# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (4-6, 45-31)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes continue a three-game home stand against the Visalia Rawhide. Tonight is Throwback Music Night, as we enjoy some old favorites! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the eighth of 24 head-to-head meetings and the second of nine here at LoanMart Field. In May, the Quakes won four of six in their only series against the Rawhide this year. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes ended their three-game losing streak with a well-played 4-2 victory over the Visalia Rawhide on Tuesday night at LoanMart Field. Cameron Decker had two hits and the game-winning RBI, while the Rancho bullpen combined for 4.2 innings of scoreless relief to nail down the win. Shawn Oduber (3-0), Michael Vilchez and Jhonny Jimenez (3rd save) allowed just one walk and three hits to send Visalia to their third straight loss overall. Rancho starter Sterling Patick allowed two runs on seven hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. Visalia starter Josdanner Suarez (0-1) allowed four runs (two earned) on six hits over four innings in his debut, taking the loss.

**BETTER PITCHING:** The Quakes had a tough series this past week in San Jose, but the pitching specifically struggled over the last few days, allowing 32 runs in the final two games of the series. Rancho entered the San Jose series with a team ERA of 3.84 and exited with an ERA of 4.34. Last night's game dropped their ERA to 4.31.

**SERIES STUFF:** Saturday's loss at San Jose means the Quakes dropped their fourth series of the year, all four to north clubs. Rancho's series record in 2025 is 8-4-1 with two losses to both San Jose and Stockton. They have just two series wins against the north this year, one against both San Jose and Stockton. They are 6-0 in series against the south **END OF JUNE:** The Quakes had a pretty inconsistent June and hope for a more stable month as the calendar turns to July. By record, June was Rancho's worst month at 11-14. The month of June literally started with game one of a sea son-worst eight-game losing streak, only to be followed by a season-high nine-game winning streak. As a team, they hit just .233 with an ERA of 5.55, easily their worst statistical months this season. Jaron Elkins had the best offensive month, hitting .316 with ten RBIs and 16 stolen bases in 23 games, but he didn't go deep all month. On the pitching side of things, reliever Cody Morse enjoyed a strong month, allowing just two earned runs over 12.1 innings.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes made three roster moves over the last few days. RHP Christian Zazueta, who missed his last two starts in San Jose, was placed on the Development List on Sunday. On Tuesday, INF Elijah Hainline was moved back to Rancho after spending almost a full week in Triple-A Oklahoma City for their west-coast trip to Sacramento. In addition, RHP Dailoui Abad was added to the Rancho Cucamonga roster from the 60-Day Injured List.

**SAMUEL SANCHEZ:** Right-hander Samuel Sanchez makes his sixth start and tenth appearance of 2025, as he'll face the Rawhide for the first time. In his last appearance, he allowed five runs on six hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision at San Jose on June 26th. Sanchez signed with the Dodgers in January of 2023 out of Venezuela and is ranked as the Dodgers 28th-best prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

**MERVIN FELL:** 22-year-old right-hander Mervin Fell makes his 11th appearance and eighth start overall, his first start and second appearance against the Quakes. In one relief outing against Rancho, he allowed two runs on one hit with three walks, while recording just two outs in a no-decision on May 7th. In his last appearance overall, he allowed one run on two hits over five innings in a no-decision at Inland Empire on June 25th. Fell signed with the Diamondbacks in December of 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.
