TATE OF THE UNION: Southpaw Tate Kuehner will get the start for Nashville tonight against the Redbirds. It'll be his 17th Triple-A appearance since joining Nashville for two starts last year. It'll be his first career appearance against the Sounds' in-state rival. Kuehner worked 4.0 IP last Friday night against Durham with a run on two hits allowed and six strikeouts. His six strikeouts were the most in any of his five appearances for Nashville since returning from the Injured List on August 16. Since making his professional debut after being selected by Milwaukee in the 7th round of the 2023 MLB Draft, the left-hander ranks T-4th in the farm system in wins (17), 5th in IP (276.2), and 6th in strikeouts (295) and GS (54).

GOT WILK?: Brock Wilken hit his 17th home run of the season on Wednesday night, giving the Sounds their only run of the night and finished the game 1-for-3 with a walk and strikeout to go along with his eighth inning solo blast. The 17 home runs are tied for the second-most of his professional career, matching the total he had in 2024 with Double-A Biloxi. He has two homers over his last eight games, and recorded his 79th RBI of the season to leads the team and ranks 6th in the International League and 6th in the Brewers' farm system. He now ranks 10th in the organization for homers, and his 81 walks this season put him in sole possession of the 10th-most in a single-season in team history. He is one behind Steve Balboni (82, 1980) and has the second-most walks in a single-season for any Nashville player since 1984. Only Jon Singleton (117, 2022) has had more for Nashville over the last 42 seasons.

THAT'S A LOCK: With another multi-hit game for Nashville on Wednesday night, Brandon Lockridge extended his hitting streak to six straight games, and is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with three doubles, three RBI, and a pair of runs over his last six games. He is responsible for seven of Nashville's 19 hits over the last four games. He has a hit in 14 of his last 17 games overall since rejoining the Sounds on August 23.

CIRCLE THE WAGON: Right-hander Cameron Wagoner has not allowed an earned run over his last eight games and 9.1 IP total since allowing the only run of his Triple-A career so far with a RBI single against Memphis on August 4. Through his first 13 games with Nashville, Wagoner has surrendered just nine hits across 15.0 IP with 19 strikeouts and five walks and holding opposing batters to a .170 BAA (9-for-53). Jared Koenig (8 G / 8.0 IP) and Brett Wichrowski (8 G / 7.1 IP) have also worked eight straight appearances without an earned run. The trio of Nashville relievers are three off 11 different Nashville pitchers who have posted streaks of 8+ games without an earned run allowed this season are all tied for the 12th-longest active streaks in the IL.

HOME SWEET HOME: Nashville's win on Tuesday night over Memphis was the 46th of the year at home to lead all Triple-A teams this season. After Columbus' loss last night, Syracuse (43) is the only team that could challenge Nashville to finish the season with the most home wins in the International League. The Sounds led the league in home wins in 2022, finishing the year 48-27 at First Horizon Park, tied for the franchise's most wins at home in any season since 2005. Two more wins this week would guarantee the Sounds finish the second half of the season with a winning record - one of only two teams to have a winning record in all eight halves since moving to a split-season format in 2023. Oklahoma City (LAD) is the only other team to accomplish that.

BULLPEN BULLIES: With four games remaining in the 2026 regular season Nashville's bullpen owns the best ERA in Triple-A this season at 3.59. The mark currently sits as the 7th-best in any season for Nashville since 2005. The 2007 club posted a 3.31 ERA (162 ER/440.1 IP). The bullpen's 57 wins this year are already the club's most in any season since 2005 and tied for the 11th-most for any Triple-A team over the span. Round Rock's bullpen posted a Triple-A best since 2005 with 67 wins in 2023. St. Paul's bullpen has posted 63 wins this season to lead all Triple-A in 2026. They are followed by Las Vegas (62), Syracuse (62), and Rochester (59).

BROCK-OFF: Nashville's 5-4 walk-off win over Memphis on Tuesday night was the Sounds' eighth walk-off win of the year. Brock Wilken delivered the game-winning run with grounder to second base in the bottom of the 11th inning to score Ramon Rodriguez. Wilken is the eighth different player to deliver a walk-off win for Nashville this season. Tuesday night was Nashville's second time going to 11 innings this year and the first since May 15 against Iowa when the Sounds walked-off the I-Cubs 4-3. The Sounds improved to 3-8 in extra innings this year with the win.
