**TODAY'S GAMES:** Sugar Land continues their six-game series against the Dodgers on Friday night, trailing 3-0 after leading at some point in each of the first three contests.

**ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT:** Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run and JJ Matijevic followed with a sac fly in the first to give Sugar Land a 2-0 lead. The Dodgers drew level with two in the first and scored runs in the second and third to go up 4-2. Sugar Land would tie the game after scoring one in the fourth and one in the fifth, but a two-run bottom of the fifth put the Dodgers in front for good.

**ROSTER MOVES:** INF David Hensley optioned to Sugar Land from Houston.

**HOME GROWN TALENT:** Sugar Land's roster has 12 players drafted by the Astros, 5 international signings and 2 players signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

**PROSPECTING:** The Space Cowboys active roster boasts five of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), INF Joe Perez (#14) & RHP Forrest Whitley (#19)

**RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ:** On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

**LEAVE 'EM ON:** Over their six games against El Paso, Sugar Land pitching stranded 59 Chihuahuas' base runners and held El Paso to just 9 hits with runners in scoring position, with El Paso going 9-for-62 (.145) with RISP. In the first three games against OKC, the Dodgers have gone 5-for-36 (.139) with runners in scoring position and stranded 23 runners.

**BEGINNING WITH A BANG:** Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch of Thursday night's game, his fifth overall homer of the season... It was the third lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot just 12 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have twice come on the first pitch with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. Madris has accounted for three of the four lead-off homers for the Space Cowboys this season... When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .370/.453/.741/1.194 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 4 home runs and 9 RBI

**WHAT A WEEK:** The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

**GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION:** On Saturday night, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

**GOT 'EM!** C Korey Lee threw out Tim Lopes in the top of the 6th on Thursday, Lee's 11 caught stealing in 33 total attempts this year. His 11 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League. In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

**GRAE ALL DAY:** Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 31 of his first 40 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 25 of 40 contests, including 17 of the last 23... Kessinger had his 11-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday night, going 0-for-4... His 11-game hitting streak is tied with Korey Lee for the longest hitting streak by a Space Cowboys player this year... On the league leader board, Kessinger is currently tied for 8th in runs scored (31).

**DOING IT WITH DEFENSE:** Despite committing an error on Thursday night, the Space Cowboys have committed just 28 errors this year, the second fewest in the PCL... Their .981 fielding percentage is tied for the eighth best in Triple-A this season.

**GETTING IT GOING:** While a starter hasn't gone more than 4.0 innings in the last six games for Sugar Land, they've gotten great outings from their starters... In their last seven starts, Space Cowboys pitchers have combined to throw 26.1 innings, allowing 9 earned runs, translating to a 3.08 ERA in that span.

**GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN:** Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

**MATJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT:** On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

For Matijevic, it was his first five-hit game of his career, passing his previous high of 4 hits on 6/21/21 @ ELP and the most RBI in a game for Matijevic in his career, surpassing his 5 RBI on 7/2/19 with Corpus Christi @ Frisco.

**UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD:** As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

**WHERE TO FIND US:** Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at sspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

**TO INFINITY AND BEYOND:** Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon.
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

**READY TO RIDE:** The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

**REST OF THE CREW:** Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started on Saturday night against El Paso... Allowed a lead-off home run to David Dahl and a double to Jose Iglesias, but retired the next 11 in a row and 12 of 13... Came back out for the second inning after a 34 minute rain delay between the end of the first and the start of the second.

**SKIPPED START:** Whitley skipped his scheduled start in Albuquerque on 5/5 with minor soreness in his decelerator muscle (below the shoulder).

**STRIKKKKKKE EM OUT:** Struck out 7 batters in 4.0 innings on 4/12 @ OKC, generating 11 swings and misses. It was the most strikeouts in a game for Whitley since he struck out 7 on August 27, 2022 @ RR.

**IN SPRING:** Made three appearances for the Astros in Spring Training, two starts. Went 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA, giving up four runs, all earned, in 6.2 innings of work. Whitley walked just one and struck out five in his three outings with the Astros.

**PROSPECT STATUS:** Whitley currently ranks as the #19 prospect in the Astros' organization according to MLB Pipeline and the #28 prospect in the system according to Baseball America.

**WELCOME BACK:** On June 16, 2022, Whitley threw 2.0 innings in the Florida Complex League, his first appearance since September 2, 2019 with the Corpus Christi Hooks. Whitley missed the 2021 season after having UCL reconstructive surgery (Tommy John) on his right elbow on March 17, 2021.

**FAST RISER:** Whitley was named a 2017 MiLB.com Organizational All-Star and advanced to Double-A Corpus Christi that season, becoming one of just five players in a 20-year span to be drafted out of high school and advance to Double-A in his first full Minor League season, joining Chad Billingsley, Zack Greinke, Clayton Kershaw and Dylan Bundy.

**HONORS AND AWARDS:** Was named an MiLB.Com Organizational All-Star in 2017... Selected to the MLB SiriusXM Futures Game in 2018 but did not pitch... Named an Arizona Fall League Rising Star with the Scottsdale Scorpions... Also named the AFL Pitcher of the Week on October 13, 2018.

**PATH TO HOUSTON:** Whitley was selected by the Astros with the 17th overall pick of the 2016 Draft out of Alamo Heights HS.
