YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost, 3-2, to the Baysox, extending their season-long losing streak to six games. **Kyle Harrison** started on the mound and issued a walk to lead off the game but responded by striking out the final nine batters he faced in order. Bowie took a 3-0 lead with RBI doubles by Joey Ortiz, Shayne Fontana and Maverick Handley in the fourth. **Diego Rincones** broke the shutout with an RBI single in the sixth. He pulled Richmond within a run with a solo homer in the ninth, his fourth hit of the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams have met for three previous series. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with two wins in three games at Bowie from May 8-10. From April 26-May 1, the Flying Squirrels won five-of-six against the Baysox at The Diamond. In the first series of the second half, Richmond lost five-of-six against the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium. The two teams will also meet for a six-game series in Richmond from September 6-11. The Flying Squirrels are riding a six-game losing streak, their longest of the 2022 season so far.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-14 to open the second half. They won three straight prior to dropping the last six. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost six and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 987 strikeouts (111 per game) and rank tied for second with 113 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 25-19 at home this year. Richmond is 21-18 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 38-33 overall against the Southwest Division.

THE BAYSOX finished last in the Southwest Division in the first half of the season but are 12-6 in the second half, a 15 games ahead of Altoona for first place. Bowie won four-of-five in last week's series against the RubberDucks, winning the first four before falling in Sunday afternoon's finale. Bowie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Colton Cowser (3), 3B Coby Mayo (6), 2B Connor Norby (9), INF Cesar Prieto (10), SS Joseph Ortiz (13), OF Hudson Haskin (14), LHP Drew Rom (15) and RHP Zach Peck (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his league-leading 19th start of the season and his fourth against the Baysox. He last pitched on Sunday in Altoona and was hit with a loss after allowing five runs over three innings. Over his previous five starts since June 19, Teng went 3-1 with a 2.93 ERA (10 ER/30.2 IP). Teng made his Double-A debut at Bowie on April 9 and threw five scoreless innings with six strikeouts. On April 27 at The Diamond, he allowed six runs over four innings against the Baysox in a loss. He pitched in Bowie on July 1 and allowed three runs over 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Justin Armbruester makes his sixth Double-A appearance and second start. Today marks his first start since June 22, his Double-A debut. He has worked out of the bullpen his last four outings, including four scoreless innings against the Flying Squirrels on June 28 at Prince George's Stadium. Armbruester was selected in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of the University of New Mexico. He pitched eight games in his professional-debut season last year, including seven for Low-A Delmarva. Armbruester began this year with High-A Aberdeen, where he went 2-1 with a 4.02 ERA in 12 starts. He was promoted to Double-A on June 21. Last time out, he allowed six runs (three earned) over 2.2 relief innings last Sunday against Akron.

SLIDE HITS SIX: The Flying Squirrels have lost a season-high six consecutive games since July 14, which is the longest active losing streak in the Eastern League. It is also the third-longest active losing streak in all of Minor League Baseball, trailing on a nine-game streak by Double-A Arkansas and a seven-game streak by the FCL Twins. The Richmond offense has been held to three-or-less runs in all six losses. In that span, Flying Squirrels batters have combined to hit .181 (34-for-188). The last time the Flying Squirrels lost seven consecutive games was July 18-July 25, 2018.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (265,176) and average attendance (6,167). Richmond is 13th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year. The streak is the longest since the Flying Squirrels lost six consecutive games from July 21-27, 2021.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 113 home runs this season, which is tied for second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (125). **Sean Roby** is first in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 175 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .359 (42-for-117) with six doubles, seven homers and 27 RBIs over his last 30 games since June 7. In the series at Bowie from June 28-July 3, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. Over the next two series from July 4-17 against Reading and Altoona, Rincones hit .186 (8-for-43) with two doubles, a homer and eight RBIs in 11 games. He is 5-for-6 with a homer and two RBIs in this weekend's series against the Baysox, including a 4-for-4 game on Saturday night.

SHANE TRAIN: From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last 14 games since July 1, Matheny is batting .102 (5-for-49) with two doubles and six RBIs and has walked 10 times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked sixth in OBP (.387).

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** hit .333 (12-for-36) with a homer, two doubles and six RBIs over nine games from July 2-15 but is 0-for-12 in his last three games since Sunday. On July 6, he hit the first grand slam of his professional career in a win over Reading. He hit .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. He has hit 25 homers in his Flying Squirrels career, tied for fourth-most in franchise history. In the Eastern League this year, Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.284) and tied for fifth in hits (83).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is first in the EL in home runs this year ahead of Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

SMITH SURGING: In his last 10 games since July 7, **Armani Smith** is batting .306 (11-for-36) with four doubles and seven RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in four-of-his-last-eight games. Last Tuesday and Wednesday in Altoona, he played on the infield for the first time in his professional career, manning first base.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered five times over his last eight games played since July 10. He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer last Thursday night in Altoona, hit two solo homers on Friday night and hit another on Sunday afternoon in the series finale. In his last eight games since July 9, Fitzgerald is batting .333 (9-for-27) with five homers, a double and five RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.284) and tied for fifth in hits (83). **Sean Roby** is first in homers (23) and 10th in SLG (.493). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in OBP (.387). **Mike Gigliotti** is ninth in OBP (.378), tied for eighth in walks (45) and fourth in stolen bases (22). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (15). **Ryan Walker** is tied for fourth in wins (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genovés** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
