Last Night: Captains 5, Lugnuts 1. In the top of the third inning, **Jordan Díaz** hit a 427-foot home run and **William Simoneit** followed with a single -- and that was all for the Lugnuts base hits in a two-hit loss against four Lake County pitchers. **José Tena** hit a 440-foot two-run homer for the Captains in the win.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday, returning home to host Dayton on August 20-25.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Going Yard: With yesterday's **Jordan Díaz** homer, the Lugnuts have now hit 17 roundtrippers in 15 games against Lake County this year. That said, Lansing's only runs the past two games have come off home runs: a pair of two-run shots on Wednesday in an 8-4 loss and the solo blast yesterday in a 5-1 defeat.

Positive First Impression: On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**. Guasch and Millas were each assigned to the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks (with Shuman yet to receive an assignment). Millas debuted last night for the Blue Rocks with a 3-for-5 performance including two RBI singles.

Alumni Report: **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is second in the Majors in home runs (34), first in RBIs (85), second in on-base percentage (.417), third in slugging (.644), first in total bases (248), first in OPS (1.061) and second in runs scored (83) behind 2017 Lugnuts teammate **Bo Bichette** (84). Additionally, former Lansing Lugnuts outfielder **Kevin Pillar**, who was named the 2012 Midwest League MVP, was named the New York Mets' winner of the Heart and Hustle Award.

Up the Ladder: The Midland RockHounds battled back from a 9-4 deficit, scored four runs in the 8th in a game-tying rally, two more in the 9th in a game-tying rally, and then beat Wichita in 10 innings, 13-12. Notably, starting catcher Collin Theroux moved to the mound for the bottom of the 10th inning, produced a double play from Trey Cabbage (center fielder to third baseman), issued a walk to Andrew Bechtold and induced Jermaine Palacios to fly out to center, earning the save against the Twins' Double-A affiliate.

Familiar Foes: Today's starting matchup features two pitchers whose first High-A appearances came against the opposition here tonight. Lansing starter **Colin Peluse**, who is coming off six scoreless innings his last time out vs. Fort Wayne, made his 2021 debut with three scoreless innings of relief against the Captains on Opening Day, May 4. He then started against Lake County on July 17 in Lansing and earned the win, allowing two runs (one earned) on seven hits and three walks in five innings, striking out five. On the other side, young **Daniel Espino** struck out nine in four innings in his High-A debut on July 15 in Lansing, allowing two runs on three hits and three walks to suffer the loss.

Future Lugnut Spotlight: Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** moved into MLB.com's ranking as the No. 30 Athletics prospect after the deadline deals. A 6th-round selection from Westlake H.S. (Atlanta) in 2018, Butler is leading Low-A Stockton with in games (75), hits (71), runs (52), homers (15), total bases (141), RBIs (57) and walks (49), and looks well on his way to becoming a Lugnut before the year is out.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: Urgency was of the utmost importance for the Lugnuts, working to beat an incoming storm. Fort Wayne TinCaps prospect right-hander Luis Patiño held the Lugnuts hitless through the first five innings, but the Lugs broke through with four runs in the sixth at Parkview Field, taking a 4-2 lead with menacing clouds massing in the Summit City. The TinCaps tied the game with two runs in the bottom of the sixth, only to see Jalen Washington's third passed ball of the game bring in Jesus Navarro in the seventh for a 5-4 Nuts lead. After a perfect Orlando Pascual bottom of the seventh, the skies opened and the game was called after a 35-minute delay.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17, pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Díaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColi** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColi**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 15 different starting pitchers this season, specifically **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

All-Time Roster History: Catcher **Cooper Uhl** became the newest Lugnut to debut on August 5, the 47th different player on the ballclub this season and the 851st Lugnuts player all-time.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 26 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing."

Notable 2021 Moments in Lansing:

- May 8 vs. Lake County: made High-A debut in relief, following Jeff Criswell (2 IP) and Shohei Tomioka (3 IP)... worked with William Simoneit to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base.
- May 22 at Fort Wayne: made first High-A start... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, and Bryce Nightengale allowed all three inherited runners to score.
- June 5 vs. South Bend: Domination. A team-high 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings.
- June 12 at West Michigan: held Whitecaps scoreless for the first four innings... five hits and five runs in the 5th.
- July 11 at Great Lakes: served up home runs to the first two Loons batters, James Outman and Justin Yurchak, before blanking the Loons over the next 12 outs, with five strikeouts.

Last Outing: July 31 vs. FW, earned the win with six scoreless innings, allowing four hits, walking none and striking out six in his third quality start of the year... 80 pitches, 60 strikes... Lugnuts triumphed, 3-1.

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of nine Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseball marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
