G-STALL: Right-hander Garrett Stallings will make his third overall appearance and second straight start as he takes the mound for Nashville Wednesday night in Gwinnett. The 2025 Nashville Sounds Pitcher of the Year worked three scoreless innings on three hits with a pair of strikeouts last week against Charlotte in his first start of the 2026 season. The Virginia native posted five quality starts for Nashville a season ago, the second most on the pitching staff behind Bruce Zimmermann (6). Wednesday's start against Gwinnett will be his 10th career appearance against the the Stripers and he enters the game 1-1 with a 2.96 ERA over 24.1 IP with 13 strikeouts and five walks all-time against Gwinnett.

TWO-NA FISH: Nashville was limited to just two hits on Tuesday night, their fewest in a game this season and the fewest since being no-hit on June 27, 2025, on the road in Jacksonville. The Sounds were held to two or fewer hits six times during the 2025 season, but just three times in a nine-inning game. Two of them came in a three-game span on the road in Gwinnett. The first was April 2, and then again on April 4 (10 innings).

OFF AND RUNNING: Nashville allowed a season-high 10 stolen bases to Gwinnett in Tuesday's opener. The 10 stolen bases set a franchise-high for the Stripers, and it was just the fourth time a Triple-A team has had 10 stolen bases in a game since the 2005 season. Tacoma (Seattle) swiped 11 bases against Las Vegas on August 15 last season. Triple-A El Paso (San Diego) stole 10 against Oklahoma City on August 1, 2024. Fresno also had 10 on April 10, 2011, against Las Vegas. Prior to Tuesday's game against Gwinnett, Nashville had only allowed 7+ stolen bases in a game three times dating back to 2005, including a single-game high of 8 last season on August 9 vs. Jacksonville.

ON THE HOOK: Nashville's 14 strikeouts as a pitching staff in the series opener were the most in a game since also posting 14 on August 28, 2025, against the Charlotte Knights. The Sounds recorded nine games of 14+ strikeouts during the 2025 season, with a season-high of 16 in a 10-inning game on March 30 vs. Jacksonville. The 14 strikeouts were the most in a game against Gwinnett since May 11, 2023, when Nashville pitchers struck out 19 Gwinnett batters.

FROM THE SIX: Tyler Black extended his hitting streak to six games with a single in the bottom of the sixth inning Sunday against Charlotte. Black started his streak on the Saturday of the opening weekend in Norfolk and is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with a home run, five walks, and five runs scored during the span. He posted two different hitting streaks of at least 7 games last season with Nashville including a season-best 10-game hit streak from July 9-30. He set his career-high with a 16 game hitting streak between September 17, 2023 that carried over into March of 2024 with Nashville.

NUKE ADAMS: Luke Adams made it back-to-back games with a home run after getting Nashville on the board with a 423-ft solo shot to the left field berm on Sunday afternoon against Charlotte. His second homer of the season came off his bat at 110 MPH in the fourth inning. The Brewers' no. 13-rated prospect added another hit and RBI in the bottom of the sixth to give him his first multi-hit game of the season and he leads the team with eight RBI on his three hits. Sunday's series finale against Charlotte was the eighth time in his professional career with a home run in back-to-back games. He homered in three straight games from June 5-7, 2025, with Double-A Biloxi to set his career-high for consecutive games with a homer. He's the first Sound with a homer in consecutive games since Raynel Delgado did it on August 19-20 of last season.

CALL IT A COMEBACK: Sunday was Nashville's first win of the season when trailing at any point through the first eight games of the season. Nashville scored six unanswered runs after Charlotte took a 5-1 lead in the top of the fifth inning. The Sounds took the lead in the bottom of the eighth inning with four runs, all with two outs, despite not hitting a ball out of the infield. They used a bases loaded hit by pitch, a bases loaded walk that was unsuccessfully challenged by Charlotte, and two wild pitches to help make it a 7-5 game.
