By the Numbers

After not hitting a home run in his first 115 Minor League games, INF Nate Furman has hit his first 7 professional home runs in his last 24 contests.

Lake County's 399 hits through its first 44 games are the most in franchise history since the 2007 team tallied 403 hits in 44 games. Notable future Major Leaguers on that team included RHPs Chris Archer and Josh Tomlin.

The trio of INF **Nate Furman**, INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus**, and C **Cooper Ingle** make up the entire top 3 in the Midwest League in AVG this week, hitting a combined .556 (25-for-45) so far this series.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: A pair of 4-run innings propelled the Captains to an 8-6 victory over the Whitecaps in front of a season-high 7,146 fans at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

Trailing 3-0 entering the bottom of the 5th inning, an RBI infield single from CF **Guy Lipscomb** put Lake County on the board. Then, in the ensuing at-bat, LF **Steven Kwan**, serving an MLB rehab assignment for the Cleveland Guardians, hit a go-ahead, 3-run home run to give the Captains a 4-3 lead. <u>This was Kwan's 1st Minor League homer since</u> 9/30/21 vs. the Louisville Bats (Triple-A, CIN) with the Triple-A Columbus Clippers.

2 innings later, trailing 6-4, 3 consecutive singles loaded the bases with 1 out. C Cooper Ingle capitalized by hitting Lake County's 2nd grand slam of the season, which put the Captains in front for good.

RHP Alaska Abney (2-0) earned his 2nd win of the season, pitching 2 scoreless innings of relief in the 7th and 8th. He allowed 1 hit and threw 3 strikeouts, facing just 7 batters. Finally, RHP **Zane Morehouse** earned his 3rd save of the season in his 4th opportunity, allowing 1 walk and striking out the final 2 batters he faced to end the game.

WILKINSON'S STRONG DEBUT: LHP Matt Wilkinson fared well in his 1st career High-A start. The left-hander pitched 5 innings, allowing 4 hits, a career-high 3 earned runs, and no walks, while throwing 8 strikeouts in 87 pitched (58 strikes).

INGLE IGNITES: C Cooper Ingle has had a remarkable series this week, batting .533 (8-for-15) with 1 home run, 6 RBI, and a 1.344 OPS. Ingle's .611 OBP ranks tied for 2nd in the MWL this week with teammate C.J. Kayfus.

JAKE RAKES: OF Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, is batting .412 (7-for-17) this series with a team-high 7 RBI. Fox's 7 RBI are tied for the 3rd-most in the MWL during this span.

2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN: Lake County leads the season series 10-4 through 14 games. The Captains took 2 of 3 games from April 6-7 at home and won 5 of 6 contests from April 23-28. Lake County is 10-1 in games that follow a West Michigan series-opening win.

2-OUT HITTING: As a team, the Captains have hit .322 with 19 hits and 9 RBI with 2 outs so far this series. Lake County's .285 AVG with 2 outs leads all teams from High-A through MLB.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,778 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,398-1,380 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

A KWAN-FORGETTABLE WEEKEND: Cleveland Guardians OF Steven Kwan will make a rehab assignment Saturday and Sunday for the Captains, his first action since being moved to the 10-day injured list with a left hamstring strain. At the time of his injury. Kwan led the American League with a .353 AVG and 47 hits.

ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT: On Tuesday, Cleveland announced the promotion of LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson to Lake County. Wilkinson, a 10th round pick in 2023 out of Central Arizona College (JUCO), leads Minor League Baseball with 79 strikeouts, while ranking 7th with a 0.77 WHIP through 9 starts across Single-A Lynchburg (8) and Lake County 11). The Vancouver, B.C. native fanned a seasonhigh 15 batters on April 25 vs. the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC) in 6 scoreless, hitless innings. According to Mil.B.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th Mil.B pitcher since 2005 with 15+ strikeouts without allowing a hit.

YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY: But it just may be a Lipscomb that you're looking for. With an RBI infield single on Saturday, Captains OF Guy Lipscomb ranks 2nd in High-A with both a .400 AVG and 4th with a .471 OBP in the month of May. He has reached base in 18 of 19 games played this month.

FURMANATION: Lake County INF Nate Furman extended his hitting streak to 11 games in Friday night's win vs. West Michigan, trailing only Beloit INF Josh Zamora (13 games) for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. Furman is the only player in the MVL with multiple hitting streaks of 10+ games this season. He is batting .529 (27-for-51) with 6-home runs and 14 RBI during this streak.

TOP QUALITY: Through 44 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 14 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A and tied for 7th in MiLB. RHPS Austin Peterson (6), Trenton Denholm (4), Carter Spivey (3) and LHP Parker Messick (2), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, have recorded quality starts for the Captains this year.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (15, 1s), fewest walks (50, 1s), strikeouts (207, 2so), innings pitched (215.0, 2so), and WHIP (1.22, 4so).

WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY: Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this season. The team leads the Midwest League in: AVG (.270), hits (399), total bases (600), OBP (.361), SLG (.407), and OPS (.768). The Captains¹ .270 AVG, 399 hits, 600 total bases, .361 OBP, and .768 OPS lead all of High-A.

LAST TIME OUT: For the 1st time in his Minor League career, **Carter Spivey** started twice in the same series against Lansing. In his most recent start against the Lugnuts on May 19. **Spivey** picked up the no decision, allowing a season-high 9 runs (7 unearned) and 12 hits while striking out 4 and walking none in the eventual 13-10 win in extra innings. The Captains entered the top of the 9th down 9-7, forced extra innings and scored 6 unanswered runs to win the series finale.

LAST START AGAINST WEST MICHIGAN: Spivey made his 2nd start against the Whitecaps back on April 26, earning his 1st of 3 straight quality starts from April 23 to May 2. The right-hander allowed 1 run on 5 hits and fanned a Minor League high-tying 6 batters in the 7-1 win.

A NEW FRONTIER: After his 5-year collegiate career at East Carolina University ended in 2023, Spivey made eight starts in independent ball for the Florence Y'alls (Florence, KY) of the Frontier League from July 22 to September 1. He tallied 4 quality starts for the Y'alls and posted a 3.06 ERA, the lowest on the team among pitchers that threw 40+ innings. Spivey went 7+ innings in 2 starts (August 3 at Evansville and August 20 at Joliet). Starting with San Diego RHP Brian Tollberg making his Major League debut on June 20, 2000, 52 Frontier League alumni have made the Majors.

A PIRATE'S LIFE FOR SPIVEY: Spivey went 17-4 with a 4.71 ERA in 83 games (15 starts) across five seasons at East Carolina from 2019-23. The right-hander was a teammate of current Cleveland Guardians RHP Gavin Williams from 2019-21. In 2023, Spivey was a 2nd Team All-American Athletic Conference selection. He went 7-3 with a 4.68 ERA in 24 games (10 starts), moving into the weekend rotation by the end of the season. The Fairfax, Virginia native was also tabbed the 2023 AAC Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Spivey's 15 wins over his last 2 seasons were the most by any AAC pitcher during that span.

HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE: On April 15, 2023 against the University of Cincinnati, **Spivey** pitched a complete game shutout in 7 innings. He allowed 4 hits and no walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in the 10-0 win.

2022 IN THE JUNGLE: Pitching at Clark-LeClair Stadium, nicknamed "The Jungle," **Spivey** was named the 2022 AAC Pitcher of the Year. He went a perfect 8-0 with a 2.83 ERA and 76 strikeouts in 76.1 innings of work. The 24-year-old was also named the ECU Jungle Pitching MVP. The right-hander was a Collegiate Baseball 3rd Team All-American and a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year. **Spivey** made 35 appearances, the eighth-most in the country and third-most in a season in program history. In the Greenville Regional, he went 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA and a .214 opposing average. **Spivey** also finished with 5 saves, which ranked second in the AAC behind Houston's Ben Sears.

