YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Patriots, 10-8. Somerset jumped in front with a run in the second and two in the third. Richmond took a 5-3 lead in the bottom of the fourth inning. **Jairo Pomares** hit a two-run single, **Sabin Ceballos** tied the game with an RBI double and **Adrian Sugastey** hit a two-run homer. The Patriots scored a run in the fifth and took the lead in the sixth with a two-run single by Garrett Martin. Somerset extended the lead to 10-5 with three runs in the seventh. In the bottom of the seventh, **Carter Howell** hit a solo homer and **Devin Mann** added an RBI double. **Aeverson Arteaga** scored on a wild pitch in the ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game home series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The two teams meet again at Somerset from July 29-August 3. The Flying Squirrels and Patriots met last season for two series. Richmond opened the year at Somerset dropping two-of-three from April 5-7. The Patriots won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 25-30.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,290 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 1-5 in last week's road trip to Akron, their fourth series loss of the year. Their 5-18 start is the worst in franchise history. The 2015 Flying Squirrels started 3-2 before losing a franchise-record 15 consecutive games, failing to 3-17. They snapped the losing slide with a six-game win streak and finished the year 72-68, one game out of a postseason spot.

THE PATRIOTS split last week's home series against the Hartford Yard Goats. They opened the season dropping two-of-three at Hartford before splitting a home series against Reading and dropping four-of-six at Altoona the following week. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (28), doubles (52) and SLG (.429). Somerset's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 6), C/1B Rafael Flores (No. 10), RHP Cam Schlittler (No. 14) and RHP Clayton Beeter (No. 21). There are also four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including Jones (No. 2), Schlittler (No. 10), Flores (No. 15) and Beeter (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jack Choate** makes his fifth start of the season and the first of his career against the Patriots. He last pitched on Saturday at Akron in the first game of a doubleheader and allowed one run over three innings. In his season debut on April 6, he tied his career high with nine strikeouts, throwing 3.2 scoreless, two-hit innings against Akron at The Diamond. Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (.121) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. **For more on Choate, see page two.**

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Cam Schlittler makes his fifth appearance of the season. He last pitched last Thursday against the Yard Goats and threw seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits with nine strikeouts. In the Eastern League this season, he ranks fourth in ERA (1.23), fourth in BAA (.171), fifth in WHIP (0.82) and tied for eighth in innings pitched (22.0). Last year, Schlittler made seven appearances for Somerset, going 2-4 with 4.45 ERA. He spent most of the season with High-A Hudson Valley, posting a 6-4 record with a 2.60 ERA in 17 starts en route to being named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Year. Entering 2025, he is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 14 Yankees prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 16 stolen base attempts this season, which is first among all 30 Double-A teams. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 10 runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is third in the EL with six.

BRYCE IS BACK: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster last Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history.

HAMMERIN' JAIRO: In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** gave the Flying Squirrels a 4-1 lead in the sixth with a three-run homer. It was his fourth homer of the year, which is tied for 10th-most in the Eastern League this season. Last year, Pomares led the team with 12 homers. Eight-of-his-10 RBIs this year have come on home runs.

GO, DIEGO, GO: **Diego Velasquez** is riding an 11-game hitting streak, which is the longest current streak in the Eastern League and the third-longest in the EL this season. In those 11 games since April 18, Velasquez is batting .405 (17-for-42) with a homer, three doubles, five RBIs and seven runs scored. In his 64 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .314 (72-for-229). His 11-game hit streak is tied for the longest by a Richmond player since the start of 2024. Last year, **Victor Bericoto** posted a team-high 11-game hit streak from June 8-21. The last 12-game hit streak by a Richmond hitter was set by **Carter Williams** from May 27-June 13, 2023.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' roster, including the United States (22 players), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (1), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 21 American-born players, 12 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (3), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1), Texas (1), Indiana (1) and Virginia (1). There are 12 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, five were signed as non-drafted free agents, four as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades, one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft and two signed as MiLB free agents. For 22 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and seven have played with other major-league organizations.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is ninth in batting average (.317) and tied for third in hits (26). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for 10th in homers (4). **Seth Lonsway** is tied for ninth in ERA (2.18) and 10th in WHIP (0.97). **Jack Choate** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (25). **John Michael Bertrand** is tied for first in games started (5).

LONG NIGHTS: The Flying Squirrels are playing nine-inning games at an average time of two hours, 48 minutes and five seconds, which is tied with Reading for the longest in the Eastern League this year. It is their second-longest average game time in the pitch clock era (since 2015), trailing only 2021 (2:56:51). It is the fourth-longest in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels have played seven nine-inning games at 2:56 or longer. Wednesday's game was 3:27, the longest nine-inning game for the team since September 9, 2021.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Rochester Red Wings, 3-0, at Parker Field. Jim Coates struck out 10 with no walks in his first start of the season. He had been pitching in relief to open the year after dealing with a sore shoulder. Richmond scored a run in the second on a bases-loaded walk by Coates and added two in the third. **1971:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 6-5, at Parker Field. Oscar Brown won the game with a pinch-hit ninth-inning single to score Fred Velazquez. Don Baylor and Bobby Grich hit early homers to help Rochester take a 5-0 lead. Tommie Aaron hit his first homer of the year to tie the score in the eighth. **1985:** The Richmond Braves beat the Maine Guides, 4-3, at The Diamond. Steve Curry won the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth off Jose Calderon to score Milt Thompson. Curry was back with Richmond for the first time since 1982. It was the ninth win in 10 games for Richmond. **1995:** The Richmond Braves beat the Charlotte Knights, 1-0, at The Diamond. Manager Grady Little was sent 10 new players that day, including seven who played in the game. Matt Murray started for Richmond and threw seven scoreless innings. **2005:** The Richmond Braves beat the Norfolk Tides, 3-2, at The Diamond. Mike O'Keefe won the game with a walk-off homer in the bottom of the ninth. **2019:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 7-3, at Prince George's Stadium. In his first day back off the IL, Jacob Heyward hit a homer on the first pitch of the game. Later in the game, he went deep with another home run. Richmond homered four times in the game, tying what was then the franchise single-game record for home runs, which was broken in 2022 and then passed again in 2023.
