JUMBO SHRIMP ROLL BY BULLS TO TAKE SERIES

Erik González went 4-for-6 with two doubles and two RBIs and Joe Dunand reached base five times on Sunday to propel the Jumbo Shrimp to an 8-1 victory over Durham. Jacksonville jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning and did not look back. After the Bulls plated their lone run of the game, the Jumbo Shrimp tallied one in the third, two in the sixth, one in the seventh and one in the ninth for an 8-1 margin. All nine Jacksonville hitters reached base at least one, with six doing so multiple times. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined to yield only three hits in six scoreless innings, fanning nine.

THIRD WHEFL

Jacksonville won the final three games of its series in Durham to take its first series of the year. In the process of registering that first set victory, the Jumbo Shrimp outscored the Bulls 29-9 with a 42-13 advantage in hits and a 7-1 margin in home runs. In addition to the club's dominance over the last three games - the Jumbo Shrimp rank second out of 120 MiLB teams in hits, tied for third in home runs and tied for fourth in runs over this span -Jacksonville racked up 13 runs on 17 hits in Saturday's win over the Bulls. The 13 runs scored by Jacksonville marked the club's third-highest total over the last four seasons (since 2018), trailing a 15-run outburst at Chattanooga on July 19, 2019 and the 14 runs the club scored in that Charlotte game on July 27, 2021. The 17 hits tallied by the Jumbo Shrimp last night were bested during this same fourseason span only by the 19 the club totaled in Chattanooga on July 19, 2019.

Jacksonville has popped 17 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Entering play on Tuesday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in five of the last six games.

FRROR 404: NOT FOUND

While the Jumbo Shrimp have hit well to start 2022, the club's run prevention has struggled, with Jacksonville yielding 65 runs through 12 games, the eighth-most in the International League. The Jumbo Shrimp's run prevention struggles, though, are of little fault of the club's defense; Jacksonville's defense has turned 70.4 percent of balls put in play into outs, above the 70.0-percent average. Additionally, the Jumbo Shrimp's six errors are tied for the sixth-fewest in the circuit. Entering play on Tuesday, Jacksonville has made just one error in the last six games, a span of 52 innings.

MEN OF STEAL

Through the first 11 games of the season, Jacksonville mustered just four stolen bases, tied for the second-fewest in the International League and knotted for the 13th-fewest out of the 120 Minor League Baseball teams. However, in Sunday's series finale at Durham, Jacksonville swiped five bases, all coming in the contest's first four innings. Those five steals are tied for the most in any game for any Triple-A team this season, and match the most for any Jacksonville club since the Jacksonville Suns swiped six bases on April 10, 2016 vs. Birmingham.

SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE

The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for fourth in the International League in runs (75; 6.3 per game), and the biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting .256/.438/.411, producing a .759 OPS that ranks ninth in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .293/.364/.522, with the resulting .886 OPS placing second in the circuit.

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15

-Meyer is currently ranked among the top 50 prospects in baseball by Baseball Prospectus (No. 24) and MLB.com (No. 35).

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in innings pitched

-Among the 200 pitchers who recorded at least 50.0 innings in Double-A at the time of Meyer's promotion, he ranked 12th in ERA (2.41) and 30th in FIP (3.34) while posting the level's 14th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent) and 26th-lowest fly ball rate (28.3 percent).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
