**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds begin a six-game series tonight against the Memphis Redbirds at AutoZone Park. The Sounds are coming off their second consecutive series loss. Left-hander Ethan Small starts for Nashville, facing right-hander Aaron Brooks for Memphis.

**Ethan Small:** 25-year-old Ethan Small starts for the Sounds in tonight's series opener. The left-hander is 3-2 with a 2.41 ERA (41.0 IP/11 ER) in nine starts for Nashville this season. He also has a 6.75 ERA (2.2 IP/2 ER) in one outing with Milwaukee. Small last pitched on June 8 vs. Norfolk, taking the loss in the series opener against the Tides. He allowed seven runs (3 ER) on five hits and a walk. Small struck out one in 2.2 innings of work, firing 51 pitches (31 strikes). The Spring Hill, Tenn. resident began the season as the No. 7 prospect in the Brewers organization, according to MLB Pipeline. He was named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star in 2021 after going 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA in nine starts with Nashville and 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in eight starts with Double-A Biloxi. A graduate of Lexington (TN) High School, Small was the SEC Pitcher of the Year with Mississippi State his junior year with the Bulldogs. He was drafted by the Brewers in the First Round (28th Pick) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

**Aaron Brooks:** 32-year-old Aaron Brooks will be Memphis' starting pitcher in tonight's series opener. The right-hander is 1-3 with an 8.86 ERA (21.1 IP/21 ER) in five starts for the Redbirds this season. He also has a 7.71 ERA (9.1 IP/8 ER) in five outings (no starts) for St. Louis in 2022. Last time out, Brooks allowed eight runs (all earned) on nine hits and four walks in 3.1 innings in a loss at Durham on June 9. He struck out a couple of Bulls in his 82 pitches (47 strikes) of work. Brooks pitched with the Kia Tigers of the Korean Baseball Organization in 2021, going 3-5 with a 3.35 ERA in 13 starts. The Montclair, Calif. native made two starts for the Sounds in 2015, going 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA. He was originally drafted by the Royals in the Ninth Round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State San Bernardino.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 49; Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives:** On Sunday, the Sounds dropped to 8-2 in series finales, 7-2-1 in overall series, 20-10 at First Horizon Park...23-18 against AL affiliates...15-17 when allowing at least one home run and 2-8 when allowing 10+ hits.

**On The Road Again:** Nashville enters tonight's game with a 16-13 record on the road, as compared to 20-10 at home. Despite the W/L difference, Sounds hitters have a .419 slugging percentage and .788 OPS on the road compared to .389 and .743 at home. Abraham Almonte (.313, 20-for-64) and Mario Feliciano (.352, 25-for-71) are leading the team on the road.

**It's a Small Road:** Starter Ethan Small has done his best work away from First Horizon Park this year. In four road starts, Small is 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA (22.0 IP/3 ER) compared to 1-2 with a 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP/8 ER) in five starts at home.

**Clutch RBI for Tyler White:** Infielder/DH Tyler White collected two more RBI Saturday night and has a team-high 9 multi-RBI games. Both RBI on Saturday were with two outs to bring White's two-out RBI total to 15 on the season - also a team-high. With running in scoring position this year, White is hitting .298 (14-for-47). In his last 11 games, the North Carolina native is batting .324 (12-for-38) with 7 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 9 RBI and 5 walks.

**Sizzling Sadzeck:** Connor Sadzeck continued his dominant pitching on Saturday with his second save in as many opportunities. The right-hander is 1-1 with a 1.33 ERA (20.1 IP/3 ER). Sadzeck has 24 strikeouts and is limiting hitters to a .192 batting average.

**The Nashville List:** Last night's win for Rick Sweet was his 183rd as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

**He Gets On Base:** Jonathan Davis has reached base safely in a team-best 23 consecutive games. During the 23-game streak, Davis is hitting .297 (27-for-91) with 15 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 16 walks and 6 stolen bases. It's the 3rd-longest active streak in the International League. He also holds the second-best OBP in the IL at .422, trailing only Worcester's Rob Refsnyder at .429.

**Earn It:** Despite Sunday's loss, the Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.63 ERA. Buffalo check in second with a 4.07 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**LAST OUTING:** Small last pitched on June 7 vs. Norfolk in the series opener against the Tides. He allowed seven runs (3 ER) on five hits and one walk in 2.2 innings. The lefty totaled 51 pitches (31 strikes) in his second loss of the year.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Small is facing Memphis for the second time in his career and the first time this season. His only outing against the Redbirds came on September 10, 2021 at First Horizon Park. Small pitched 4.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 2 BB, 2 K) in Nashville's 8-2 win that night.
