TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open up a six-game set with Akron for their final matchups of the season, Altoona is 7-11 vs. the 'Ducks.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona dropped their series finale at Bowie with a 5-4 walk-off defeat. Altoona took the lead on a **Malcom Nuñez** RBI single, only to see Colton Cowser win the series for the Baysox with a 2-run homer in the 9th.

BLAKEY: Catcher **Blake Sabol** was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis following Altoona's series at Bowie. Sabol finishes his time with the Curve on an 11-game hit streak during which he batted .395 (17-for-43) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI and a 1.124 OPS. Following play on Sunday, August 28, Sabol ranked 3rd in the EL in BA (.281), 6th in SLG % (.486) and 8th in OPS (.833).

HAMMERIN' HANK IS BACK: Catcher **Henry Davis** has returned to Altoona's active roster after a 7-week stint on the IL. Davis, the No.1 overall selection in the 2021 draft out of Louisville, last appeared for Altoona on Saturday, July 2. In a four-game rehab assignment at Low-A Bradenton, Davis batted 3-for-9 with 1 HR and 2 RBI.

ACTIVE 1'S: For the first time in franchise history, Altoona has 4 First Round draft picks on the active roster at the same time with **Connor Scott** (13th overall, 2018 by Miami), **Quinn Priester** (19th overall, 2019), **Nick Gonzales** (7th overall, 2020) and Henry Davis (1st overall, 2021) active for Altoona.

BIG TREE HIT BALL HARD: Infielder **Jared Triolo** was playing some of his best baseball on both sides of the ball until his trip to the IL on Tuesday, August 30 with a left knee injury. Triolo is amid a 16-game on-base streak (8/9 - Present) in which he's batting: .354/.419/.646 with 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 7 RBI and 3-3 SB. Triolo scored a run in 8 straight games (8/14 - 8/25), the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In his last 54 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .402 on-base percentage with 26 extra base hits. He's reached base safely in 21-of-22 games in August.

K-MAN: Right-hander **Luis Ortiz** has 126 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Ortiz struck out 10 Bowie Baysox on Friday, August 26, the first 10+ strikeout performance for the Curve since **Roansy Contreras** struck out 10 on 6/15/21 at Erie. Should Ortiz stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 4 more starts in the regular season; he needs just 16 strikeouts to match the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (**Ian Snell**, 2004: 142).

NICKY G IS BACK: Infielder **Nick Gonzales** picked up a season-high 4 hits including a walk-off double in the 10th inning of Altoona's 3-2 win over Harrisburg on Wednesday, August 17. After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Gonzales has reached base safely in each of his first 11 games since his activation batting: .250/.411/.409 (11-for-44) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 10 BB and 1-3 SB since his return.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford has 24 homers on the season, becoming the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, **Mason Martin** hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Shackelford is 1st among Pirates MiLB with 24 HR (Matt Gorski) and ranks 3rd in the Eastern League with 25 Extra-Base Hits in the Second Half of the Season.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB.com, **C Endy Rodriguez**. Rodriguez picked up at least one hit in 14-of-15 games with the Curve and driven in 17 runs. He had a hit in 12 straight games to begin his Curve career, a stretch that ended on August 26 at Bowie.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 144 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 19 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, **Jared Triolo** (24), **Liover Peguero** (23) and **Andres Alvarez** (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Managed by Rouglas Odor, Akron enters the series on the fringe of the second half division playoff race. Their roster features several top Guardians prospects despite the promotions of INF Bryan Rocchio and OF George Valera to Triple-A. RHP Gavin Williams (#3), RHP Tanner Bibee (#8), INF Angel Martinez (#12), OF Jhonkensy Noel (#17), INF Jose Tena (#18), RHP Tanner Burns (#19), C Bryan Lavastida (#26) and LHP Doug Nikhazy (#28) highlight the current 'Ducks roster.

THE FIRST ONTO THE POND: Righty Tanner Burns takes the ball in the series opener. Burns is 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA (2 ER / 14.2 IP) in three starts against Altoona this year. Burns was Gatorade's Alabama high school player of the year in 2017, but he was strongly committed to Auburn and followed 2018 No. 1 overall pick Casey Mize as the Tigers' Friday-night starter in his final two college seasons. The Guardians selected him 36th overall in 2020, the highest pick they've spent on a college arm since taking Drew Pomeranz at No. 5 a decade earlier, and signed him for a below-slot \$1.6 million.

CURVE CUTS: Carmen Alexander Mlodzinski... Last name pronounced "ma-JINSK-ee"... Parents are Holly and Tim... After using a powerful sinking fastball at South Carolina, has adopted a more traditional four-seam fastball as a pro... Change has helped his fastball play better off of his cutter, slider and changeup... Was rated by MLB.com as the No. 21 prospect in the 2020 draft... Signed with the Pirates for \$2,050,000... Was ranked as the top prep player in the state of South Carolina in 2017 by Perfect Game... Grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch during his junior year at Hilton Head (SC) High School... Was the South Carolina 4A Player-of-the-Year in 2017 despite having his season cut short by a torn fingernail... Was a Baseball America Top 500 prospect for the 2017 MLB Draft... Plays the guitar and piano... Does not have any social media accounts and didn't have a cell phone until age 16... Enjoys photography and surfing in his free time... Brother, JJ, was named the 2020 Rookie of the Year for South Carolina's Club Baseball Team after going 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts during the pandemic-shortened season... With nearby baseball fields closed during the height of the COVID-19 Pandemic in the summer of 2020, Mlodzinski told WSAV-TV in Hilton Head S.C. that he would get his throwing in at dusk on local golf courses with his brother JJ...
