Today: Coming off a cancellation on Sunday (unplayable field), the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, play the opener in a six-game series. Lansing has won five of its last six games, including four of five at home vs. Cedar Rapids. The Nuts are 4-8 this vs. the Whitecaps.

Last Game, Saturday: Kernels 23, Lugnuts 15. Lansing third baseman **Jared Sprague-Lott** hit for the ninth cycle in team history, but the Kernels won a slugfest that featured 38 combined runs and 48 combined hits. Jay Thomason went 6-for-6 for the Kernels with six singles, tying the Midwest League single game record.

LUG-NOTES

Congrats, and Farewell! Southpaw **Ryan Magdic** was honored by the Midwest League as the Pitcher of the Week for June 9-14 after dicing up Cedar Rapids to the tune of a 77-pitch, seven-inning, three-hit, one-run, nine-strikeout gem last Friday. The A's promptly promoted the Canadian to Double-A Midland yesterday; there was no corresponding move. This is Magdic's first trip to the Class-AA level. He joins other promoted 2026 Lugnuts **Davis Diaz**, **Casey Yamauchi**, **Bobby Boser**, **Devin Taylor**, **Jackson Finley** and **Jay Dill**.

On Star Wars Night, in a Ballpark Not So Far Away: Saturday's 23-15 loss to the Kernels...

- tops the most runs ever scored in a game in Lugnuts history, an 18-17 loss to Michigan on August 31, 2001.
- Cedar Rapids collected 30 hits, most ever allowed by Lansing pitching in a game, and two hits away from tying the Midwest League single game record, set by Danville in 1951 in a 40-5 victory over Vincennes.
- the Kernels hit six home runs, two by Danny De Andrade, while Lansing hit two homers, one apiece by **Jared Sprague-Lott** and **Ali Camarillo**. Sprague-Lott hit for the cycle, completing the task with a single in a nine-run eighth inning (after tripling earlier in the inning). Camarillo had the chance to cycle immediately afterward, but - needing a triple - singled instead. Both players finished 4-for-6.
- the Kernels might have had 30 hits... but they only drew one walk. Meanwhile, the Lugnuts collected 18 hits and nine walks.
- the Kernels led 23-4 entering the bottom of the 6th... and the Lugnuts rallied with 11 unanswered runs, including nine in the 8th, to lose by eight. Cedar Rapids scored in each of the first six innings, while the Lugnuts scored in every inning between the 3rd and 8th.

Noisy Bats: In their last six games, the Nuts are batting .327/.435/.484, averaging 9.5 runs on 11.8 hits and 6.2 walks, plus 3.2 stolen bases.

Thievery: The Nuts have 29 steals in 31 attempts in June, second most in the Midwest League. In April and May combined, by comparison, the Lugnuts stole a league low 43 bases.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 74 double plays in 62 games, ranking 1st in all of Minor League Baseball.

Big League Nuts: 2024 Lugnut **Kade Morris** made his MLB debut on June 6 vs. Houston, becoming the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**). There are eight current Lugnuts on the Athletics: Bolte, Jump, **Lawrence Butler**, **Joey Estes**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

JUNE 16 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2015: Jason Leblebician homered twice and Richard Ureña and Chris Carlson homered once apiece, as the Lugnuts destroyed Bowling Green, 13-3, at Cooley Law School Stadium. With five games left in the first half, the Lugs broke a first-place tie and took a one-game lead on the Hot Rods. Anthony Alford went 4-for-5 with a double and a triple, and Starlyn Suriel pitched six shutout innings.

2017: Bo Bichette singled, doubled, homered and singled. Then he singled, doubled, struck out and singled again. Eight at-bats, seven hits, five runs batted in, all in a doubleheader's worth of excitement at South Bend, swept by the Lugnuts 8-5 and 6-1. In the process, Bichette brought his batting average up to an even .400. Game 1 included a wacky five-run sixth inning that brought the Nuts from 5-3 down, taking the lead on a fluke Nick Sinay RBI single – Sinay did not swing the bat, but Jared Cheek's fastball smacked off the knob and rebounded into play, bringing in Christian Williams with the tie-breaking run.

2024: Henry Bolte rocketed a home run off the video board in the ninth, but the Lugnuts came up short to Cedar Rapids, 9-8.