SHIPMATE STEVEN: Cleveland Guardians outfielder Steven Kwan will complete a rehab assignment for the Lake County Captains on Saturday, May 25 and Sunday, May 26, wearing #36. Kwan was placed on the 10-day injured list on May 5 with a left hamstring strain. Last night, Kwan went 1-for-3 with a go-ahead 3-run home run in the bottom of the 5th inning and recorded two putouts at left field. Kwan joined Casey Blake (2006) and Carlos Santana (2012) as the only players to hit a home run for Lake County during a rehab stint.

SKIPPED THE SHIP: Saturday and Sunday will mark **Kwan's** first two games as a Lake County Captain. After being selected in the 5th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Oregon State, **Kwan** spent parts of 2018 in the Arizona League and with Low-A Mahoning Valley, 2019 with High-A Lynchburg, and parts of 2021 with Double-A Akron and Triple-A Columbus before making his MLB debut with the Guardians on April 7, 2022.

THE CHOSEN KWAN: Kwan played in 32 of Cleveland's first 33 team games before his hamstring strain. Among MLB players in the first 33 team games of 2024, he ranked among MLB players in hits (47, T-2nd) and runs (28, T-4th). **Kwan** became the 5th Cleveland hitter with 45+ hits & 27+ runs through the first 30 games of a season, last done by **Manny Ramirez** in 1995.

THE K IS SILENT: Kwan has actively gone 16 consecutive games for the Guardians without tallying a strikeout, a stretch marking 70 plate appearances dating back to April 16th @ BOS. He is the first Cleveland hitter to go 16+ games without a strikeout since **Omar Vizquel** (16 games, July 16-August 5, 1996). 16 games mark the longest streak without a strikeout by an MLB hitter since SFG/HOU's Mauricio Dubón (18 games/52 PA; 5/4-6/11/2022). **Kwan's** 70 straight plate appearances without a strikeout mark the most by an MLB hitter since OAK's Tony Kemp (26 games/86 PA; 8/19-9/24/2021).

2023 IN REVIEW (via Cleveland Guardians): Kwan made another significant impact in his sophomore 2023 campaign. Defensively, he ranked 3rd in the AL/5th in MLB with 16 defensive runs saved. He also played 1,352.0 innings in the outfield, trailing only ATL's Ronald Acuña Jr. for the most in MLB. In the batter's box, **Kwan** showcased another year of stellar plate discipline. His 9.57 PA/SO ranked 4th in MLB, just ahead of teammate and former Captain **José Ramírez** (5th, 9.47). **Kwan** also posted an 11.1% swing-and-miss rate, which ranked 2nd-best in MLB in 2023. He tallied 171 hits, 36 doubles, 54 RBI, 93 runs, and 21 stolen bases in 158 games played during the season. This made him the first Cleveland outfielder to post a 35+ double, 20+ steal season since **Michael Brantley** in 2014.

FIRST TWO YEARS (via Cleveland Guardians): In his first 2 seasons of MLB play, Kwan ranked highly among all MLB players in a slew of categories. He ranked top 10 among all MLB players in singles (253, 2nd), % of swings put in play (49.6%, 3rd), swing-and-miss rate (10.2%, 3rd), triples (14, T-3rd), PA/SO (10.04, 4th), infield hits (47, 6th), 4+ hit games (6, T-7th) and 3+ hit games (27, 9th). Among Cleveland hitters in the first 2 seasons of their MLB career, he ranked in games played (305, 1st), bWAR (9.1 T-1st), hits (339, 2nd), runs (182, 2nd), doubles (61, 3rd) and stolen bases (40, T-3rd). Most notably, however, Kwan is a 2-time American League Gold Glove Award winner.

He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
