"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints were walked off for the seventh time in the club's history at Victory Field as they fell 7-6 in 11 innings, dropping their third straight in the series in Indianapolis on Friday night. St. Paul failed to push across a run in either the 10th or the 11th, leaving the door open for the Indians. While Anthony Misiewicz struck out all three outs in the 10th, the leadoff hitter Llover Peguero flew out to right to advance the placed runner to third. After an intentional walk put runners at the corners, the infield came in and Alike Williams hit a ground ball just out of the reach of Tanner Schobel to knock in the winning run. In the first, the Indians put up a three-spot for a third consecutive game in the opening frame. The Saints answered with three of their own in the third. The newest member of the Saints Aaron Sabato smashed a single to center to lead it off, his first Triple-A hit, and came around to score on Mickey Gasper's three-run home run, his tenth of the season after Gasper hadn't played in eight days. The Saints took the lead on Jefferson Morales' RBI double in the fourth, but Indy retook the lead off four hits against Michael Tonkin in the fifth, scoring twice to make it 5-4. It was tied at 6-6 after the Saints plated two in the top of the sixth and Indianapolis used an error to answer back with one in the bottom of the inning.

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Saints have hit just .175 (27-154) with a .558 team OPS on their road trip to Indy so far, ranking as the worst batting average in Triple-A & 2nd-worst team OPS, leading only Toledo in the last four days (.516). The Saints have been held without a hit through the first four innings in three of their previous five games in Indianapolis. In the first two games of the series, St. Paul were kept out of the hit column through five innings in each game, including going into the seventh until collecting their first hit on Tuesday night. It marked the first time in franchise history the Saints have been held hitless through five innings in back-to-back games and the 20th and 21st times in franchise history, by far the most of any Triple-A club the last five years.

THE MERRIMACK MISSILE: Saints UT Mickey Gasper played for the first time in eight days on Friday night and went deep, his tenth homer of the season in 33 games with Triple-A St. Paul. The switch-hitter from New Hampshire tied Carson McCusker this season and Alex Kiriloff in 2022 for the 3rd fewest games to reach 10 homers with the Saints in franchise history:

HOW COME THEY CALL IT VICTORY FIELD?: The Saints snapped out of an eight-game losing streak at Victory Field with a win on Wednesday afternoon, but have still dropped 11 of their last 12 and 15 of the past 17 games played at Victory Field. The Saints have historically struggled in Indy, and have the second-lowest winning percentage at Victory Field of any of their visiting ballparks since going Triple-A, with only a worse mark in Columbus (see below). The Saints went just 1-11 in two visits to Indianapolis last year, including being swept in a six-game series from August 13-18. Their seven walk-off defeats in Indianapolis all-time trail only their nine in Columbus.

I'M LOVIN IT: Left-hander Richard Lovelady has retired the last 16 hitters he's faced out of the bullpen dating back to June 1 after recording his sixth save in as many chances on Wednesday. His current streak of six straight saves is the 3rd-longest active streak in Triple-A. Lovelady is currently one of three Triple-A relievers with an active streak of 16+ batters retired in-a-row, trailing only Gwinnett's Jesse Chavez (17) and tied with Las Vegas's Grant Holman (16). His streak is tied with Kody Funderburk for the most consecutive batters retired by a St. Paul pitcher this year, with Funderburk retiring 16 straight Triple-A batters from a stretch spanning April 4-27, interrupted by a stint with the Twins.

ED(WALK) JULIEN: Entering play Saturday, Saints second baseman Edouard Julien is tied for the third-most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 28 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 16 of 29 games while touting a .443 OBP.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .342 (38-111) with 10 doubles, 8 HR, and 21 RBI in 29 games. Gasper is 2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (18) since that date and his OPS ranks 3rd in the International League (min 80 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure):

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (36-33) lost their series opener 10-3 to the Astros in Houston on Friday night. The Astros jumped on Chris Paddack, scoring runs against the Twins starter in each of the first four innings to stake an 8-0 lead after three and 9-1 after four. Willi Castro and Royce Lewis each went deep for Minnesota. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (32-29) notched a 9-3 victory for their second win in-a-row over Corpus Christi (HOU). Kala'i rosario hit a third inning grand slam to put the Wind Surge on the board while Gabriel Gonzalez went 3-for-3 with a double and raised his batting average to .312 on the year. High-A Cedar Rapids (36-25) best Peoria (STL) 6-2. Twins No. 4 prospect Kalen Culppepper picked up two hits and continues to rank among the top-10 in the Midwest League in average, slugging, and OPS. Low-A Fort Myers (27-31) were swept in two games, completing a suspended game from the night before and falling in a scheduled for 7-inning affair in the nightcap to Dunedin (TOR).

