TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona continues a 6-game series at Erie.

Andrew Sears starts tonight for Erie, his 9th appearance and 7th start for them this year. Sears was a 10th round selection by Detroit out of the University of Connecticut in 2023 and played his first two seasons of college baseball at Rhode Island College. Sears was one of the biggest risers in the Tigers system a year ago and began the season on the IL, he works from the extreme third-base side of the rubber, and has a big cross fire and a low release. He's neither a great athlete nor a precise strike-thrower, but he tends to hit the box and hitters don't seem to pick up the ball well against him. He's capable of running his upshot fastball up to 97, albeit with more velocity variation than most guys. His primary secondary is his slider, an east-west offering that gives lefties in particular a ton of trouble. He'll also work in a cutter and change.

MOSS IS BOSS: 1B Callan Moss ranks 5th in the Eastern League in hits (100) and 3rd in doubles (23) entering play on August 6. Moss has started off August on fire by going 8-for-16 (.500) with 1 HR and 2 RBI, recording a 1.244 OPS.

SO LONG, PARTNER: At the trade deadline the Pirates traded two current Curve players, C Omar Alfonzo and RHP Kyle Robinson. Alfonzo went to NYY in the Camilo Doval deal and Robinson went to LAA for Kirby Yates.

TALL MATT PROVIDES LENGTH: In 3 of his last 5 outings in July, righty Matt Ager fired at least 6.0 innings for the Curve. In four outings in July he held his opponent to 2 runs or fewer and struck out 21 batters in 26.2 IP with 7 BB.

EASTON BATS ON SALE IN CURVE, PA: Catcher Easton Carmichael recorded his first career multi-homer game on Thursday, July 30 against Chesapeake. Carmichael went 3-for-5 with 2 HR and 5 RBI in the win. Among MiLB catchers, Carmichael ranks 2nd in hits (103), 8th in HR (18), 6th in RBI (68) and 11th in SLG% (.509).

LONNIE LONGBALLS: Outfielder Lonnie White Jr. slammed a his third career two-homer game on July 28 against Chesapeake, his second two-homer game since the All-Star Break. White Jr. is third among Pirates minor leaguers in homers this season with 22 and has set his career-high with 56 RBI this season. In his last 16 games since the All-Star break, he's batting .393 (24-for-61) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR, 12 RBI and a 1.235 OPS. White Jr. led the Eastern League with 8 HR in the month of July.

AL TUNA IS TIRED: Coming out of the All-Star break, Altoona leads the Eastern League with 28 HR (4th among Double-A clubs). Lonnie White Jr. has homered 6 times since the break. Altoona's 31 HR led the Eastern League in July.

GRAY ZONE: One of the most productive hitters in the minors this season, Murf Gray, joined the Curve on Friday, July 17 as the team returned from All-Star Break. Gray ranks among all minor league players in several categories: 9th in HR (27) and 9th in SLG% (.591). Among Pirates minor leaguers, he is 2nd in hits (113), T-1st in HR (27), 1st in RBI (80) and 5th in 2B (20) across 96 games. Gray has reached base in all 15 games he's played for the Curve recording a .415 OBP and a .894 OPS with 1 2B, 4 HR and 10 RBI.

KRISTHIAN TORTOSA: Lefty Cristhian Tortosa has punched out 18 hitters over 10.2 innings over his last 6 outings since July 9, allowing just 2 unearned runs in that time. Tortosa has struck out at least 3 batters in 7-of-10 outings with Altoona.

PUPPIES: Among the 22 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 12 have made their Double-A debut this season. Only 5 pitchers (23 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut.

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 26 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 112 home runs in 104 games, they're on pace to hit 148 homers which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022. 20 different players have hit a home run this season, 2nd-most by an Eastern League club. Eastern League clubs surpassed the league total of 1,223 home runs in 2025 on July 19 this season.

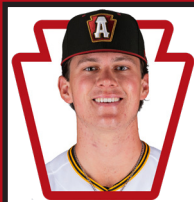

Matthew Lance Ager (Matt)... Resides in Pleasanton, CA... Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$357,400... Attended Foothill HS in Pleasanton, CA... Grew up a San Francisco Giants fan... His parents both have Pittsburgh connections, his father Jeff graduated from Penn-Trafford and his mother, Lisa, graduated from Bethel Park, the two met at Penn State and moved to California after college (h/t Noah Hiles, Pittsburgh-Post Gazette)... His grandmother, Luise is a fierce Pirates fan and told her son "It was the best day of her life" when Matt was drafted by the Pirates... Luise and Matt's uncle live near Harrison City about a 90-minute drive from Peoples Natural Gas Field and are regularly in attendance when he pitches... Was an Economics major at UC Santa Barbara... Was 1 of 4 UC-Santa Barbara players drafted in the 6th and 7th round in 2024 (Ryan Gallagher (Cubs, 6th round), Aaron Parker (Blue Jays, 6th round), and Ivan Brethowr (7th round, Cubs)... Was a teammate of Brethowr this season at Greensboro and with Altoona... Faced Aaron Parker for the first time as a pro on June 5 at NH... The two are close friends - Parker walked and singled off Ager...

In 2026... Entered the season as Baseball America's No. 23 prospect... Allowed 2R or fewer in 5-of-6 outings with Greensboro to begin the season... Pitched to a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) as a piggy-back on Carlson Reed... Transferred to ALT on 5/12... 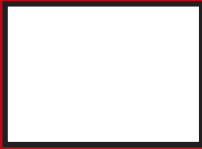
