4.0 innings and 60 pitches in his first rehab start, May 2 @ Springfield (STL) ... threw exactly 2.0 innings, did not reach 50 pitches in his next 3 outings in Double-A.

Told MLB.com's Anne Rogers, after his outing on May 7 vs. Wichita (MIN) ... "I kind of felt when I went out for that second inning, I felt like my delt was tired, so I kind of noticed my velo was dropping just a touch. Means I was protecting. Just wanted to not do anything dumb. Overall, I felt good. First inning felt good. Just got tired."

CAREER NOTES

2024

Did not pitch professionally ... on Kansas City's 60-day injured list from February 17 to November 1.

2023

Opened the year on Atlanta's Injured List with right shoulder inflammation ... after one rehab outing, struggled to a 5.79 ERA (12 ER in 18.2 IP) over 5 starts from April 11 to May 3 ... back to the IL on May 4 to heal the same shoulder, there through September 10 ... finished the year on the Braves' 60-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain.

2022

Spent the entire year in the Majors with Atlanta with a 21-5 record and a 3.19 ERA (64 ER in 180.1 IP), to go along with 174 strikeouts ... led the Majors with 21 wins ... finished 10th in National League Cy Young Award voting.

19 of 30 starts were quality starts ... made 4 straight quality starts from May 26 to June 12 and again July 9 to 29 ... every start from July 9 to August 31 was at least 6.0 innings.

Ended the season on an 8-game winning streak, posting a 3.14 ERA (18 ER in 51.2 IP) over 9 starts, August 10 to October 1 ... 8 runs of the runs he allowed in the streak came in a no-decision effort on September 6 at Oakland.

2021

Only made 2 starts for Atlanta in the big leagues, one on April 15 at Chicago (NL) and one on June 23 at New York (NL) ... totaled just 6.1 MLB innings, allowed 7 earned runs (9.95 ERA).

His only MLB playoff appearances came out of the bullpen in Games 2 and 4 of the World Series against the Astros ... allowed 1 run over 4.2 innings of relief behind opener Dylan Lee, who allowed 3 of 4 batters to reach.

2020

Spent most of the shortened season in the Major Leagues with Atlanta, going 2-4 with a 5.21 ERA (22 ER in 38.0 IP across 8 starts ... was at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in Gwinnett from August 20 to September 8.

2019

Made his first MLB Opening Day roster and appeared in 7 games (4 starts) over 5 stints in the big leagues ... went 0-3 with a 8.69 ERA (19 ER in 19.2 IP) for Atlanta.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

After being drafted by Atlanta in the 1st round, began his professional career in 2017 with the GCL Braves (R) ... after 3 outings, joined the Florida Fire Frogs (A+) at the start of August and ended his year in High-A.

Opened the 2018 season with the Mississippi Braves (AA) and ended the year in the Major Leagues for his MLB debut ... over 27 games in the Minors (24 starts) between Mississippi and the Gwinnett Stripers (AAA).

Represented the Braves on Team USA at the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game in Washington D.C.

In 5 stints with the Gwinnett Stripers (AAA) in 2019, led the International League in wins (11), ranked 9th in strikeouts (116) ... of qualified IL pitchers, ranked 1st in opponents' average (.252), 2nd in WHIP (1.26) and 5th in ERA.

Spent nearly the entire 2021 season with the Gwinnett Stripers (AAA), with a league-leading 3.02 ERA (46 ER in 137.0 IP) and 137 strikeouts ... also led the league in innings pitched, tied for the Triple-A East lead in starts (24).

COLLEGE (VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY, 2015-2017)

Pitched three seasons at Vanderbilt University, where he went 19-11 with a 2.78 ERA (79 ER in 255.1 IP) with 290 strikeouts over three seasons for the Commodores (SEC).

FRESHMAN (2015): Pitched in 4 of Vandy's 6 College World Series games, throwing 7.2 innings ... appeared in Games 1 and 3 of the CWS Finals vs. Virginia, including 4.0 innings of 1-run relief in Game 3 on June 24.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