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Saturday at CHS Field against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and recorded his second start this year of 5.0 shutout innings to earn the win. Faced the minimum through the first two innings with the help of a pickoff. In the third, walked the leadoff batter, allowed a double, and walked another hitter to load up the bases with nobody out, but wriggled out of the jam with a shallow fly to right and two force outs at the plate on grounders. Had another potential run cut down at the plate on a fly-ball double play to end the fifth. Threw 34 sinkers (40%), 19 four-seamers (22%), 18 changeups (21%), and 15 sweepers (17%). Got seven swings-and-misses, led by three apiece on the four-seamer and changeup. His lone “K” came on the four-seamer, retiring Brennan Davis looking in the fifth.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp and the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints will mark the 10th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings, but worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineup in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT! Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed “The Dirtbags,” a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding “hard-nosed players with something to prove” and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally “dirtying the uniform.” The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former “Dirtbags” that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.

LAST APPEARANCE: On Tuesday in Indianapolis, made his second consecutive start and his first appearance of the season with the Saints since having his contract selected by Minnesota on June 6 (did not make his MLB debut). Worked three scoreless innings until giving up three straight singles to open the fourth before allowing a sac fly to Llover Peguero. Struck out the last two hitters he faced to end his night. Threw 18 sliders (26%), 16 cutters (24%), 13 sinkers (19%), 13 four-seamers (19%), 7 changeups (10%), and 1 curveball (1%). Generated 9 whiffs on the evening, led by five on his cutter. Recorded two of his four punchouts on the cutter and one each on the four-seamer and slider.

PITCHING LAB PAYING DIVIDENDS: Adams credits his success to a relationship built on trust with the Twins player development staff, who helped him add a cutter as well as convert his sweeper into a true slider with big swing-and-miss numbers (a 40.6% whiff-rate in four Triple-A appearances last season), helping him round out his six-pitch arsenal in 2024.

NOT ALL HEROES WEAR CAPES: Travis helped save the life of a stranger from a burning house in Fort Myers in March of 2024 during Spring Training. He heard a loud bang from the house across the street from where he was staying. He and another man ran out, and saw that the house was on fire. They started to bang on the door to see if anyone was inside. Three other people came out who knew the man inside and started yelling, "Howard, your house is on fire, get out!" Gaining entrance to the house was difficult because of so many objects around the outside of the house, but Travis went around the side of the house, tearing up a part of the fence down to get back to the area where another door was. He ended up opening the door, and safely escorting the man out of the burning building.

SIGHT-SEERS: Adams traveled through Kyoto, Osaka and the outskirts of Japan with fellow Twins minor leaguer Jaylen Nowlin following the 2024 season. It was a leisure trip, but the duo took time away from their vacation to travel two hours from Shibuya (on the outskirts of Tokyo) to meet their old coach in the Twins organization, Takashi Miyoshi (now a Minor League instructor with the Reds) at his youth clinic. Adams and Nowlin spoke to a group of 8-16 year olds about their journey through American baseball and the mental side of the game.

HORNET PRIDE: Adams played his college baseball at Cal-State Sacramento in the Western Athletic Conference. He was a three-year starter for the Hornets, regularly pitching as their Saturday night guy as a junior and forming a dynamic 1-2 punch atop the rotation with Scott Randall, who went nine picks after Adams in that summer's June 2021 Amateur Draft to the Pirates (the two have yet to face each other in a professional game entering the season). While at Cal-State Sacramento, Adams was known for his pinpoint control, issuing just 25 walks in 151.0 career innings, the lowest BB/9 rate in program history (min. 100 IP). The program has produced nine Major Leaguers entering the 2025 season, headlined by Rhys Hoskins and James Outman.
