LATE HOMER SINKS JUMBO SHRIMP

Enmanuel De Jesus pitched six strong innings on Saturday, but Jacksonville fell 4-1 to Lehigh Valley. The IronPigs struck in the bottom of the first on a Jim Haley RBI single. The score remained 1-0 all the way until the seventh, when Jerar Encarnacion's sacrifice fly evened the tally. In the eighth. however, Drew Ellis cracked a three-run home run to put Lehigh Valley back in front at 4-1. De Jesus yielded just one run on five hits with five strikeouts in his 6.0 innings. Jacksonvlle mustered only three hits in the losing effort.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 60 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 93-for-245 at the plate, slashing .380/.447/.510/.957 with nine doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 41 RBIs and 53 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.365) and second in the International League in OBP (.444). Among the 323 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the second-best swinging-strike rate (4.3%).

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 22 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 32-for-89 (.360/.441/.607/1.048) with eight doubles, one triple, four home runs and 19 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering 10 multi-hit contests. His 22-game on-base streak is the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since Justin Twine's 27-game run from July 19-August 19, 2018. Including Johnston's time with Pensacola in 2023, the Tacoma, Wash., has driven in 101 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 105 games.

'PEN PALS

Over the last two weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 11 games since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 18 runs 14 earned on 31 hits (8 1 H/9) in 34 1 innings for a 3.66 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 47 batters (12.3 K/9) against 24 walks (6.3 BB/9).

IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville has won nine out of their last 14 games, a stretch that has featured elite starting pitching. During the run. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have vielded three runs or fewer 10 times, working 66.2 innings out of the club's 114.0 innings thrown (58.5 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 7-3 with a 3.91 ERA (32 R, 29 ER in 66.2 innings). They have combined for 58 strikeouts (7.8 K/9) against only 25 walks (3.4 BB/9) and 65 hits allowed (8.8 H/9).

PUMPKIN BICE SEASON

Dylan Bice will start Sunday's series finale at Lehigh Valley, becoming the 20th different starter in 2023 for Jacksonville. Bice has not started a game since August 8, 2019, when he pitched a scoreless inning for the AZL Rangers against AZL Brewers Blue. His last start of more than one inning was also for the AZL Rangers on September 1, 2017, when he pitched 4.0 innings against AZL Indians. Bice has only started seven out of his 136 career appearances. Jacksonville set a franchise-record with 25 different starting pitchers in 2022.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In his 42 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 61-for-172, hitting .355/.401/.483/.884 with 12 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 15 RBIs and 31 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 12 multi-hit games in his last 30 games, batting 49-for-132 (.371/.417/.500/.917) with nine doubles, one triple, two homers, 11 RBIs and 25 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 259 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (45.4 percent). His 29.7 percent line drive rate is 18th.

SHRIMP BITES


