TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for tonight's game, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers) host the San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants) in game four of a six-game home stand. 1,500 fans will take home a Rancho Cucamonga BBQs Jersey tonight, thanks to Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel. Tickets for all Quakes home games are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the fourth of 12 against the Giants here in 2024 and the fourth of six at LoanMart Field. Last season, the Quakes went 8-4 against the Giants, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Giants won a wild shootout on Thursday night at LoanMart Field, scoring a run with two outs in the ninth inning to take the lead for good in a 13-12 win over the Quakes. Justin Bench, who smashed a two-run homer (2) earlier in the game, singled home Ty Hanchey with a two-out single off Reynaldo Yean (2-1) for the eventual game-winner. San Jose reliever Josh Wolf (1-0), who blew a save by allowing the Quakes to tie the game in the eighth, worked a 1-2-3 ninth for his first win of the year. Bo Davidson (5) clubbed a grand slam and finished with five RBIs, while Elian Rayo (5) also went deep. Wilman Diaz led the Quakes with five hits and four RBIs, season-bests. Both the Giants and the Quakes blew multiple leads, including four-run leads for each team.

WHERE THERE'S A "WILMAN", THERE'S A WAY: Wilman Diaz had a career-night on Thursday, becoming the first Quake this year to record a five-hit game. His .244 batting average is the highest it's been since he entered the April 25 game with a .255 average. Diaz also matched his season-best with four RBIs. Diaz now leads the team in RBIs with 44, two more than Juan Alonso.

THE CLOSE ONES: The Quakes have played in four straight one-run games and in six of their last eight, including three straight to open this series. Rancho is 2-2 in those four games and is now 16-11 in one-run games in 2024. **SOUTH DIVISION TIGHTENING UP:** Thursday's setback was a costly one for Rancho, as they were the only South Division team to lose last night. The Quakes have won four of their last seven and six of their last nine, but Rancho's now tied with Lake Elsinore at the top of the South Division second-half standings. Most importantly, they have a one-game lead over Visalia, who is the biggest threat to the Quakes making the playoffs in 2024, as Lake Elsinore already won the first half. The Quakes must finish ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (currently five games back) in order to make the playoffs.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made multiple roster moves over the last two days. Earlier today, Rancho added RHP Marco Corcho from the Arizona Complex League. On Thursday, the Quakes moved catcher Jesus Galiz to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League. Taking his spot on the roster is catcher Victor Rodrigues, who joins Rancho from the ACL, where he hit .265 with two homers and 12 RBIs.

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Linan makes his ninth appearance and his second start, his first appearance against San Jose. In his last appearance, he allowed just one run on two hits over 4.2 innings of relief in a win at Inland Empire on July 27. Linan made six appearances (one start) in the ACL this year, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA, allowing three runs on nine hits over 13 innings with 21 strikeouts and only two walks prior to getting moved up to Rancho in mid-June. Linan is from Columbia and signed with the Dodgers in 2022.

SHANE RADEMACHER: Right-hander Shane Rademacher will make his 20th appearance and eighth start, his first against the Quakes. In his last start, he allowed six runs on six hits over four innings in a no-decision vs Modesto on July 27. Rademacher signed as an undrafted free agent in 2023 after playing college ball at Chowan University in NC. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2024 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
